

Exodus

8-12-17

Ex 1:6 Joseph and his brethren and their generation all die.

Ex 1:7 And the children of Israel were fruitful, and increased abundantly, and multiplied, and waxed exceeding mighty; and the land was filled with them.

Ex 1:8-14 The Egyptians became fearful of Israel, and put them under hard bondage: yet they still continue to prosper.

Ex 1:15-22 Pharaoh commands that the newborn sons of Israel be cast into the river.

Ex 2:1-10 Moses is born

Ex 2:2-3 Moses is hidden first by his mother then in a small ark in the river.

Ex 2:4-10 Moses is raised by the daughter of Pharaoh.

Ex 2:11-14 Moses kills an Egyptian who was mistreating a Hebrew.

Ex 2:15-22 He flees to the land of Midian and marries Zipporah the daughter of the Midian priest Reuel (Jethro).

Ex 2:23-25 GOD hears the cries of the Israelites under their bondage.

HE remembers HIS covenant with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

Exodus cont. 2

Ex 4:20-28 Moses returns to Egypt, and meets with Aaron.

Ex 4:29 And Moses and Aaron went and gathered together all the elders of the children of Israel:

Ex 4:30 And Aaron spake all the words which the LORD had spoken unto Moses, and did the signs in the sight of the people.

Ex 4:31 And the people believed: and when they heard that the LORD had visited the children of Israel, and that HE had looked upon their affliction, then they bowed their heads and worshipped.

Ex 5:1 And afterward Moses and Aaron went in, and told Pharaoh, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Let my people go, that they may hold a feast unto ME, in the wilderness.

Ex 5:2-7 Pharaoh says No and increases the burdens upon the people.

Ex 5:8-21 The people appeal to Moses.

Ex 5:22-23 Moses prayer to the LORD.

Ex 6 The LORD responds to Moses

Exodus cont.

Exodus 3 Moses talks with GOD!

Ex 3:1-6 GOD appears to Moses in a burning bush.

Ex 3:6 Moreover HE said, I AM the GOD of thy father, the GOD of Abraham, the GOD of Isaac, and the GOD of Jacob. And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon GOD.

Ex 3:7-10 GOD sends Moses to deliver Israel.

Ex 3:11-15 The name JEHOVATH.

Ex 3:14 And GOD said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and HE said, Thus shalt thou say unto the Children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.

Ex 3:16-12 The Deliverance of the Israelites is promised.

Ex 4 Moses has objections about Leading the People.

Ex 4:1-9 "They will not believe me". GOD gives Moses power to work miracles.

Ex 4:10-17 "I am not eloquent". GOD explains how Aaron, his brother, will speak for him.

Ex 4:18 Moses asks Jethro, his father in law, permission to return to Egypt.

Exodus cont. 3

Ex 6:1 The LORD foretells of HIS action against Pharaoh.

Ex 6:2 And GOD spake unto Moses, and said unto him, I AM the LORD:

Ex 6:3 And I appeared to Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, by the name of GOD ALMIGHTY, but by MY name JEHOVATH was I not known to them.

Ex 6:4-9 GOD renews HIS promise.

Ex 6:10-13 Moses and Aaron again sent to Pharaoh.

Ex 6:14-30 The history of the family of Moses and Aaron.

Ex 7:1-6 Moses and Aaron are encouraged by the LORD.

Ex 7:7 And Moses was 80 years old and Aaron was 83 years old when they spake to Pharaoh.

Plagues Ex 7:8-13 The rods turned into serpents.

Ex 7:14-25 The river is turned into blood.

Ex 8:1-15 The plague of frogs.

Ex 8:16-19 The plague of lice.

Ex 8:20-32 The plague of flies.

Ex 9:1-7 The murrain (deadly disease) of beasts.

Exodus cont. 4

Ex 8:22-23 The LORD separates the land of Goshen, where Israel lived, from all the plagues falling upon Egypt.)

Ex 9:4-6 The cattle of Israel not affected, the cattle of Egypt all died.

Ex 9:8-12 The plague of Boils.

⇒ Ex 9:13-35 The plague of Fire and Hail.

Ex 9:26 Only in the land of Goshen, where the children of Israel were, was there no hail.

Ex 10:1-20 The plague of Locusts.

8-21-17 Ex 10:21-29 The plague of thick darkness.

Ex 11 The LORD foretells the death of the Firstborn of Egypt.

