

Exodus cont. 12

Exodus 14:1-22 The Egyptians follow the children of Israel to the Red Sea. Moses follows the direction of the LORD to raise his rod and part the Red Sea. The Pillar of the LORD holds back the Egyptians, while Israel crosses over dry land amidst the Red Sea.

Ex 14:23 And the Egyptians pursued them into the midst of the Red Sea.

Ex 14:26 And the LORD said unto Moses, Stretch out thine hand over the sea, that the waters may come again upon the Egyptians...

Ex 14:27-29 The Egyptians drown at the hand of the LORD.

Ex 14:30 Thus the LORD saved Israel that day, out of the hand of the Egyptians: and Israel saw the Egyptians dead upon the sea shore.

Ex 14:31 And Israel saw that great work which the LORD did upon the Egyptians: and that people feared the LORD, and believed the LORD, and his servant Moses.

Ex 15:1-21 The song of Moses for the deliverance of Israel.

Ex 15:18 The LORD shall reign for ever and ever.

Ex 15:20 And Miriam, the prophetess, the sister of Aaron, took a timbrel in her hand: and all the women went out after her with timbrels and with dances.

Exodus cont. 13

Ex 15:22 So Moses brought Israel from the Red Sea, and they went out into the wilderness of Shur; and they went three days in the wilderness, and found no water.

Ex 15:24 And the people murmured against Moses...

Ex 15:25 And he cried unto the LORD; and the LORD showed him a tree, which when he had cast into the water, the waters were made sweet: there he made a statute and an ordinance, and there he proved them.

Ex 15:26 And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy GOD, and wilt do that which is right in HIS sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I AM the LORD that healeth thee.

Ex 15:27 And they came to Elim, where were twelve wells of water, and threescore and ten palm trees: and they encamped there by the waters.

Ex 16:2 And the whole congregation of the children of Israel murmured against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness:

Ex 16:13-21 GOD sends quails and manna.

Exodus cont. 14

Ex 16:4 Then said the LORD unto Moses, Behold, I will rain bread from heaven for you;...

Ex 16:13 And it came to pass that at even the quails came up, and covered the camp; and in the morning the dew lay round about the feet.

Ex 16:14 And when the dew that lay upon the face of the wilderness there lay a small round thing...

Ex 16:15 And when the children of Israel saw it, they said... it is manna...

Ex 16:15 ... And Moses said unto them, This is the bread which the LORD hath given you to eat.

Ex 16:23-25 Tomorrow is the rest of the holy sabbath.

Ex 16:25 Six days shall ye gather it; but on the seventh day, which is the sabbath, it shall be none.

Ex 16:30 So the people rested on the seventh day.

Ex 16:35 And the children of Israel did eat manna forty years... until they came into the borders of the land of Canaan.

Ex 17:1-7 The people murmur for water at Rephidim, and GOD smiteth out of a rock.

Ex 17:8 Then came Amalek, and fought with Israel at Rephidim.

Exodus cont. 15

Ex 17:11 And it came to pass when Moses held up his hand, that Israel prevailed: and when he let down his hand, Amalek prevailed.

Ex 17:13 And Joshua discomfited Amalek and his people with the edge of the sword.

Ex 17:14 And the LORD said unto Moses, Write this for a memorial in a book, and rehearse it in the ears of Joshua: for I will utterly cut off the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven.

Ex 17:15 And Moses built an altar, and called the name of it Jehovah-nissi:

Ex 18:1 When Jethro, the priest of Midian, Moses' father-in-law, heard of all that GOD had done for Moses and for Israel his people, and that the LORD had brought Israel out of Egypt;

Ex 18:2 Then Jethro... took Moses' wife Zipporah, ... and his two sons to meet him.

Ex 18:5 ... into the wilderness, where he encamped at the mount of GOD.

Ex 18:7-12 Moses entertains Jethro and praises the LORD.

Ex 18:13-27 Jethro counsels Moses to set up judges for the people. The first court system.

Ex 19:1 In the third month, when the children of Israel were gone forth out of the land of Egypt, the same day came they into the wilderness of Sinai.
