

Exodus cont. 4

Ex 4:1 And Moses answered and said, But behold, they will not believe me, nor hearken unto my voice: for they will say, The LORD hath not appeared unto me.

Ex 4:2-9 The LORD shows Moses different signs to convince the people of Israel. ^{Red as saffron, Leprosy, Water to blood}

Ex 4:5 That they may believe that the LORD GOD of their fathers, the GOD of Abraham, the GOD of Isaac, and the GOD of Jacob, hath appeared unto thee.

Ex 4:10 And Moses said unto the LORD, O my LORD, I am not eloquent, neither heretofore, nor since thou hast spoken unto thy servant: but I am slow of speech, and of a slow tongue.

Ex 4:11 And the LORD said unto him, Who hath made man's mouth? or who maketh the dumb, or deaf, or the seeing, or the blind? have not I the LORD?

Ex 4:12 Now therefore go, and I will be with thy mouth, and teach thee what thou shalt say.

Ex 4:13 Moses says, send any, but me.

Ex 4:14 And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Moses, and he said, Is not Aaron the Levite thy brother? I know that he can speak well...

Ex 4:16 And he shall be thy spokesman, unto the people...

Exodus cont. 5

Ex 4:18 And Moses went and returned to Jethro his father in law, and said unto him, Let me go, I pray thee, and return unto my brethren which are in Egypt, and see whether they be yet alive. And Jethro said to Moses, go in peace.

Ex 4:19 And the LORD said unto Moses in Midian, Go, return into Egypt: for all the men are dead, which sought thy life.

Ex 4:20 Moses returns to Egypt and meets with Aaron.

Ex 4:29 And Moses and Aaron went and gathered together all the elders of the children of Israel:

Ex 4:30 And Aaron spake all the words which the LORD had spoken unto Moses, and did the signs in the sight of the people.

Ex 4:31 And the people believed: and when they heard that the LORD had visited the children of Israel, and that HE had looked upon their affliction, then they bowed their heads and worshipped.

Ex 5:1 And afterward Moses and Aaron went in, and told Pharaoh. Thus saith the LORD GOD of Israel, Let my people go, that they may hold a feast unto me, in the wilderness.

Ex 5:2 And Pharaoh said, Who is the LORD, that I should obey his voice, to let Israel go? I know not the LORD, neither will I let Israel go.

Exodus cont. 6

Ex 5:3 And they said, the GOD of the Hebrews hath met with us: let us go, we pray thee, three days' journey into the desert, and sacrifice to the LORD our GOD; lest he fall upon us with pestilence or with the sword.

Ex 5:4 And the king of Egypt said unto them, Wherefore do ye, Moses and Aaron, let the people from their works? get you into your burdens.

Ex 5:6 And Pharaoh commanded the same day...

Ex 5:7 Ye shall no more give the people straw to make brick, as heretofore: let them go and gather straw themselves.

Ex 5:8-21 The people appeal to Moses.

Ex 5:22 And Moses returned unto the LORD, and said, LORD, wherefore hast thou set evil against this people? why is it that thou hast set me?

Ex 5:23 For since I came to Pharaoh to speak in thy name, he hath set evil to this people; neither hast thou delivered thy people at all.

Ex 6:1 Then the LORD said unto Moses, Now shalt thou see what I will do to Pharaoh: for with a strong hand shall he, let them go, and with a strong hand shall he drive them out of his land.

Ex 6:2 And GOD spake unto Moses, and said unto him, I AM the LORD:

Exodus cont. 7

Ex 6:3 And I appeared to Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, by the name of GOD ALMIGHTY, but by name JEHOVAH was I not known to them.

Ex 6:4 And I have also established my covenant with them, to give them the land of Canaan, the land of their pilgrimage, whereas they were strangers.

Ex 6:5 And I have also heard the groaning of the children of Israel, whom the Egyptians keep in bondage; and I have remembered my covenant.

Ex 6:6 Wherefore say unto the children of Israel, I AM the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will rid you out of their bondage.

Ex 6:9 And Moses spake so unto the children of Israel: but they hearkened not unto Moses for anguish of spirit, and for cruel bondage.

Ex 6:10 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, 6:11 Go in, speak unto Pharaoh king of Egypt, that he let the children of Israel go out of his land.

Ex 7:1 And the LORD said unto Moses, See, I have made thee a god to Pharaoh: and Aaron thy brother shall be thy prophet.

Ex 7:2 Thou shalt speak all that I command thee: and Aaron thy brother shall speak unto Pharaoh, that he send the children of Israel out of his land.

Ex 7:3 And I will harden Pharaoh's heart, and multiply my signs and my wonders in the land of Egypt.
