

Numbers

Num 1:46 Even all they that were numbered were six hundred thousand and three thousand and five hundred and fifty.

Σ Num 1 The number of males twenty years and above: 603,550.

⊙ Num 1:47 But the Levites after the tribe of their fathers were not numbered among them.

✕ Num 1:50 But thou shalt appoint the Levites over the tabernacle of testimony, and over all the vessels thereof, and over all things that belong to it...

✕ Num 1:53 But the Levites shall pitch round about the tabernacle of testimony, that there be no wrath upon the congregation of the children of Israel; and the Levites shall keep the charge of the tabernacle of the testimony.

➤ Num 2 The tribes with their tents around the tabernacle of the testimony, by tribe, in a certain order.

Num 3:1-13 The Levites taken for the LORD in place of all the firstborn of Israel.

✕ Num 3:13 Because all the firstborn are mine; for on the day that I smote all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, I borrowed into me all the firstborn of Israel, both man and beast: mine shall they be: I AM the LORD.

Num 3:39 The Levites after numbered: 22,000

Σ Num 3:43 The firstborn males of Israel: 22,273

Num 4 The duties of the Levites

Num 4:43 Levites from 30 to 50 years of age served in the tabernacle.

Num 4:48 Even those that were numbered of them, were eight thousand and five hundred and fourscore.

Num 6 The law concerning Nazarites

✕ Num 6:2 ... When either man or woman shall separate themselves to vow a vow of a Nazarite, to separate themselves unto the LORD.

✕ Num 6:22-27 Blessings of the LORD

✕ Num 6:23 ... Or this wise ye shall bless the children of Israel, saying unto them,

Num 6:24 The LORD bless thee and keep thee;

Num 6:25 The LORD make HIS face shine upon thee, and be gracious unto thee;

Num 6:26 The LORD lift up HIS countenance upon thee, and give thee peace.

Num 6:27 And they shall put MY name upon the children of Israel; and I will bless them.

⊙ Num 11:16 And the LORD said unto Moses Gather unto me seventy men of the elders of Israel...

✕ Num 11:17 And I will come down and talk with thee there: and I will take of the spirit which is upon thee, and will put it upon them; and they shall bear the burden of the people with thee, that thou bear it not thyself alone.

Num 11:31-35 Quails are given to the people

Num 12:1 And Miriam and Aaron spoke against Moses...

✕ Num 12:9 And the anger of the LORD was kindled against them; and HE departed.

✕ Num 12:10 And the cloud departed from off the tabernacle, and behold Miriam became leprous, white as snow; and Aaron looked upon Miriam, and behold she was leprous.

⊙ Num 12:15 And Miriam was shut out from the camp seven days.

!!! Num 12:8 The LORD will speak to Moses face to face, not in a dream as to others who are prophets.

Num 13:1-20 Twelve men, one from each tribe are sent to search the land of Canaan.

➤ Num 13:25 And they returned from searching of the land after forty days.

Num 13:27 And they told him and said, We came into the land whither thou hast sent us, and search it floweth with milk and honey; and this is the fruit of it.

Numbers cont. 3

Num 13:28 Nevertheless the people be strong, they, and the cities are walled, and very great; and moreover we saw the children of Anak there.

✕ Num 13:30 And Caleb stilled the people before Moses, and said, Let us go up at once, and possess it; for we are well able to overcome it.

Num 13:31 But the men that went up with him said, We be not able to go up against the people, for they are stronger than we.

⊙ Num 13:33 And there we saw the giants, the sons of Anak, which sons of the giants; and we were in our own sight as grasshoppers, and so we were in their sight.

✕ Num 14:2 And all the children of Israel murmured against Moses and Aaron...

Num 14:1-4 Joshua and Caleb labor to still the people.

Num 14:5-10 The LORD wroth to destroy all the people, save Moses, Joshua, and Caleb. But, Moses pleads for them all to save them.

✕ Num 14:33-34 And your children shall wander in the wilderness forty years... After the number of days in which ye searched the land, even forty days, each day, for a year...

✕ Num 16 The rebellion of Korah, Dathan, and Abiram; and 250 princes rise up against Moses and Aaron.

Numbers cont. 4

Num 16:20-21 And the LORD spoke unto Moses and unto Aaron saying,

Separate yourselves from among this congregation, that I may consume them in a moment.

