

## Exodus cont. 20

Ex 24:1-8 Moses is called up into the mountain. The people promise obedience.

Ex 24:9-11 The glory of the LORD appears.

Ex 24:9 Then went up Moses, Aaron, Nadab, and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel.

Ex 24:10 And they saw the GOD of Israel: and there was under his feet as it were a paved work of a sapphire stone, and as it were the body of heaven in His cleanness.

Ex 24: And the LORD said unto Moses Come up to me into the mount, and be there: and I will give thee tables of stone, and a law, and commandments which I have written; that thou mayest teach them.

Ex 24:13 And Moses rose up, and his minister Joshua: and Moses went up into the mount of GOD.

Ex 24:16 And the glory of the LORD abode upon mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it six days: and the seventh day HE called unto Moses out of the midst of the cloud.

Ex 24:17 And the sight of the glory of the LORD was like devouring fire on the top of the mount in the eyes of the children of Israel.

## Exodus cont. 21

Ex 24:18 And Moses went into the midst of the cloud, and got him up into the mount: and Moses was in the mount forty days, forty nights.

Ex 25:1-9 What Israel shall offer for the making of the tabernacle.

Ex 25:10-22 The Ark was a chest in which the two tables of the law, written with the finger of GOD, were to be deposited.

Ex 25:23-40 The Table and Candlesticks of the tabernacle.

Ex 26 Details of the Tabernacle

Ex 27 Details of the altar and the court of the Tabernacle.

Ex 28 Aaron and his sons set aside for the priests' office.

Ex 28:2-34 Garments for Aaron and his sons - Bells

Ex 28:35 And it shall be upon Aaron to minister: and his sound shall be heard when he goeth in unto the holy place before the LORD, and when he cometh out, that he die not.

Ex 28:36 And thou shalt make a plate of pure gold, and grave upon it, like the engravings of a signet, HOLINESS TO THE LORD.

Ex 28:37-38 Gold plate on the mitre or head dress

Ex 29:1-37 The consecration of the priests

Ex 29:38-46 continual burnt offerings, GOD'S promise to dwell among Israel

Ex 29:45 And I will dwell among the children of Israel, and will be their GOD.

Ex 29:46 And they shall know that I AM the LORD their GOD, that brought them forth out of the land of Egypt, that I may dwell among them: I AM the LORD their GOD.

Ex 30:1-10 The altar of incense

Ex 30:11-16 The ransom of souls.

Ex 30:12 When thou takest the sum of the children of Israel after their number, thou shalt they give every man a ransom for his soul unto the LORD, when thou numberest them, that there be no plague among them...

Ex 30:15 The rich shall not give more, and the poor shall not give less than half a shekel, when they give an offering unto the LORD, to make an atonement for your souls.

Ex 30:11-38 The brass laver, the holy anointing oil, the perfume.

Ex 31:1-11 Bezaleel and Aholiab appointed for the work of the tabernacle

## Exodus cont. 23

Ex 31:15 Six days may work be done; but in the seventh is the sabbath of rest, holy to the LORD: whosoever doeth any work in the sabbath day, he shall surely be put to death.

Ex 31:16 Wherefore the children of Israel shall keep the sabbath, to observe the sabbath throughout their generations, for a perpetual covenant.

Ex 31:17 It is a sign between me and the children of Israel for ever: for in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, and on the seventh day HE rested, and was refreshed.

Ex 31:18 And HE gave unto Moses when HE had made an end of communing with him upon mount Sinai, two tables of testimony, tables of stone, written with the finger of GOD.

Ex 32:1-6 The people cause Aaron to make a golden calf.

Ex 32:7 And the LORD said unto Moses Go, get thee down - for thy people, which thou broughtest out of the land of Egypt, have corrupted themselves.

Ex 32:8 ... they have made them a molten calf, and have worshipped it, and have sacrificed thereunto...
