

Gen 1:1-5 GOD creates Heaven, the Earth and Light.

Gen 1:2 And the earth was without form and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep.

⇒ And the SPIRIT of GOD moved upon the face of the waters.

Gen 1:8 And GOD called the firmament Heaven.

Gen 1:26-28 GOD created man in HIS own image.

Gen 1:28 And GOD blessed them, and GOD said unto them, Be fruitful and multiply...

Gen 2:1-3 And GOD rested on the Seventh Day. First Sabbath

Gen 2:3 And GOD blessed the seventh day and sanctified it.

Gen 2:7 And the LORD GOD formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the Breath of Life; and man became a living soul.

## [Genesis] cont. 2

### Gen 5 The Generations of Adam

Gen 5:27 And all the days of Methuselah were 969 Years; and he died.

Gen 5:31 And all the days of Lamech were 777 years; and he died.

Gen 5:21-22 Enoch begat Methuselah

Gen 5:23-24 Enoch lived 365 Years

⇒ And Enoch walked with GOD: and he was not; for GOD took him.

\* Gen 5:32 And Noah was 500 years old; and Noah begat Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

⇒ Gen 6:1-7 The LORD regrets that man has become wicked & evil

\* Gen 6:8 But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.

Gen 6:13 GOD tells Noah, "The end of all flesh is come."

Gen 6:14 Make thee an Ark of Gopher Wood

Gen 6:15-16 The Ark.

⇒ Gen 6:17 GOD will Flood the Earth

Gen 2:8-20 The Garden of Eden,

Gen 2:21-25 The making of Woman and the Divine Institution of Marriage

Gen 2:23 And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: She shall be called woman, because she was taken out of man.

Gen 2:24 Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.

Gen 3:1-5 The serpent tempts Eve.

Gen 3:6 Eve tempts Adam.

Gen 3:7-11 The LORD discovers the temptation.

Gen 3:12-19 Adam and Eve perished

Gen 3:22-24 Adam and Eve are driven out of Paradise.

Gen 4:1-2 Cain and Abel are born.

⇒ Gen 4:4-24 Cain kills Abel

⇒ Gen 4:25 Seth is born.

## [Genesis] cont. 3

Gen 6:18 But with thee will I establish my covenant and thou shalt come into the Ark, thou, and thy sons, and thy wife, and thou sons' wives with thee.

Gen 6:19 And every living thing of all flesh, two of every sort shalt thou bring into the Ark, to keep them alive with thee: they shall be male and female.

Gen 7:1-4 Noah and all enter the Ark,

⇒ Gen 7:5 And Noah did according unto all that the LORD commanded him.

Gen 7:6 As Noah was six hundred years old when the flood of waters was upon the earth.

⇒ Gen 7:12 And the rain was upon the earth forty days and forty nights.

Gen 7:23 And every living substance perished. and Noah only remained alive, and they that were with him in the Ark.

Gen 7:24 The waters prevailed 150 days.

## [Genesis] cont. 4

Gen 8:1 And GOD remembered Noah.

Gen 8:2-12 The earth begins to dry.

Gen 8:13 And it came to pass in the Six Hundredth year and First Year, in the first month, the first day of the month, the waters were dried up off the earth.

Gen 8:14 May 27th the earth was dried.

Gen 8:15-19 Noah being commanded goes out of the Ark.

Gen 8:20-22 Noah offers sacrifice, GOD promises not to curse the earth.

Gen 9:1 And GOD blessed Noah and his sons, and said unto them, Be Fruitful and Multiply, and replenish the earth.

Gen 9:8-9 GOD speaks unto Noah and establishes a covenant with him and his seed.

Gen 9:12-17 The Rainbow in the Clouds is the token of GOD's Covenant.

## [Genesis] cont. 6

Gen 12:7 The LORD's covenant with Abram first mentioned.

Gen 12:10-20 A Famine in the land causes Abram and Sarai to travel to Egypt.

Gen 13:1 Abram and his family return from Egypt.

Gen 13:2-13 Abram's family dwelt in Canaan, and Lot's family near Sodom.

Gen 13:14-18 The Abrahamic Covenant

Gen 13:16 And I will make thy seed, as the dust of the earth: so that if a man can number the dust of the earth, then shall thy seed also be numbered.

