

[Genesis] cont 24

Gen 26:13 And the man waxed great, and went forward, and grew until he became very great.

Gen 26:16 And Abimelech said unto Isaac, Go from us, for thou art much mightier than we.

Gen 26:23 And he went up from thence into Beer-Sheba.

Gen 26:24 And the LORD appeared unto him the same night, and said, I AM the GOD of Abraham, thy father: fear not, for I AM with thee, and will bless thee, and multiply thy seed for my servant Abraham's sake.

Gen 26:16-31 Abimelech makes a covenant with Isaac.

Gen 26:32 ... We have found water.

Gen 26:33 And he called it Shebah: therefore the name of the city is Beer-Sheba unto this day.

Gen 26:34 Esau marries Hittite wives.

Gen 26:35 Which were a grief of mind unto Isaac and Rebekah

Gen 27:1 And it came to pass, that when Isaac was old, and his eyes were dim, so that he could not see, he called Esau his eldest son, and said unto him, My son: and he said unto him, Behold here am I.

Gen 27:3-4 Isaac asks Esau to bring him venison, that he may eat and give him a blessing.

Gen 27:6-26 Rebekah helps Jacob to trick Isaac into a blessing.

Gen 27:27 And he came near, and kissed him, ... and brought him, and said, ... God give thee of the dew of heaven, and the fatness of the earth, and plenty of corn and wine.

[Genesis] cont 25

Gen 27:29 Let people serve thee, and nations bow down to thee: be lord over thy brethren, and let thy mother's sons bow down to thee: cursed be every one that curseth thee, and blessed be he that blesseth thee

Gen 27:41 And Esau hated Jacob because of the blessing wherewith his father blessed him: and Esau said in his heart, The days of mourning for my father are at hand: then will I slay my brother Jacob.

Gen 27:42-46 Rebekah sends Jacob to her brother Laban, to Haran for safety.

Gen 28:1 And Isaac called Jacob, and blessed him, and charged him, and said unto him, Thou shalt not take a wife of the daughters of Canaan.

Gen 28:2 Arise, go to Paddan-aram, to the house of Bethuel thy mother's father: and take thee a wife from thence of the daughters of Laban thy mother's brother.

Gen 28:3 And GOD ALMIGHTY bless thee, and make thee fruitful, and multiply thee, that thou mayest be a multitude of people.

Gen 28:4 And give thee the blessing of Abraham, to thee, and to thy seed with thee, that thou mayest inherit the land wherein thou art a stranger, which GOD gave unto Abraham.

Gen 28:5-10 ... And Jacob was out from Beer-Sheba, and went toward Haran.

Gen 28:11 And he lay upon a certain place, and tired there all night ... and lay down in that place to sleep.

[Genesis] cont 26

Gen 28:12 And he dreamed, and behold a ladder set up on the earth, and the top of it reached to heaven: and behold the angels of GOD ascending and descending on it.

Gen 28:13 And, behold, the LORD stood above it, and said, I AM the LORD GOD of Abraham, thy father, and the GOD of Isaac: the land wherein thy father is, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed.

Gen 28:14 And thy seed shall be on the east of the earth, and thou shalt spread abroad to the west, and to the east, and to the north, and to the south: and in thee and in thy seed shall all the families of the earth be blessed.

Gen 28:15 And, behold, I AM with thee, and will keep thee in all places whither thou shalt go, and will bring thee again into the land; for I will not leave thee, until I have done that which I have spoken to thee of.

Gen 28:18 And Jacob rose up early in the morning, and took the stone that he had put for his pillar, and set it up for a pillar, and poured oil upon the top of it.

Gen 28:20 And Isaac vowed a vow, saying, if God will be with me, and will keep me in this way that I go, and will give me bread to eat, and raiment that I will put on,

Gen 28:21 So that I come again to my father's house in peace; then shall the LORD be my GOD.

[Genesis] cont 27

Gen 28:22 And this stone, which I have set for a pillar, shall be GOD's house: and of all that thou shalt give me I will surely give the tenth into thee.

Gen 29:1-14 Jacob meets Rachel

Gen 29:15 And Laban said unto Jacob, Because thou art my brother, ... tell me, what shall thy wages be?

Gen 29:18 And Jacob loved Rachel; and said, I will serve thee seven years for Rachel thy younger daughter.

Gen 29:19-26 Laban gives Leah into Jacob, rather than Rachel.

Gen 29:27-30 Jacob serves another 7 years.

Gen 29:31 And when the LORD saw that Leah was hated, he opened her womb: but Rachel was barren.

Gen 29:32-35 Leah bears Reuben, Simeon, Levi, and Judah.

Gen 30:6-8 Bilhah, Rachel's maid, bears Jacob sons, Dan and Naphtali.

Gen 30:10-13 Zilpah, Leah's maid, bears Jacob sons, Gad and Asher.

Gen 30:14-21 Leah bears Jacob sons, Issachar and Zebulun, and a daughter, Dinah.

Gen 30:22 And God remembered Rachel, and GOD hearkened to her, and opened her womb.

Gen 30:23 And she conceived, and bore a son ... Gen 30:24 And she called his name Joseph.
