

Exodus

Ex 1:6 And Joseph died, and all his brethren, and all that generation.

Ex 1:7 And the children of Israel were fruitful, and increased abundantly, and multiplied, and waxed exceeding mighty; and the land was filled with them.

Ex 1:8 Now there arose up a new king over Egypt, which knew not Joseph.

Ex 1:9 And he said unto his people, Behold, the people of the children of Israel are more and mightier than we...

Ex 1:11 Therefore they did set over them taskmasters to afflict them with their burdens. And they built for Pharaoh treasure cities, Pithon and Raamses.

Ex 1:14 And they made their lives bitter with hard bondage...

Ex 1:15-22 Pharaoh commands that the newborn sons of Israel be cast into the river.

Ex 2:1-10 Moses is born

Ex 2:1 And there went a man of the house of Levi, and took to wife a daughter of Levi.

Ex 2:2 And the woman conceived and bore a son: ... she hid him three months.

Ex 2:3 And when she could not longer hide him, she took for him an ark of bulrushes, and daubed it with slime and with pitch, and put the child therein; and she hid it in the flags by the river's brink.

Exodus cont. 1

Ex 2:5 And the daughter of Pharaoh came down to wash herself at the river; and her maidens walked along by the river's side; and when she saw the ark among the flags, she sent her maid to fetch it.

Ex 2:6 And when she opened it, she saw the child: and behold the babe wept. And she had compassion on him, and said, This is one of the Hebrews' children.

Ex 2:7-9 The child's mother nurses him for Pharaoh's daughter.

Ex 2:10 And the child grew, and she brought him into Pharaoh's daughter, and he became her son. And she called his name MOSES...

Ex 2:11-14 Moses kills an Egyptian who was mistreating a Hebrew.

Ex 2:15 Now when Pharaoh heard this thing, he sought to slay Moses. But Moses fled from the face of Pharaoh, and dwelt in the land of Midian.

Ex 2:16-22 Moses marries Zipporah, the daughter of the Midian priest, Reuel (Jethro).

Ex 2:23 And it came to pass in process of time, that the king of Egypt died: and the children of Israel sighed by reason of the bondage, and they cried, and their cry came up unto GOD by reason of the bondage.

Ex 2:24 And GOD heard their groaning, and GOD remembered his covenant with Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob.

Exodus cont. 2

Exodus 3 Moses talks with GOD!

Ex 3:1 Now Moses kept the flock of Jethro his father in law, the priest of Midian: and he led the flock to the backside of the desert, and came to the mountain of GOD, even to Horeb.

Ex 3:2 And the Angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush: and he looked, and behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed.

Ex 3:3 And Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt.

Ex 3:4 And when the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, GOD called unto him out of the midst of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses. And he said, here am I.

Ex 3:5 And HE said, Draw not nigh hither: put off thy shoes from off thy feet, for the place whereon thou standest is holy ground.

Ex 3:6 Moreover HE said, I AM the GOD of thy father, the GOD of Abraham, the GOD of Isaac, and the GOD of Jacob. And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon GOD.

Ex 3:7 And the LORD said, I have surely seen the affliction of my people which are in Egypt, and have heard their cry by reason of their taskmasters; for I know their sorrows.

Ex 3:8 And I AM come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians...

Exodus cont. 3

Ex 3:10 Come now therefore, and I will send thee into Pharaoh, that thou mayest bring forth my people, the children of Israel out of Egypt.

Ex 3:11 And Moses said unto GOD, Who am I, that I should go unto Pharaoh, and that I should bring forth the children of Israel out of Egypt?

Ex 3:12 And HE said, Certainly I will be with thee.

Ex 3:14 And GOD said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and HE said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.

Ex 3:15 And GOD said moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, The LORD GOD of your fathers, the GOD of Abraham, the GOD of Isaac, and the GOD of Jacob, hath sent me unto you: this is my name forever, and this is my memorial unto all generations.

Ex 3:19 And I am sure that the King of Egypt will not let you go, no, not by a mighty hand.

Ex 3:20 And I will smite out my hand, and smite Egypt with all my wonders which I will do in the midst thereof: and after that he will let you go.
