

Leviticus

Lev 10:1 And Nadab and Abihu, the sons of Aaron, took either of them his censer, and put fire therein, and put incense thereon, and offered strange fire before the LORD, which He commanded them not.

Lev 10:2 And there went out fire from the LORD, and devoured them, and they died before the LORD.

Lev 11 Dietary Laws

Lev 11 The bird slain, and the live give a release, the two aspects of salvation in Rom 4:25 "delivered for our offences, and raised again for our justification".

Lev 15:16 And if any man's seed of copulation go out from him, then he shall wash all his flesh in water, and be unclean until the even.

Lev 15:18 The woman also with whom man shall lie with seed of copulation, they shall both bathe themselves in water, and be unclean until the even.

Lev 16:5 And he shall take of the congregation of the children of Israel two kinds of goats for a sin offering, and one ram for the burnt offering.

Lev 16:8 And Aaron shall cast lots upon the two goats; one lot for the LORD, and the other lot for the scapegoat.

Lev 16:9 And Aaron shall bring the goat upon which the LORD's lot fell, and offer him for a sin offering.

Lev 16:10 But the goat, on which the lot fell to be the scapegoat, shall be presented alive before the LORD, to make an atonement with him, and to let him go for a scapegoat into the wilderness.

Lev 16:29 October 10th, day of atonement - sabbath

Lev 17 Blood or food is forbidden

Leviticus cont.

Lev 17:11 For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul.

Lev 18:22 Thou shalt not lie with mankind, as with woman kind: it is an abomination.

Lev 19 Further Explanation of 10 commandments

Lev 20:6 And the soul that turneth after such as have familiar spirits, and after wizards, to go a whoring after them, I will set MY face against that soul, and will cut him off from among his people.

Lev 20:7-25 Avoid actions forbidden by the LORD, including lying with near kin and bests.

Lev 20:26 And ye shall be holy unto me; for I the LORD AM HOLY, and have severed you from other people, that ye should be mine.

Lev 23 The Feasts of the LORD.

Lev 23:1-3 The Sabbath

Lev 23:4-14 The Passover, the offering of first fruits

Lev 23:15-22 The feast of Pentecost

Lev 23:23-32 The feast of Trumpets, the day of atonement

Lev 23:33-44 The feast of Tabernacles.

Lev 23:15-16 The feast of Weeks, 50 days after the departure from Egypt, 50 days after the seven first of CHRIST the outpouring of the HOLY SPIRIT Pentecost

Lev 23:42 Ye shall dwell in booths seven days; all that are Israelites born shall dwell in booths:

Lev 23:43 that your generations may know that I made the children of Israel to dwell in booths, when I brought them out of the land of Egypt: I AM the LORD your GOD !!!

Leviticus cont. 2

Lev 24:16 And he that blasphemeth the name of the LORD he shall surely be put to death, and all the congregation shall certainly stone him: as well the stranger, as he that is born in the land, when he blasphemeth the name of the LORD, shall he be put to death.

Lev 24:17 And he that killeth any man shall surely be put to death.

Lev 24:19-20 And if a man cause a blemish in his neighbor, as he hath done, so shall it be done to him:

Breach for breach, eye for eye, tooth for tooth: as he hath caused a blemish in a man, so shall it be done unto him again.

Lev 24:22 Ye shall have one manner of law, as well for the stranger, as for one of your own country: for I AM the LORD your GOD.

Lev 25:1-7 Seventh year a year of rest Sabbath for land.

Lev 25:8-22 50th year a Jubilee. Trumpets sound on the Day of Atonement

Lev 25:23-34 Redemption of land and house, returned to original owners

Lev 25:35-38 Compassion towards the poor.

Lev 25:39-55 Bondmen and servants freed during Jubilee

Lev 25:55 For into ME the children of Israel are servants; they are MY servants whom I brought forth out of the land of Egypt: I AM the LORD your GOD.

Lev 26 The LORD promises blessings for obedience, and punishment for disobedience.
