

[Exodus] cont. 16

Ex 19:3 And Moses went up unto GOD and the LORD called unto him out of the mountain, saying, Thus shalt thou say to the house of Jacob, and tell the children of Israel;

Ex 19:5 Now therefore, if ye will obey my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people: for all the earth is mine:

Ex 19:6 And ye shall be unto me a kingdom of priests, and an holy nation. These are the words which thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel.

Ex 19:7 And Moses came and called for the elders of the people, and laid before their faces all these words which the LORD commanded him.

Ex 19:8 And all the people answered together, and said, All that the LORD hath spoken we will do.

And Moses returned the words of the people unto the LORD.

Ex 19:9 And the LORD said unto Moses, Lo, I come unto thee, in a thick cloud, that the people may hear when I speak with thee, and believe thee forever. And Moses told the words of the people unto the LORD.

Ex 19:10-15 The people are directed to prepare to hear the law, and to be ready the third day.

Ex 19:16-25 The presence of GOD on Sinai.

[Exodus] cont. 17

Ex 19:16 And it came to pass on the third day, in the morning, that there were thunders and lightnings, and a thick cloud upon the mount; and the voice of the trumpet exceeding loud; so that all the people that was in the camp trembled.

Ex 19:17 And Moses brought forth the people out of the camp, to meet with GOD; and they stood at the nether part of the mount.

Ex 19:18 And Mount Sinai was altogether in a smoke, because the LORD descended upon it in fire: and the smoke thereof ascended as the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mount quaked greatly.

Ex 19:19 And when the voice of the trumpet sounded long, and waxed louder and louder, Moses spake, and GOD answered him by a voice.

Ex 19:20-25 Moses desired to charge the people not to come up to Sinai.

Ex 19:24 And the LORD said unto him, Away, get thee down, and thou shalt come up, thou, and Aaron with thee...

Ex 20 → The Ten Commandments

Ex 20:1 And GOD spoke all these words saying
Ex 20:2 I AM the LORD thy GOD, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.

Ex 20:3 Thou shalt have no other gods before me.

Ex 20:4 Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing...

Ex 20:5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them: for I the LORD thy GOD AM a jealous GOD...

Ex 20:7 Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy GOD in vain...

Ex 20:8 Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy.

Ex 20:12 Honour thy father and thy mother...

Ex 20:13 Thou shalt not kill.

Ex 20:14 Thou shalt not commit adultery.

Ex 20:15 Thou shalt not steal.

Ex 20:16 Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor.

Ex 21 Hebrew laws - Judgements

Ex 21:17 And he that curseth his father or his mother, shall surely be put to death.

Ex 21:24 Eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot.

Ex 22 Laws against falsehood and injustice

Ex 22:29 Thou shalt not delay to offer the first of thy ripe fruit and of thy liquors: the firstborn of thy sons, shalt thou give unto ME.

Ex 23:7 Keep thee far from a false matter...

Ex 23:8 And thou shalt take no gift: for the gift blindeth the wise, and perverteth the words of the righteous.

Ex 23:9 Also thou shalt not oppress a stranger.

Ex 23:14 Three times thou shalt keep a feast unto me in the year.

The Passover, Pentecost - First Fruits, Tabernacles

Ex 23:20 Behold, I send an Angel before thee, to keep thee in the way, and to bring thee into the place which I have prepared.
