

Genesis cont 20

Gen 23:17 And the field of Ephron, which was in Machpelah, what was before Mamre, the field and the cave which was therein, and all the trees that were in the field, that was in all the borders round about, was made sure

23:18 Unto Abraham for a possession in the presence of the children of Heth, before all that went in at the gate of his city.

Gen 23:19 And after this, Abraham buried Sarah his wife in the cave of the field of Machpelah before Mamre: the same is Hebron in the land of Canaan.

Gen 24:1 And Abraham was old and well stricken in age: and the LORD had blessed Abraham in all things.

Gen 24:3 ... thou shalt not take a wife unto my son of the daughters of the Canaanites, among whom I dwell:

24:4 But thou shalt go unto my country, and to my kindred, and take a wife unto my son Isaac.

Gen 24:5 And the servant said unto him, Peradventure the women will not be willing to follow me into this land: must I needs bring thy son again into the land from whence thou comest?

Gen 24:6 And Abraham said unto him, Beware thou that thou bring not my son thither again.

Gen 24:7 The LORD GOD of heaven, which took me from my father's house, and from the land of my kindred, and which spake unto me and that swore unto me saying, Into thy seed will I give this land:

Genesis cont 21

Gen 24:7 ... he shall send his angel before thee, and thou shalt take a wife into my son from thence.

Gen 24:8 And if the women will not be willing to follow thee, then thou shalt be clear from this my oath: only bring not my son thither again

Gen 24:10 And the servant took ten camels of the camels of his master, and departed; for all the goods of his master were in his hand: and he arose and went to Mesopotamia, unto the city of Nahor.

Gen 24:12 And he said, O LORD GOD of my master Abraham, I pray thee, send me good speed this day, and shew kindness unto my master Abraham.

Gen 24:15 And it came to pass before he had done speaking, that, behold, Rebekah came out, who was born to Bethuel, son of Milcah, the wife of Nahor, Abraham's brother, with her yoke upon her shoulder.

Gen 24:16-19 The servant visits with Rebekah's family

Gen 24:50 Then Laban and Bethuel answered and said, The thing proceedeth from the LORD: we cannot speak unto thee bad or good.

Gen 24:51 Behold, Rebekah is before thee, take her, and go, and let her be thy master's son's wife, as the LORD hath spoken.

Gen 24:58 And they called Rebekah, and said unto her, Wilt thou go with this man?

And she said, I will go.

Genesis cont 22

Gen 24:59 And they set away Rebekah their sister, and her nurse, and Abraham's servant, and his men.

Gen 24:60 And they blessed Rebekah, and said unto her, Thou art our sister, be thou the mother of thousands of millions, and let thy seed possess the gate of those which hate them.

Gen 24:64 And Rebekah lifted up her eyes, and when she saw Isaac, she lighted off the camel.

Gen 24:67 And Isaac brought her into his mother Sarah's tent, and took Rebekah, and she became his wife; and he loved her: and Isaac was comforted after his mother's death.

Gen 25:5 And Abraham gave all that he had unto Isaac.

Gen 25:7 Abraham 175 yrs old.

Gen 25:8 Then Abraham gave up the ghost, and died in a good old age, an old man, and full of years, and was gathered to his people.

Gen 25:11 And it came to pass after the death of Abraham, that GOD blessed his son Isaac...

Gen 25:12-18 Generations of Ishmael

Gen 25:20 And Isaac was forty years old when he took Rebekah to wife... and Rebekah his wife conceived.

Gen 25:22- And the children struggled within her... And she went to enquire of the LORD.

Gen 25:23 And the LORD said unto her, Two nations are in thy womb, and two manner of people shall be separated from thy bowels; and the one people shall be stronger than the other people; and the elder shall serve the younger.

Genesis cont 23

Gen 25:24 And when her days to be delivered were fulfilled, behold, there were twins in her womb.

Gen 25:25-26 And the first came out red, all over like an hairy garment; and they called his name Esau. And after that came his brother out, and his hand took hold on Esau's heel; and his name was called Jacob: and Isaac was threescore years old when she bore them.

Gen 25:28 And Isaac loved Esau, ... but Rebekah loved Jacob.

Gen 25:29-34 Esau sells his birthright to Jacob.

Gen 26:1 And there was a famine in the land, beside the first famine that was in the days of Abraham. And Isaac went into Abimelech king of the Philistines into Gerar.

Gen 26:2 And the LORD appeared unto him, and said, Go not down into Egypt; dwell in the land which I shall tell thee of:

Gen 26:3 Sojourn in this land and I will bless thee. Gen 26:4 And I will make thy seed to multiply as the stars of heaven, and will give unto thy seed all these countries; and in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed.

Gen 26:6 Isaac pretended Rebekah in his sister.

Gen 26:12 Then Isaac sowed in that land, and received in the same year an hundred fold: and the LORD blessed him.
