

[Exodus] cont. 20

Ex 24:1-8 Moses is called up into the mountain.
The people promise obedience.

Ex 24:9-11 The glory of the LORD appears.

Ex 24:10 Then went up Moses, Aaron, Nadab,
and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of
Israel.

Ex 24:10 And they saw the GOD of Israel: and
there was under his feet as it were a paved
work of a sapphire stone, and as it were
the body of heaven in HIS cleanness.

Ex 24:11 And the LORD said unto Moses, Come up
to me into the mount, and be there: and I will
give thee tables of stone, and a law, and
commandments which I have written; that
thou mayest teach them.

Ex 24:13 And Moses rose up, and his minister
Joshua: and Moses went up into the mount of GOD.

Ex 24:16 And the glory of the LORD abode
upon mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it
six days: and the seventh day HE called
unto Moses out of the midst of the cloud.

the LORD their GOD, that brought them forth
out of the land of Egypt, that I may dwell
among them: I AM the LORD their GOD.

Ex 30:1-10 The altar of incense

Ex 31:15 Six days may work before; but in the
seventh is the sabbath of rest, holy to the LORD:
whoever doeth any work in the sabbath day, he
shall surely be put to death.

Ex 31:16 Wherefore the children of Israel shall
keep the sabbath, to observe the sabbath throughout
their generations, for a perpetual covenant.

Ex 31:17 It is a sign between me and the
children of Israel for ever: for in six days
the LORD made heaven and earth, and on the
seventh day HE rested, and was refreshed.

Ex 31:18 And HE gave unto Moses when HE had
made an end of communing with him upon
mount Sinai, two tables of testimony,
tables of stone, written with the finger of GOD.

Ex 32:1-6 The people cause Aaron to make a
golden calf.