Num 16:22 And Moses rose up and went unto Dathan 16:25 and Abiram; and the elders of Israel followed him.

Num 16:26 And he spoke unto the congregation saying, Depart, I pray you, from the tents of these wicked men, and touch nothing of theirs, lest ye be consumed in all their sins.

Num 16:28 And Moses said, Surely ye shall know that the LORD hath sent me to do all these works; for I have not done them of mine own mind.

Num 16:32 And the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed them up, and their houses; and all the men that appertained unto Korah, and all their goods.

Num 16:33 They, and all that appertained to them, went down alive into the pit, and the earth closed upon them: and they perished from among the congregation.

Num 16:35 And there came out a fire from the LORD, and consumed the two hundred and sixty men that offered incense.

Num 16:41:50 The people murmur against Moses and Aaron, and a plague is sent and destroys 14,700 more people.

Numbers cont. 5

Num 17:1-7 Twelve rods, one from each tribe, with the name of its leader inscribed on it, laid up into the LORD.

Num 17:3 And thou shalt write Aaron's name upon the rod of Levi: for one rod shall be for the head of the house of their fathers.

Num 17:4 And thou shalt lay them up in the tabernacle ... where I will meet with you.

Num 17:5 And it shall come to pass, that the man's rod, whom I shall choose, shall blossom: and I will make to cease from me the murmurings of the children of Israel, whereby they murmur against you.

Num 17:8 And it came to pass, that on the morrow Moses went into the tabernacle of witness; and, behold, the rod of Aaron for the house of Levi was budded, and brought forth buds, and blossomed blossoms, and yielded almonds.

Num 17:10 And the LORD said unto Moses, bring Aaron's rod again before the testimony, to be kept for a token against the rebels ...

Num 18:1-7 The charge of the priests and Levites

Num 18:8-19 The priests' portion

Num 18:20-32 The Levites' portion

Num 18:21 And, behold, I have given the children of Levi all the tenth in Israel for an inheritance, for their service which they serve even the service of the tabernacle of the congregation.

Numbers cont. 6

Num 20 Israel complains about lack of water. The LORD tells Moses and Aaron to speak to the rock; instead they smote the rock twice. This was disobedience to the LORD, and they were not allowed to enter the promise land.

Num 20:2 And there was no water for the congregation; and they gathered themselves together against Moses and Aaron.

Num 20:6 And Moses and Aaron went from the presence of the assembly into the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and they fell upon their faces; and the glory of the LORD appeared unto them.

Num 20:7-8 And the LORD spoke unto Moses, saying, Take the rod, and gather thou the assembly together, thou and Aaron thy brother, and speak ye unto the rock, before their eyes; and it shall give forth his water, and thou shalt bring forth to them water out of the rock: so thou shalt give the congregation and their beasts drink.

Num 20:10 ... Heed now ye rebels; must we fetch you water out of this rock?

Num 20:11 And Moses lifted up his hand, and with his rod he smote the rock twice: and the water came out abundantly, and the congregation drank, and their beasts also.

Numbers cont. 7

Num 20:12 And the LORD spoke unto Moses and Aaron, Because ye believed me not, to sanctify ME in the eyes of the children of Israel, therefore ye shall not bring this congregation into the land which I have given them.

Num 20:14:21 The Israelites are refused a passage through Edom. Edom was Esau, brother of Jacob.

Num 20:22-29 Aaron receives the priest's office to Eleazar, his son, and dies in mount Horeb.

Num 20:24 Aaron shall be gathered unto his people: for he shall not enter into the land which I have given unto the children of Israel, because ye rebelled against MY WORD at the water of Meribah.

Num 20:28 And Moses stripped Aaron of his garments, and put them upon Eleazar his son; and Aaron died there in the top of the mount; and Moses and Eleazar came down from the mount.

Num 20:29 And when all the congregation saw that Aaron was dead, they mourned for Aaron thirty days, even all the house of Israel.

Numbers cont. 8

Num 22: The king of Moab, Balak, seeks to get Balaam to prophesy against Israel.

Num 22:9 And GOD came unto Balaam, and said, What men are these with thee?

X Num 22:12 And GOD said unto Balaam, Thou shalt not go with them; thou shalt not curse the people: for they are blessed.

Num 22:21 Thus Balaam rose up in the morning, and saddled his ass, and went with the princes of Moab.