Gen 13:18 Then Abram removed his tent, and came and dwelt in the plain of Mambre, which is in Hebron, and there built an altar unto the LORD.

→ Abram was thus called an Hebrew.

Gen 14:1-12 Battle of the Kings and Lot is taken prisoner.

Gen 14:14 And when Abram heard that his brother was taken captive, he armed his trained servants, born in his own house three hundred and eighteen, and pursued them unto Dan.

## [Genesis] cont. 5

Gen 9:18-19 The sons of Noah:

Shem, Ham, and Japheth: of them was the whole earth overspread.

→ Gen 9:20-23 Noah is shamed by his son Ham, the Father of Canaan.

Gen 9:24-29 Noah places a curse on Canaan.

Gen 9:29 And all the days of Noah were 950 years: and he died.

Gen 10 The generations of Noah and his sons Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

Gen 10:2 The 7 sons of Japheth became Gentiles.

Gen 10:8-9 Ham begat Cush who begat Nimrod, a mighty hunter before the LORD.

Gen 10:15-20 the sons of Canaan.

Gen 11:1-9 Tower of Babel, many languages.

Gen 11:10-29 Ancestry of Abram.

Gen 11:31-32 Abram and family go to Canaan.

Gen 12:1-6 The LORD tells Abram to leave Haran and Abram, Sarai, and Lot and families travel to Canaan.

## [Genesis] cont. 7

Gen 14:15-16 Abram smote the invaders and returned with Lot and family.

→ Gen 14:18 And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he King was the priest of the Most High GOD.

Gen 14:19 And he blessed him, and said Blessed be Abram of the Most High GOD, Possessor of Heaven and earth.

Gen 14:20 And blessed be the Most High GOD, which hath delivered thine enemies into thy hands. And he gave him tithes of all.

Gen 14:18 Note El Elyon "the Highest" as in Most High GOD.

Gen 15 GOD encourages Abram

Gen 15:1 After these things the Word of the LORD came unto Abram in a Vision saying, Fear Not Abram; I AM thy shield and thy Exceeding Great Reward.

→ Gen 15:2-6 The Divine Promise, Abram is Justified by Faith.

→ Gen 15:6 And he believed in the LORD, and HE counted it to him for Righteousness.

→ Gen 15:7-11 GOD promises Canaan to Abram for an inheritance.

## Genesis cont. 8

Gen 15:7 And HE said unto him, I AM the LORD that brought thee out of UR of the Chaldees, to give thee this land to inherit it.

Gen 15:12-16 The Promise confirmed in a Vision.

Gen 15:17-21 The Promise confirmed by a Sign

Gen 15:18 In the same day the LORD made a Covenant with Abram, saying, Unto thy seed, have I given this land, from Egypt to Euphrates.

Gen 16-Birth of Ishmael.

Gen 16:1-6 Hagar, Sarai's maid is given to Abram and she conceives. Sarai mistreats Hagar, and Hager flees.

Gen 16:7-16 An Angel of the LORD appears to Hagar and commands her to return. He promises her that her seed will be multiplied.

Gen 16:10 ... I will multiply thy seed exceedingly, that it shall not be numbered for multitude.

Gen 16:11 And the Angel of the LORD said unto her, Behold, thou art with child and shalt bear a son, and shalt call his name Ishmael...

## Genesis cont. 10

Gen 17:17 Then Abraham fell upon his face, and laughed, and said in his heart Shall a child be born unto him that is an hundred years old? and shall Sarah, that is ninety years old, bear?

Gen 17:19 And GOD said, Sarah thy wife shall bear thee a son indeed; and thou shalt call his name Isaac, and I will establish MY Covenant with him for an everlasting covenant, and with his seed after him.

Gen 17 The Birth of Isaac was to be a Miracle, as was the birth of CHRIST.

Gen 17:26 Abraham and Ishmael and all the males are circumcised.

Gen 18: The LORD and HIS Angels visit Abraham.

Gen 18:1 And the LORD appeared unto him in the plains of Mamre: and he sat in the tent door in the heat of the day.

Gen 18:2 And he lift up his eyes and looked, and lo, three men stood by him: and when he saw them, he ran to meet them from the tent door, and bowed himself toward the ground.

