Lev 9 The Priests begin their ministry,

Lev 9:23 And Moses and Aaron went into the Tabernacle of the Congregation, and came out and blessed the people; and the GLORY of the LORD appeared to all the people.

Lev 9:24 And there came a fire out from before the LORD, and consumed upon the altar the burnt-offering and the fat: which when all the people saw, they shouted and fell on their faces.

Lev 10 The Strange Fire of Nadab and Abihu.

Lev 10:1 The sons of Moses offer strange incense and fire without permission

Lev 10:2 And there went out fire from the LORD, and devoured them, and they died before the LORD.

Lev 10:3 Then Moses said unto Aaron, this is it that the LORD spoke, saying, I will be sanctified in them that come nigh ME, and before all the people I will be glorified.

We are sanctified by the Blood shed by JESUS CHRIST our LORD, so that we may be in the presence of GOD.

Lev 11 Dietary Laws

Lev 12 The Law of Motherhood

Lev 12:3 A male child shall be circumcised on the eighth day.

Lev 12:4-6 The Mother is purified 33 days for a male child and 66 days for a female child.

Lev 13 Directions concerning Leprosy.

Lev 14 The cleansing process for Leprosy

Lev 14:4-7 The bird slain and the live bird released, represent the two aspects of salvation in Rom 4:25 "delivered for our offences, and raised again for our salvation."

Lev 15 The cleansing of Males and Females

Lev 15:1-17 The cleansing of Males with an issue of skin or the spilling of seed.

Lev 15:18-33 The cleansing of Females having an issue of her blood (Flowers)

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Lev 16 The Scapegoat and the Day of Atonement.

Lev 16:1-4 Aaron, as High Priest, to enter into the Holy of Holies only on the Day of Atonement of Israel

Lev 16:5-28 Two goats are chosen.

Lev 16:8 And Aaron shall cast lots upon the two goats; one lot for the LORD, and the other lot for the scapegoat.

Lev 16:10 But the goat, on which the lot fell to be the scapegoat, shall be presented alive before the LORD, to make an atonement with HIM, and to let him go for a scapegoat into the wilderness.

Lev 16:29 October 10th, Day of Atonement

Lev 16:30 Heb 9:1-14 The Blood of JESUS CHRIST presented as an Atonement for our sins, that ye may be clean from all your sins before the LORD.

Lev 17 Only one place of sacrifice, through the priests, and Blood as food is for bidden.

Lev 17:11 For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul

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Lev 17:11 Foretells the Blood of CHRIST given for us.

Lev 18 Laws concerning physical relationships with close kin.

Lev 18:22 Thou shalt not lie with mankind as with womankind: it is abomination.

Lev 19 Further explanation of the LORD's Commandments.

Lev 19:18 Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself: I AM the LORD.

Lev 20:1-23 The people of Israel to keep the LORD's statutes, to separate themselves from the practices of those around them

Lev 20:24 But I have said unto you Ye shall inherit their land, and I will give it unto you to possess it, a land that floweth with milk and honey: I AM the LORD your GOD, which have separated you from other people.

Lev 20:26 And ye shall be holy unto ME: for I the LORD AM HOLY, and have covered you from other people, that ye should be Mine.

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Lev 21 The Priests are held to a higher moral standard, than others.

Lev 23:42 Ye shall dwell in booths seven
days; all that are Israelites born shall
dwell in booths:

Lev 23:43 That your generation may
know that I made the children of Israel
to dwell in booths, when I brought
them out of the land of Egypt:
I AM the LORD your GOD !!!

Lev 24 The laws covering Blasphemy
and Murder

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Lev 24:22 Ye shall have one manner
of law, as well for the stranger, as
for one of your own country: for
I AM the LORD your GOD.

Lev 25:1-7 The sabbath of rest for the
land in the seventh year.

Lev 25:8-22 50th year a Jubilee.
Trumpets sound on the Day of Atonement.

Lev 25:23-34 Redemption of Land and
Houses, returned to original owners.

Lev 25:35-38 Compassion towards
the poor.

Lev 25:39-55 Bondmen and servants are
freed during Jubilee.

Lev 25:55 For unto ME the children of Israel
are servants; they are MY servants
whom I brought forth out of the land
of Egypt: I AM the LORD your GOD.

Lev 26 The LORD promises blessings
for obedience, and punishment
for disobedience.
