

[Genesis] cont 40

Gen 46:4 I will go down with thee into Egypt; and I will also surely bring thee up again: and Joseph shall put his hand upon thine eyes.

Gen 46:5 And Jacob rose up from Beer-Sheva: and the sons of Israel came with Jacob their father, and their little ones, and their wives, in the wagons which Pharaoh had sent to carry them.

Gen 46:6 And they took their cattle, and their goods, which they had gotten in the land of Canaan, and came into Egypt, Jacob, and all his seed with him.

Gen 46:26 All the souls that came with Jacob into Egypt, which came out of his loins, beside Jacob's sons wives, all the souls were threescore and six;

Gen 46:27 And the sons of Joseph, which were born him in Egypt, were two souls: all the souls of the house of Jacob, which came into Egypt, were threescore and ten.

Gen 46:28 And he sent Judah before him unto Joseph, to shew his face unto Goshen; and they came into the land of Goshen.

Gen 46:29 And Joseph made ready his chariot, and went up to meet Israel his father, to Goshen, and presented himself unto him; and he fell on his neck, and wept on his neck a good while.

Gen 46:30 And Israel said unto Joseph, Now let me die, since I have seen thy face, because thou art yet a live.

Gen 46:33 And it shall come to pass, when Pharaoh shall call you, and shall say, What is your occupation?

Gen 46:34 That ye shall say, Thy servants' trade hath been about cattle from our youth even until now, both we, and also our fathers: that ye may dwell in the land of Goshen; for every shepherd is an abomination unto the Egyptians.

Gen 47:5 And Pharaoh spoke unto Joseph, saying, Thy father and thy brethren are come into thee. 47:6 The land of Egypt is before thee; in the best of the land make thy father and brethren to dwell; in the land of Goshen let them dwell...

Gen 47:13 And there was no bread in all the land; for the famine was very sore, so that the land of Egypt and all the land of Canaan fasted by reason of the famine.

Gen 47:14-17 The people give up their cattle to Joseph for food.

Gen 47:18-19 The people give up their land and themselves to Joseph for food.

Gen 47:20-21 And Joseph bought all the land of Egypt for Pharaoh; for the Egyptians sold every man his field... And as for the people he removed them to cities from one end of the land to the other...

Gen 47:23 Then Joseph said unto the people, Behold, I have bought you this day and your land for Pharaoh...

Gen 47:26 And Joseph made it a law over the land of Egypt unto this day, that Pharaoh should have the fifth part; except for the land of the priests only, which became not Pharaoh's.

Gen 47:27 And Israel dwelt in the land of Egypt, in the country of Goshen; and they had possessions therein, and grew, and multiplied exceedingly.

Gen 47:28 And Jacob lived in the land of Egypt seventeen years: so the whole age of Jacob was and he had died eighty and seven years.

Gen 47:29-31 Joseph promises his father that he will not bury him in Egypt, but with his fathers.

Gen 48:1 And it came to pass after these things, that one told Joseph, Behold, thy father is sick: and he took with him his two sons, Manasseh and Ephraim.

Gen 48:11 And Israel said unto Joseph, I had not thought to see thy face: and, lo, GOD hath shewed me also this.

Gen 48:15 And he blessed Joseph, and said, GOD, before whom my fathers Abraham and Isaac did walk, the GOD which fed me all my life long, unto this day.

Gen 48:16 The Angel which redeemed me from all evil, bless the lads, and let my name be named on them, and the name of my father Abraham and Isaac; and let them grow into a multitude in the midst of the earth.

Gen 48:21 And Israel said unto Joseph, Behold, I die, but GOD shall be with you and bring you again into the land of your fathers.

Gen 49 Jacob blesses each son and tells of their future.

Gen 49:29 And he charged them, I am to be gathered unto my people; bury me with my fathers in the cave that is in the field of Ephraim the Hittite.

Gen 49:30 In the cave that is in the field of Machpelah, which is before Mamre, in the land of Canaan, which Abraham bought with the field of Ephraim the Hittite, for a possession of a buryingplace.

Gen 49:33 And when Jacob had made an end of commanding his sons, he gathered up his feet unto the bed, and yielded up the spirit, and was gathered unto his people.

Gen 50 Joseph returns to Canaan to bury Jacob.

Gen 50:14 And Joseph returned into Egypt, he and his brethren, and all that went up with him to bury his father, after he had buried his father.

Gen 50:15-18 Brethren of Joseph fear he will hurt them after Jacob's death.

Gen 50:19 And Joseph said unto them, Fear not: for am I in the place of GOD? But as for you, ye thought evil against me; but GOD made it into good, to bring to pass, as it is this day, to save much people alive.

Gen 50:20-22 And Joseph died in Egypt, he and his father Joseph: and Joseph lived an hundred and ten years.