Gen 18:3-8 Abraham prepares a meal for the LORD.

## Genesis cont. 9

Gen 16:16 And Abrem was soar score and six years old, when Hagar bare Ishmael to Abraam.

Gen 17 The LORD's Covenant with Abraham.

Gen 17:1 And when Abram was Ninety years old and Nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I AM the Almighty GOD; walk before ME and be perfect.

Gen 17:2 And I will make my Covenant between ME and thee, and will multiply thee exceedingly.

Gen 17:3-4 And Abrem fell on his face: And GOD talked with him saying, and, as for ME, behold, MY Covenant is with thee, and thou shalt be a Father of many nations.

Gen 17:5 Neither shall thy name any more be called Abrem, but thy name shall be called Abraham; for a father of many nations have I made thee.

Gen 17:10 This is MY covenant, which ye shall keep between ME and you and thy seed after thee, Every man child among you shall be circumcised.

Gen 17:15-16 Sarai to be called Sarah, the Mother of many nations.

## Genesis cont. 11 7-10-17

Gen 18:9-13 Sarah laughs at the thought of having a child.

Gen 18:14 Is any thing too hard for the LORD?

At the time appointed, I will return unto thee, according unto the time of life; and Sarah shall have a son.

Gen 18:16-22 GOD reveals to Abraham the destruction of Sodom.

Gen 18:23-33 Abraham pleads for the Righteous who are in Sodom.

Gen 18:32 And HE said, I will not destroy it for Ten's sake.

Gen 18:33 And the LORD went HIS way, as soon as HE had left commanding with Abraham: and Abraham returned unto his place.

Gen 19 The destruction of Sodom and the deliverance of Lot.

Gen 19:1-3 Two Angels go to Sodom to destroy the city.

Gen 19:4-11 The men of Sodom surround Lot's house and demand the traveler's to be brought out. The Angels smote the men with Blindness.

## [Genesis] cont. 12

Gen 19:12-17 The man told Lot to leave, for they have come to destroy the city.

Gen 19:17 ... Escape for thy life; look not behind thee, neither stay thee in all the plain; escape to the mountain, lest thou be consumed.

Gen 19:18-23 Lot escapes to a small city, Zoar.

Gen 19:24 Then the LORD rained upon Sodom and Gomorrah brimstone and fire from the LORD out of Heaven.

Gen 19:26 Lot's wife looked back from behind him, and she became a pillar of salt.

Gen 19:30-36 Lot's daughters tricked him and slept with him to bear children.

Gen 19:37-38 Their sons became Moab and Ammon.

Gen 20 Abraham and Sarah travel to Gerar and tell King Abimelech that Sarah is his sister. GOD warns Abimelech that he has taken another man's wife. Sarah is restored to Abraham with 1000 pieces of silver. Also gave him sheep, oxen, and servants.

## [Genesis] cont. 14

Gen 22:9 And they came to the place which GOD told him of; and Abraham built an alter there, and laid the wood in order, and bound Isaac his son and laid him on the altar upon the wood.

Gen 22:10 And Abraham stretched forth his hand, and took the knife to slay his son.

Gen 22:11 And the Angel of the LORD called unto him out of Heaven, and said, Abraham, Abraham: and he said, Here am I.

Gen 22:12 And he said, Lay not thine hand upon the lad, neither do thou any thing unto him: for now I know that thou fearest GOD, seeing thou hast not withheld thy son, thine only son from ME.

Gen 22:11-14 Another sacrifice is provided rather than Isaac.

Gen 22:15-19 The covenant with Abraham is renewed.

Gen 23 The death of Sarah

Gen 23:1-2 Sarah dies at the age of 127 in Hebron.

## [Genesis] cont. 13

Gen 20:12 And yet indeed she is my sister; she is the daughter of my father, but not the daughter of my mother; and she became my wife.

Gen 21:1-8 Isaac is born and circumcised.

Gen 21:9-16 Hagar and Ishmael cast out.

Gen 21:17-21 And GOD heard the voice of the lad; and the Angel of GOD called to Hagar out of Heaven, ... See not for GOD hath heard the voice of the lad where he is.