Ex 11:1-3 The LORD has the people of Israel to prepare for their departure.

Ex 11:4-10 Moses is told to warn Pharaoh about the death of the firstborn.

Ex 12 The Passover is begun.

Ex 12:1-2 The First Month of the Hebrew Calendar is changed to April, to align with the Month of Passover.

Ex 12:3-11 A lamb is to be sacrificed with the blood used to mark the doors of Hebrew homes.

Exodus cont. 6

Ex 13:17-18 The LORD leads the people of Israel through the wilderness of the Red Sea, not the short way through the land of the Philistines.

Ex 13:19 And Moses took the bones of Joseph with him.

Ex 13:21-22 And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of cloud, to lead them by the way; and by night in a pillar of fire, to give them light; to go by day and night...

Ex 14:1-22 Moses parts the Red Sea.

The Pillar of the LORD holds back the Egyptians, while Israel crosses over dry land amidst the Red Sea.

Ex 14:14 The LORD shall fight for you, and ye shall hold your peace.

Ex 14:23-25 The Egyptians pursued them into the midst of the Red Sea and the LORD attacked the Egyptians.

Ex 14:26 The LORD tells Moses to stretch out his hands upon the sea, that the waters may be upon the Egyptians.

⇒ Ex 14:27-29 The Egyptians drown!

Ex 14:30-31 The people saw the great work of the LORD and believed!

Exodus cont. 5

Ex 12:12 For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the Firstborn in the land of Egypt, both Man and Beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgement: I AM the LORD.

Ex 12:13 And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, who I smite the land of Egypt.

⇒ Ex 12:29-30 At Midnight, the Death of the Firstborn of Egypt.

Ex 12:31-36 Israel is asked to leave by Pharaoh.

Ex 12:37-50 All of Israel to keep the Passover

⇒ Ex 12:51 The LORD brings out the house of Israel by their armies that same day!

Ex 13:1-2 The Firstborn of Israel, both of Man and Beast to be the LORD's

⇒ Ex 13:3 The people commanded to Remember the Passover on an annual basis.

Exodus cont. 7

Ex 15:1-21 The song of Moses for the deliverance of Israel.

Ex 15:20-21 Miriam the prophetess, the sister of Aaron and Moses, led the women in Singing Praise to the LORD.

Ex 15:22 Moses brings the people of Israel to the wilderness of Shur.

Ex 15:23-26 The bitter waters found at Marah, are turned unto sweet.

Ex 15:26 ... If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy GOD, and wilt do that which is right in HIS sight, and wilt give ear to HIS commandments, and keep all HIS statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon you, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I AM the LORD that healeth thee.

Ex 15:27 They came to Elim, an oasis with 12 wells of water and 70 palm trees

Ex 16:1-12 The children of Israel murmured against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness of Sinai.

Ex 16:13-21 GOD sends quails and manna.

⇒ Ex 16:23-30 The people gather food for six days. They rested on the seventh day, the sabbath.

[Exodus] cont. 8

Ex 16:35 And the children of Israel did eat manna forty years, until they came unto the borders of the land of Canaan.

Ex 17:1-7 The people murmur for water at Rephidim, and GOD sendeth it from a rock.

Ex 17:8-13 Amalek attacks Israel at Rephidim. Joshua leads Israel against the enemy and prevails while Moses' arms are raised. Amalek is destroyed.

Ex 17:14-16 Moses writes anentorials in a book and builds an altar to the LORD and called the name of it JEHOVAH-Nissi:

Ex 18:1-6 Jethro, the priest of Midian takes to Moses his wife Zipporeh and their two sons.

Ex 18:13-27 Jethro counsels Moses to set up judges for the people.

The first court system.

Ex 19:1-6 Moses ascends Mt. Sinai to hear the words of the LORD. HE shares HIS desire to take the people of Israel and treat them as HIS special family if they will follow HIS commandments and keep the covenant with HIM.

[Exodus] cont. 10 Commandments

① Ex 20:3 Thou shalt have no other gods before ME.

Ex 20:4 Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing...

② Ex 20:5 Thou shalt not bow down thyselfs unto them: for I the LORD thy GOD AM a jealous GOD.

③ Ex 20:7 Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy GOD in vain...

④ Ex 20:8 Remember the Sabbath day to keep it holy.

⑤ Ex 20:12 Honour thy father and thy mother...