X Num 22:22 And GOD's angel was bannetted because he went: and the angel of the LORD stood in the way for an adversary against him. Now he was riding upon his ass, and his two servants were with him.

X Num 22:23 And the ass saw the angel of the LORD standing in the way, and his sword drawn in his hand: and the ass turned aside out of the way, and went into the field: and Balaam smote the ass, to turn her into the way.

X Num 22:28 And the LORD opened the mouth of the ass, and she said unto Balaam, What have I done unto thee, that thou hast smitten me these three times?

Numbers cont. 9

Num 22:29 And Balaam said unto the ass, Because thou hast mocked me...

Num 22:31 Then the LORD opened the eyes of Balaam, and he saw the angel of the LORD standing in the way, and his sword drawn...

Num 22:32 And the angel of the LORD said unto him... behold I went out to withstand thee...

X Num 22:33 And the ass saw me, and turned from me these three times: unless she had turned from me, surely now also I had slain thee, and saved her alive.

Num 23 Balaam blesses Israel as the LORD commanded him, against Balak.

Num 24 Balaam prophesies the happiness of Israel

X Num 24:17 I shall see him, but not now: I shall behold him, but not nigh: there shall come a Star out of Jacob, and a Sceptre shall rise out of Israel, and shall smite the corner of Moab, and destroy all the children of Sheth.

Num 24:19 Out of Jacob shall come HE that shall have dominion, and shall destroy him that remaineth of the city.

Num 25 The Israelites enticed by daughters of Moab & M. Am.

Numbers cont. 10

Num 25:6-15 Phineas, Eleazar's son, puts Zimri & Cosbi to death

Num 25:7 And when Phineas... saw it he rose up from among the congregation, and took a javelin in his hand;

X Num 25:8 And he went after the man of Israel into the tent, and thrust both of them through, the man of Israel, and the woman through her belly. So the plague was stayed from the children of Israel.

X Num 25:9 And those that died in the plague were twenty and four thousand.

Num 26:1-51 Numbering in Israel in plains of Moab near Jericho - 601,763 Men 20+ in age

Num 26:52-56 Land is divided

Num 26:57-62 Number of the Levites: 23,000

X Num 26:64 But among these there was not a man of them whom Moses and Aaron the priest numbered, when they numbered the children of Israel in the wilderness of Sinai.

X Num 26:65 For the LORD had said of them, They shall surely die in the wilderness. And there was not left a man of them, save Caleb the son of Jephthah, and Joshua the son of Navi.

Numbers cont. 11

Num 27:1-11 The law of inheritance. The daughters of Manasseh ^{son of Joseph} give their inheritance.

X Num 27:12-14 Moses worried of his death.

Num 27:15-23 Joshua appointed to succeed Moses

X Num 27:18 And the LORD said unto Moses, Take the Joshua the son of Nun, a man in whom is the spirit, and lay thine hand upon him;

X Num 27:19 And set him before Eleazar the priest, and before all the congregation; and give him a charge in their sight.

X Num 27:20 And thou shalt put some of thine honour upon him, that all the congregation of the children of Israel may be obedient.

X Num 27:21 And he shall stand before Eleazar the priest, who shall ask counsel for him after the judgment of Urim before the LORD: at his word shall they go out, and at his word they shall come in, both he, and all the children of Israel with him, even all the congregation.

Num 27:22 And Moses did as the LORD commanded him...

Numbers | cont. 12

Num 32 The tribes of Reuben, Gad, and half the tribe of Manasseh request an inheritance on the east of Jordan.

✧ Num 34 The bounds or border of the promised land, are given. Borders of Israel.

Num 35 Cities given to the Levites from the land of the other tribes

✧ Num 35:7 Do all the cities which ye shall give to the Levites shall be forty, and eight cities....

Num 35:11 Then ye shall appoint your cities to be cities of refuge for you; that the slayer may flee thither, which killeth any person unawares.

✧ Num 35:12 And they shall be unto you cities for refuge from the avenger; that the manslayer die not, until he stand before the congregation in judgment.

Num 35:13 And of these cities which ye shall give, six cities shall ye have for refuge.

◇ Num 35:14 Ye shall give three cities on this side Jordan, and three cities shall ye give in the land of Canaan, which shall be cities of Refuge.