Gen 21:18 Arise, lift up the lad, and hold him in thine hand; for I will make him a great nation. Ishmael

## + Gen 22 The offering of Isaac

Gen 22:1 And it came to pass after these things, that GOD did tempt Abraham, and said unto him, Abraham: and he said, Behold, here I am.

Gen 22:2 And HE said, Take now thy son, thine only son Isaac, whom thou lovest and get thee unto the land of Moriah; and offer him there for a burnt offering upon one of the mountains which I will tell thee of.

## [Genesis] cont. 15

Gen 23:3-18 Abraham purchases the cave of Machpelah for 400 shekels of silver from Ephron, the son of Zohar.

Gen 23:19 Abraham buried Sarah in the cave of Machpelah before Mamre: the same is Hebron in the land of Canaan.

Gen 24 Abraham sends his servant to the land of Nahor, his brother, to find a wife for Isaac.

Gen 24:1-10 Abraham's servant departed and traveled unto Mesopotamia, unto the City of Nahor.

Gen 24:12 And he said, O LORD GOD of my master Abraham, I pray thee, send me good speed this day, and shew kindness unto my master Abraham.

Gen 24:15 And it came to pass before he had done speaking, that, behold, Rebekah came out, who was born unto Bethuel, son of Milcah, the wife of Nahor, Abraham's brother, with her pitcher upon her shoulder.

Gen 24:16-49 The servant visits with Rebekah's family.

+ Gen 24:58 ... I will go. Rebekah's FAITH

## [Genesis] cont. 16

Gen 24:59-60 Rebekah's parents send her to Isaac, and bless her.

⇒ Gen 24:64-67 Isaac takes Rebekah to become his wife.

Gen 25:1-4 Abraham marries Keturah and has many children by her.

Gen 25:5-6 Isaac is heir of all things and Abraham sends the concubines and their children away from him to the east.

Gen 25:7 Abraham 175 years old

⇒ Gen 25:8 Then Abraham gave up the ghost, and died in a good old age, and full of years; and was gathered to his people.

Gen 25:11 And it came to pass after the death of Abraham, that God blessed his son Isaac...

Gen 25:12-18 Generations of Ishmael

⇒ Gen 25:20 And Isaac was forty years old when he took Rebekah to wife, the daughter of Bethuel the Syrian of Padan-aram, the sister to Laban the Syrian.

→ Abraham a Syrian ←

## [Genesis] cont. 18

Gen 26:6-11 Isaac pretends Rebekah is his sister.

⇒ Gen 26:12 Then Isaac sowed in that land, and received in the same year an hundred fold: and the Lord blessed him.

Gen 26:13-16 Isaac becomes very great, and Abimelech asks him to leave.

Gen 26:23 Isaac goes to Beer-Sheba.

Gen 26:24 And the Lord appeared to him the same night and said I AM the God of Abraham, thy father: fear not, for I AM with thee, and will bless thee, and multiply thy seed for MY servant Abraham's sake.

Gen 26:26-31 Abimelech makes a covenant with Isaac.

Gen 26:32-33 ... we have found water.

⇒ And he called it Shebah: therefore the name of the city is BeerSheba this day.

Gen 26:34-35 Esau marries Hittite wives, which were a grief unto Isaac and Rebekah.

⇒ Gen 27:1-5 Isaac asks Esau to bring him venison, that he may give him a blessing.

## [Genesis] cont. 17

Gen 25:21-23 Rebekah conceives, and the children struggled within her. And she went to enquire of the Lord.

⇒ X X Gen 25:23 And the Lord said unto her, Two Nations are in thy womb, and two manner of people shall be separated from thy bowels, and the one people shall be stronger than the other people; and the elder shall serve the younger.

Gen 25:24-26 Birth of Esau and Jacob

Gen 25:28 And Isaac loved Esau, ... but Rebekah loved Jacob.

⇒ Gen 25:29-34 Esau sells his birthright to Jacob.

Gen 26:1-5 Isaac, because of a famine, goes to Gerar, to Abimelech King of the Philistines, who had a covenant with Abraham. (Gen 21:22-34).

Gen 26:2-3 The Lord appears to Isaac and tells him not to go to Egypt.