⑥ Ex 20:13 Thou shalt not kill.

⑦ Ex 20:14 Thou shalt not commit adultery.

⑧ Ex 20:15 Thou shalt not steal.

⑨ Ex 20:16 Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor.

Ex 20:17 Thou shalt not covet:

thy neighbor's house, thy neighbor's wife, thy neighbor's manservant, ... nor any thing that is thy neighbor's.

[Exodus] cont. 9

Ex 19:7-8 Moses returns to the people and asks them to Follow the LORD. They all agree.

Ex 19:9-15 The people are directed to prepare to hear the Words of the LORD.

*** Ex 19:16-25 The presence of GOD on Sinai.

Ex 19:19 And when the voice of the trumpet sounded, and waxed louder and louder Moses spake, and GOD answered him by a Voice.

*** Ex 20 → The Ten Commandments

Ex 20:1 And GOD spake all these words saying:

Ex 20:2 I AM the LORD thy GOD, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.

[Exodus] cont. 11

Ex 21 Hebrew Laws - Judgements

Ex 21:1-11 Laws respecting servants

Ex 21:17 And he that curseth his father or mother, shall surely be put to death.

Ex 21:24 Eye for an eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot.

Ex 22 Laws against falsehood and injustice

Ex 23:10-19 The year of rest, The sabbath, the Three Festivals

Ex 23:8 And thou shalt take no gift: for the gift blindeth the wise, and perverteth the words of the righteous

Ex 23:7 Keep thee far from a false matter

Ex 23:9 Also thou shalt not oppress a stranger

Ex 23:14 Three times thou shalt keep a feast unto ME in the year.

The Passover, Pentecost-Firstfruits, Tabernacles,

Ex 23:20 Behold, I send an Angel before thee to keep thee in the way, and to bring thee into the place which I have prepared.

Ex 23:21 Beware of him, and obey his voice, ... do all that I speak.

Ex 23:25 And ye shall serve the LORD your GOD, and HE shall bless thy bread, and thy water, and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee.

[Exodus] cont. 12

Ex 24:1-8 Moses is called up into the mountain. The people promise obedience.

Ex 24:9-11 The Glory of the LORD appears.

Ex 24:12-18 Moses and his minister Joshua rise up: and Moses went up into the Mount of GOD.

Ex 24:15-17 A cloud covered the Mount, And the Glory of the LORD abode upon mount Sinai for six days. On the Seventh day HE called unto Moses.

Ex 24:18 And Moses went into the midst of the cloud, and got him up into the mount: and Moses was in the mount Forty days & Forty nights.

Ex 25:1-9 What Israel shall offer for the making of the Tabernacle.

Ex 25:10-22 The Ark was a chest, in which the two tables of the Law, written with the Finger of GOD, were to be deposited.

Ex 25:23-40 The Table and Candlesticks of the Tabernacle.

Ex 26 Details of the Tabernacle

Ex 27 Details of the altar and the court of the Tabernacle.

[Exodus] cont. 14

Ex 30:1-10 The altar of incense

Ex 30:11-16 The ransom of souls

Ex 30:12 ... then shall they give every man a ransom for his soul unto the LORD, that there be no plague among them ...

Ex 30:15 Every person shall give a half a shekel, when they give an offering unto the LORD, to make an atonement for your souls.

Ex 30:17-38 Details of Worship.

Ex 31:1-11 Bezaleel and Aholiab appointed for the work of the Tabernacle.

Ex 31:12-17 The Sabbath observed.

Ex 31:15 Six days may work be done; but in the seventh is the sabbath of rest, holy to the LORD.

Ex 31:16 Wherefore the children of Israel shall keep the Sabbath, to observe the Sabbath throughout their generations, for a perpetual covenant.

Ex 31:17 ... for in Six Days the LORD made heaven and earth, and on the seventh day HE rested, and was refreshed.

Ex 31:18 And HE gave unto Moses when HE had made an end of commanding with him upon Mt. Sinai, two tables of testimony of stone, written with the Finger of GOD.

[Exodus] cont. 13

Ex 28 Aaron and his sons set aside for the priest's office.

Ex 28:2-34 Garments for Aaron and his sons. Bells

Ex 28:35 And it shall be upon Aaron to minister: and his sound shall be heard when he goeth in unto the Holy Place before the LORD, and when he cometh out, that he die not.

