

## Exodus cont. 8

Ex 7:4 But Pharaoh shall not listen into you, that I may lay my hand upon Egypt, and bring forth mine armies, and my people the children of Israel, out of the land of Egypt by great judgements.

Ex 7:5 And the Egyptians shall know that I AM the LORD, when I stretch forth mine hand upon Egypt, and bring out the children of Israel from among them.

Ex 7:6 And Moses and Aaron did as the LORD commanded them, so did they.

Ex 7:7 And Moses was four score years old, and Aaron four score and three years old, when they spoke unto Pharaoh.

Ex 7:8-13 The rove turned into serpents.

Ex 7:14-25 The river is turned into blood.

Ex 8:1-15 The plague of frogs.

Ex 8:16-19 The plague of lice.

Ex 8:20-32 The plague of flies.

Ex 9:1-7 The murrain (deadly disease) of beasts.

## Exodus cont. 9

Ex 11:1 And the LORD said unto Moses, Yet will I bring one plague more upon Pharaoh, and upon Egypt: afterwards he will let you go hence: when he shall let you go, he shall surely thrust you out home altogether.

Ex 11:3 And the LORD gave people forth in the sight of the Egyptians. Moreover the name Moses was very great in the land of Egypt in the sight of Pharaoh's servants, and in the sight of the people.

Ex 11:4 And Moses said thus saith the LORD, About midnight will I go out into the midst of Egypt:

Ex 11:5 And all the firstborn in the land of Egypt shall die from the birth of Pharaoh that sitteth upon his throne, even unto the birth of the maidservant that is behind the mill; and all the firstborn of beasts.

Ex 11:6 And there shall be a great cry throughout all the land of Egypt, since there was none like it, nor shall be like it any more.

Ex 11:7 But against any of the children of Israel shall not a dog move his tongue, against man or beast: that ye may know how that the LORD doth put a difference between the Egyptians and Israel.

## Exodus cont. 10

Ex 11:10 And Moses and Aaron did all these wonders before Pharaoh: and the LORD hardened Pharaoh's heart, so that he would not let the children of Israel go out of his land.

Ex 12:1-28 The Passover is begun.

Ex 12:1 And the LORD speak unto Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt saying,

Ex 12:2 This month shall be unto you the beginning of months: it shall be the first month of the year to you.

Ex 12:3 I speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the tenth day of this month, they shall take to them every man a lamb...

Ex 12:7 And they shall take of the blood, and strike it on the two side posts and on the upper door post of the houses, wherein they shall eat it.

Ex 12:12 For I will pass through the land of Egypt, this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both men and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgement: I AM the LORD.

Ex 12:13 And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt.

## Exodus cont. 11

Ex 12:29 And it came to pass, that at midnight the LORD smote all the firstborn in the land of Egypt from the firstborn of Pharaoh that sat upon his throne into the firstborn of the captive that was in the dungeon; and all the firstborn of cattle.

Ex 12:30-36 Israel is asked to leave by Pharaoh.

Ex 12:37-50 All of Israel to keep the Passover.

Ex 12:51 And it came to pass the selfsame day, that the LORD did bring the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt by their armies.

Ex 13:1 And the LORD speak unto Moses saying, 13:2 Speak unto ME all the firstborn, whatsoever opereth the work among the children of Israel, both of man and of beast: it is mine.

Ex 13:3 And Moses said unto the people, Remember this day, in which ye came out from Egypt, out of the house of bondage; for by strength of hand the LORD brought you out from this place: there shall no leaven bread be eaten.

Ex 13:19 And Moses took the bones of Joseph with him.

Ex 13:21-22 And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of a cloud, to lead them their way; and by night in a pillar of fire, to give them light, to go by day and night...