Gen 26:4 And I will make thy seed to multiply as the stars of heaven, and will give unto thy seed all these countries: and in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed.

## [Genesis] cont. 19

Gen 27:6-26 Rebekah helps Jacob to trick Isaac into a blessing.

⇒ + Gen 27:27 And he came near and kissed him... and blessed him, and said... God give thee of the deer of heaven, and the fatness of the earth, and plenty of corn and wine.

⇒ + Gen 27:29 Let people serve thee, and nations bow down to thee: be lord over thy brethren, and let thy mother's sons bow down to thee: cursed be every one that curseth thee, and blessed be he that blesseth thee.

⇒ Gen 27:41 Esau hated Jacob for receiving the blessing from his father ... and vowed to kill him.

Gen 27:42-46 Rebekah sends Jacob to her brother Laban, to Haran for safety.

Gen 28:1-5 Isaac sends Jacob to Padan-aram to live with relatives.

Gen 28:6-9 Esau marries the daughter of Ishmael

Gen 28:10-15 Jacob's Vision

⇒ + Gen 28:12 And he dreamed and behold a ladder set up on the earth and the top of it reached to Heaven: and Angels of God ascended and descended on it

## [Genesis] cont. 20

Gen 28:13 And behold, the LORD stood above it, and said, I AM the LORD GOD of Abraham, thy Father, and the GOD of Isaac: the land wherein thou liest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed.

Gen 28:14-15 ... in thee and in thy seed shall all the families of the earth be blessed. Are I AM with thee...

Gen 28:16-19 The stone of Beth-el.

Gen 28:20-22 Jacob's vow with the LORD.

Gen 28:22 And this stone, which I have set for a pillar shall be GOD's house: and of all that Thou shalt give me I will surely give the tenth unto Thee.

Gen 29:1-14 Jacob meets Rachel at Haran.

Gen 29:15-30 Jacob's covenant for Rachel: to work for Laban 7 years.

Laban deceives Jacob and gives him Leah instead. Jacob agrees to work another 7 years and receives Rachel.

Gen 29:31-35 Rachel is barren. Leah bears Reuben, Simeon, Levi, and Judah.

## [Genesis] cont. 22

Gen 31:17-18 Jacob leaves Padan-aram with family and belongings.

Gen 31:19-42 Laben pursues Jacob.

Gen 31:43-55 Jacob and Laben make a covenant between them at Galeed.

⇒ Gen 31:28 Jacob with Laben for 20 Years

Gen 32:1-2 Jacob begins his journey and meets the Angels of GOD and calls the place Mahaneim.

Gen 32:3-6 Jacob sends messengers ahead to his brother Esau, in Seir, the country of Edom. They return with news of Esau and 400 hundred men coming.

Gen 32:7-8 Jacob divides the people and herds into two herds, so that at least one group might escape an attack from Esau.

Gen 32:9-12 Jacob prays to the GOD of Abraham, our LORD.

Gen 32:13-23 Jacob sends a present to Esau, and his family across the river Jabbok.

Gen 32:24-27 Jacob wrestles with the Angel of the LORD.

Gen 32:28 And he said, Thy name shall be called No More Jacob, but Israel: for as a Prince hast thy power with GOD and with men, and prevailed

## [Genesis] cont. 21

Gen 30:6-8 Bilhah, Rachel's maid, bares Jacob sons, Dan and Naphtali.

Gen 30:10-13 Zilpah, Leah's maid, bares Jacob sons, Gad and Asher.

Gen 30:14-21 Leah bares Jacob sons, Issachar and Zebulun, and daughter, Dinah.

→ Gen 30:22-24 Rachel bares Jacob a son, Joseph.

Gen 30:25-31 Jacob asks Laben to leave with his family and possessions.

Gen 30:31-41 Jacob chooses the spotted and spotted cattle, sheep and goats.

Gen 30:42 The feeblest flocks were Laban's and the strongest Jacob's.

Gen 30:43 And the men increased exceedingly, and had much cattle, and maid servants, and men servants, and camels and asses.

Gen 31:11 And the angel of GOD spake unto me in a dream saying, Jacob: And I said, Here am I.