Ex 28:36 And thou shalt make a plate of pure gold, and grave upon it, like the engravings of a signet, HOLINESS TO THE LORD.

Ex 28:37-38 Gold plate on the Mitre or head dress.

Ex 29:1-37 The consecration of the priests,

Ex 29:38-46 Continual burnt offerings, ⇒ GOD's promise to dwell among Israel.

Ex 29:45 And I will dwell among the children of Israel, and will be their GOD.

Ex 29:46 And they shall know that I AM the LORD their GOD, that brought them forth out of the land of Egypt, that I may dwell among them: I AM the LORD their GOD.

[Exodus] cont. 15

Ex 32:1-6 The people cause Aaron to make a golden calf.

Ex 32:7 And the LORD said unto Moses, GO, get thee down; for thy people, which thou broaghtest out of the land of Egypt, have corrupted themselves.

Ex 32:8 ... they have made them a molten calf, and have worshipped it, and have sacrificed thereunto...

Ex 32:10-14 The LORD prepares to destroy the people, but Moses intercedes for them. Moses asks the LORD to remember HIS servants Abraham, Isaac, and Israel.

Ex 32:15-20 Moses descends from the mountain with the Two Stone Tablets of the Law, written by the LORD GOD. At the sight of the people and their idol Moses breaks them and destroys the golden calf.

Ex 32:21-29 Moses and the Levites slay 3,000 of the idolaters.

Ex 32:30-35 Moses prays for the people.

Ex 33:1-6 The LORD refuses to go with Israel.

Ex 33:7-11 The Tabernacle moved without the camp.

[Exodus] cont 16

Ex 33:9 And it came to pass, as Moses entered unto the tabernacle, the ^{ROR} cloudy pillar descended, and stood at the door of the tabernacle, and the LORD talked with Moses.

Ex 33:11 And the LORD spake unto Moses face to face as a man speaketh unto his friend...

Ex 33:12-23 Moses desires to see the Glory of GOD.

Ex 33:20 And HE said, thou canst not see MY face: for there shall no man see ME and live.

Ex 33:21 And the LORD said, Behold, there is a place by ME, and thou shalt stand upon a rock. (os FAITH)

Ex 33:22 And it shall come to pass while MY GLORY passeth by, that I will put thee in a clift of the rock, and I will cover thee with MY hand while I pass by:

Ex 33:23 And I will take away mine hand and thou shalt see MY Back Parts: but MY Face shall not be seen.

Ex 34 The LORD provides a 2nd set of Tables of Testimony.

[Exodus] cont. 18

Ex 36 Bezaleel and Aholiab chosen by the LORD for work on the Tabernacle. The work is begun.

Ex 37 The ark and alter are constructed

Ex 38 Construction of Sanctuary continues

Ex 38:26 The number of men who were 20 years old and above: 603,550.

Ex 39 The holy garments for Aaron.

Ex 39:43 And Moses did look upon all the work, and, behold, they had done it as the LORD commanded even so had they done it: and Moses blessed them.

Ex 40:1-2 April 1, os the second year, The Tabernacle is set up.

Ex 40:3 And thou shalt put therein the Ark of the Testimony, and cover the Ark with the Vail.

Ex 40:34-38 The Glory of the LORD fills the Tabernacle.

Ex 40:35-37 The Cloud of the Glory of the LORD rested on the Tabernacle, and Israel traveled not. When it was taken up, they traveled.

[Exodus] cont 17

Ex 34:10-27 GOD's Covenant and Festivals

Ex 34:27 And the LORD said unto Moses, Write thou these words: for after the tenor of these words I have made a covenant with thee and with Israel.

Ex 34:28 And he was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights; he did neither eat bread, nor drink water. And HE wrote upon the tables the words of the Covenant, the Ten Commandments. Ex 31:18

Ex 34:29-35 Moses face shined after being in the presence of the Glory of GOD. He wore a vail when speaking with men.

Ex 34:34 But when Moses went in before the LORD to speak with HIM, he took the vail off, until he came out. And he came out, and spake unto the children of Israel that which he was commanded.

Ex 35 Moses reminds the people of the Sabbath and asks them to make an offering unto the LORD, of all the things needed for the Tabernacle and the ark of the Covenant.

[Exodus] cont. 19

Ex 40:38 For the Cloud of the LORD was upon the Tabernacle by day, and fire was on it by night, in the sight of all the house of Israel, throughout all their journeys.
