

Genesis cont. 28

Gen 30:25 And it came to pass, when Rachel had born Joseph, that Jacob said unto Laban, Send me away, that I may go unto mine own place, and to my country.

Gen 30:31-41 Jacob shows the speckled and spotted cattle, sheep, and goats.

Gen 30:42 the feebler flocks were Laban's, and the stronger Jacob's

Gen 30:43 And the man increased exceedingly, and had much cattle, and maidens, and menservants, and camels, and asses.

Gen 31:11 And the angel of GOD spoke unto me in a dream saying, Jacob: And I said, Here am I.

Gen 31:13 I AM the GOD of Beth-el where thou anointedst the pillar, and where thou vowedst a vow unto me: now arise, get thee out from this land, and return to the land of thy kindred.

Gen 31:17 Then Jacob rose up, and set his sons and his wives upon camels;

Gen 31:18 And he carried away all his cattle, and all his goods which he had gotten, the cattle of his getting, which he had gotten in Padan-aram, for to go to Isaac his father in the land of Canaan

Gen 31:19-42 Laban pursues Jacob

Gen 31:43-55 Jacob and Leah make a covenant between them at Gilead.

Gen 31:28 Jacob with Laban for 20 years.

Genesis cont. 29

Gen 32:1 And Jacob went on his way, and the angels of GOD met him.

Gen 32:2 And when Jacob saw them, he said, This is GOD's host: and he called the name of that place Mahanaim.

Gen 32:1 And Jacob sent messengers before him to Esau his brother unto the land of Seir, the country of Edom.

Gen 32:6 And the messengers returned to Jacob, saying, We came to thy brother Esau, and also he cometh to meet thee, and four hundred men with him.

Gen 32:7 Then Jacob was greatly afraid and distressed, and he divided the people that was with him, and the flocks, and herbs, and the camels into two bands.

Gen 32:13 And he lodged there that same night; and took of that which came to his hand a present for Esau his brother...

Gen 32:21 So went the present over before him: and himself lodged that night in the company.

Gen 32:22 And he rose up that night, and took his two wives, and his two women-servants, and his eleven sons, and passed over the ford Jabbok.

Gen 32:23 And he took them, and sent them over the brook.

Gen 32:24 And Jacob was left alone; and there wrestled a man with him until the breaking of the day.

Gen 32:28 And he said, Thy name shall be called no more Jacob, but Israel: for as a prince hast thou power with GOD and with men, and hast prevailed.

Genesis cont. 30

Gen 33:1 And Jacob lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold, Esau cometh, and with him 400 men. And he divided the children into Leah, and unto Rachel, and unto the two handmaids.

Gen 33:2 And he put the handmaids and their children foremost, and Leah and her children after, and Rachel and Joseph hindmost.

Gen 33:3 And he passed over before them, and bowed himself to the ground seven times, until he came near to his brother.

Gen 33:4 And Esau ran to meet him, and embraced him, and fell on his neck, and kissed him: and they wept.

Gen 33:5 ... Who are these with thee? And he said, The children which GOD hath graciously given thy servant.

Gen 33:10 And Jacob said ... if now thou find grace in thy sight, then receive my present at my hand: for because I have seen thy face, as though I had seen the face of GOD, and thou wast pleased with me.

Gen 33:11 Take, I pray thee, my blessing that is brought to thee; because GOD hath dealt graciously with me, and because I have seen thy face, and he used him, and he took it.

Gen 33:16 So Esau returned that day on his way unto Seir.

Gen 33:17 And Jacob journeyed into Succoth, and built him an house, and made booths for his cattle: therefore the name of the place is called Succoth.

Genesis cont. 31

Gen 34 Dinah, the daughter of Leah, is defiled by Shechem, the son of Hamor the Hivite.

Gen 34:24 And into Hamor and into Shechem his son hearkened all that was out of the gate of his city; and every male was circumcised...

Gen 34:25 And it came to pass on the third day, when they were sore, that two of the sons of Jacob, Simeon and Levi, Dinah's brethren, took each man his sword, and came upon the city boldly, and slew all the males.

Gen 34:26 And they slew Hamor and Shechem his son with the edge of the sword, and took Dinah out of Shechem's house, and went out.

Gen 35:1 And GOD said unto Jacob, Arise, go up to Beth-el, and dwell there: and make there an altar unto GOD, that appeared unto thee when thou fleddest from the face of Esau thy brother.

Gen 35:2 Then Jacob said unto his household, and to all that were with him, Put away the strange gods that are among you, and be clean, and change your garments...

Gen 35:6 So Jacob came to Luz, which is in the land of Canaan, that is Beth-el, he and all the people that were with him.

Gen 35:7 And he built there an altar, and called the place El-beth-el: because there GOD appeared unto him, when he fled from the face of his brother.