Gen 31:13 I AM the GOD of Beth-el where thou anointedst the pillar, and where thou vowedst a vow unto me: now arise, get thee out from this land and return to the land of thy kindred.

## [Genesis] cont. 23

Gen 33 Jacob meets his brother Esau.

Gen 33:1-7 Jacob and Esau greet each other. Jacob presents his family and herds.

Gen 33:8-11 Jacob again insists that Esau receive the gifts presented.

Gen 33:12-20 Esau returns to Seir. Jacob journeys to Sacoeth and Shechem and purchases land. Jacob builds an alter to the LORD.

Gen 34 Dinah, the daughter of Leah, is defiled by 'Shechem, the son of Hamon the Hivite.

Gen 34:24 Hamor and Shechem and all the males are circumcised.

Gen 34:25 And it came to pass on the third day, when they were sore, that two of the sons of Jacob, Simeon and Levi, Dinah's brethren, took each man his sword, and came upon the city boldly, and slew all the males.

Gen 34:26 And they slew Hamor and Shechem his son with the edge of the sword, and took Dinah out of Shechem's house, and went out.

Gen 35:1-5 GOD commands Jacob to go to Bethel

## [Genesis] cont. 24

Gen 35:2-5 Jacob puts away idols from his family.

Gen 35:6 So Jacob came to Luz, which is in the land of Canaan that is Beth-el, he and all the people that were with him.

Gen 35:7 And he built there an altar, and called the place El-beth-el: because there GOD appeared unto him, when he fled from the face of his brother.

Gen 35:9-15 GOD appears to Jacob again

Gen 35:10 GOD renames Jacob to Israel

Gen 35:11 And GOD said unto him:

I AM GOD ALMIGHTY: be fruitful and multiply; a nation and a company of nations shall be of thee, and kings shall come out of thy loins;

Gen 35:12 And the land which I gave Abraham and Isaac, to thee I will give it, and to thy seed after thee will I give this land.

Gen 35:18 Pharaoh, Rebekah's nurse dies.

Gen 35:16-20 Rachel dies in childbirth of Benjamin.

Gen 35:28-29 Isaac dies at age 180 years

## [Genesis] cont. 26

Gen 40:1-9 Joseph interprets the dreams of Pharaoh's Chief Butler and Chief Baker.

Gen 40:10-15 Joseph foresees the Butler returned to Pharaoh as before.

Gen 40:17-19 Joseph foresees the Baker is to be hanged.

Gen 40:20-22 The predictions come true.

Gen 40:23 Yet did not the chief butler remember Joseph, but forgat him.

Gen 40:8 Joseph tells them that interpretation of dreams belong to GOD.

Gen 41:1-8 Pharaoh has two dreams, which no one can tell the meaning.

Gen 41:9-13 The chief butler tells Pharaoh of Joseph.

Gen 41:16 And Joseph answered Pharaoh, saying, it is not in me: GOD shall give Pharaoh an answer of peace.

Gen 41:17-24 Pharaoh tells of the two dreams: Seven good sheep followed and eaten by seven evil sheep - Then Seven good ears of wheat followed and destroyed by seven withered ears of wheat.

Gen 41:25 And Joseph said unto Pharaoh, the dream of Pharaoh is one: GOD has showed Pharaoh what HE is about to do.

## [Genesis] cont. 25

Gen 35:29 Esau and Jacob bury Isaac.

Gen 36 The generations of Esau, who is Edom.

Gen 37:1-4 Joseph is loved by Jacob, but hated by his brothers. Jacob makes him a coat of many colours.

Gen 37:5-17 Joseph has dreams that portray him as ruler over his family.

Gen 37:18-27 ... they conspired to slay Joseph and threw him into a pit.

Gen 37:28 Joseph is sold for 20 pieces of silver.

Gen 37:36 And the Midianites sold him into Egypt unto Potiphar, an officer of Pharaoh's, and captain of the guard.

Gen 38 Tamar plays the harlot and deceives Judas.

Gen 39:1-6 Joseph becomes the leader of Potiphar's house.

Gen 39:7-19 Potiphar's wife tempts Joseph and falsely accuses him.

Gen 39:20-22 Potiphar imprisons Joseph. The LORD helps Joseph who gains favor and is placed in charge of all prison activities.

Gen 39:23 The LORD causes Joseph to prosper

## [Genesis] cont. 27

Gen 41:29-30 Joseph foretells of 7 years of plenty followed by 7 years of famine.

Gen 41:33-49 Pharaoh appoints Joseph over all of Egypt. Food is gathered and stored for 7 years, the sixth part is saved.

Gen 41:56-57 Famine is over all the Earth and all people come to Joseph to buy corn.

Gen 42:1-5 Jacob sends 10 sons to Egypt to buy corn, for the famine was in Canaan.

Gen 42:6-8 The sons of Israel appear before Joseph, who was governor in Egypt. Joseph recognizes his brethren, but they knew not him.

Gen 42:9-38 Joseph sends his brethren home with corn. He holds his brother Simeon captive for them to return with Benjamin, Joseph's brother.

Gen 43 Israel finally agrees to send Benjamin to Egypt for the famine was sore in the land.

Gen 43:33-34 His brethren dine with Joseph.

Gen 44:1-2 Joseph commands his steward to fill his brothers' sacks with food and their money. Also the silver cup is placed in Benjamin's sack.

## [Genesis] cont. 28

Gen 44:3-11 The Brothers leave for home, and Joseph instructs his servant to overtake them.

Gen 44:12 And he searched and began at the eldest and left at the youngest; and the cup was found in Benjamin's sack.

Gen 44:13-14 They all return to Egypt.

Gen 44:15 And Joseph said unto them, What deed is this that ye have done?...

Gen 44:16-30 Joseph says that Benjamin must remain as his servant.

Gen 44:31-33 Judah explains that if Benjamin does not return with them, that their father, Israel, will die. Judah offers to remain as a servant that Benjamin might return to his father.

⇒ Gen 45 Joseph reveals himself

Gen 45:1-2 Joseph wept aloud and...

Gen 45:3 And Joseph said unto his brethren,

I am Joseph; doth my father yet live? And his brethren could not answer him; for they were troubled at his presence.

Gen 45:7-8 Joseph explains that God sent him to Egypt to preserve life.

Gen 45:9-27 Joseph sends his brethren home.

## [Genesis] cont. 30

Gen 47:27-28 And Israel and his family lived in Goshen, in Egypt, until he was 147 years of age.

⇒ Gen 47:29-31 Joseph promises his father that he will not bury him in Egypt, but with his fathers.

Gen 48:1-8 Joseph visits his dying father, Israel.

Gen 48:9-22 Israel blesses Joseph's sons. He blesses the younger son, Ephraim, over the older son Manasseh. Ephraim is to become a multitude of nations.

⇒ Gen 49:22 Israel blesses each of his twelve sons and tells of their future. Each will become a tribe of Israel.

⇒ Gen 49:29 And he charged them, I am to be gathered unto my people; bury me with my fathers in the cave that is in the field of Ephron the Hittite.

Gen 49:30-33 Israel, who was Jacob, died.

Gen 50 Joseph returns to Canaan to bury Jacob. After Israel's burial, Joseph and his brethren return to Egypt.

⇒ Gen 50:15-20 Joseph reassures his brethren. He means them no harm; it was God's Plan. Joseph lived 110 years. ← Gen 50:22

## [Genesis] cont. 29

Gen 45:28 And Israel said, It is enough; Joseph my son is yet alive: I will go and see him before I die.

Gen 46 Israel journeys to Egypt.

Gen 46:1-4 God's promises to Israel.

Gen 46:3 And HE said I AM GOD, the GOD of thy father: Fear not to go down unto Egypt; for I will there make of thee a great nation.

Gen 46:5-27 Israel and his family go to Egypt: all the souls of Israel (Jacob) were threescore and ten - 70; and they came into the land of Goshen.

⇒ Gen 46:28-34 Joseph meets his father and his brethren.

Gen 46:30 And Israel said unto Joseph, Now let me die, since I have seen thy face, because thou art yet alive!

Gen 47:1-6 Pharaoh gives the land of Goshen to Joseph and his family.

Gen 47:13-23 The Famine is so bad that all people, land and herds become the property of Pharaoh. Joseph buys them all for Pharaoh in exchange for food.

Gen 47:26 Pharaoh receives the fifth part
