

Deuteronomy

Deu 3:28 Moses asks the LORD to allow him to cross the river Jordan, to see the promised land.

Deu 3:26 But the LORD was wroth with me for your sakes, and would not hear me: and the LORD said unto me, Let it suffice thee: speak no more unto me of this matter.

Deu 3:27 Do it thee up unto the top of Pisgah, and lift up thine eyes westward, and northward, and southward, and eastward, and behold it with thine eyes: for thou shalt not go over this Jordan.

Deu 3:28 But charge Joshua and encourage him, and strengthen him: for he shall go over before thee people, and he shall cause them to inherit the land which thou shalt see.

Deu 4 Summary of Israel's travels

Deu 4:33 Did ever people hear the voice of GOD speaking out of the midst of the fire, as thou hast heard, and live?

Deu 4:36 Out of heaven HE made thee to hear HIS voice, that HE might instruct thee: and upon earth HE showed thee HIS great fire; and thou standest in words out of the midst of the fire.

Deu 4:41-49 Moses chooses three cities as refuge on the east side of Jordan.

Deuteronomy cont.

Deu 5:6-22 The Ten Commandments repeated

Deu 5:23-33 The people regret that the law be delivered through MOSES rather than directly from GOD, for they feared HIM.

Deu 6 Moses reminds the people that obedience to the commandments is necessary

Deu 6:4 Hear O Israel: The LORD our GOD is one LORD:

Deu 6:5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy GOD with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.

Deu 6:6 And these words which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart:

Deu 6:7 And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house...

Deu 7 Warning against involvement with inhabitants of the promised land.

Deu 7:3 Neither shalt thou make marriages with them...

Deu 7:4 For they will turn away thy son from following ME, that they may serve other gods: so will the anger of the LORD be kindled against thee suddenly.

Deu 7:6 For thou art a holy people unto the LORD thy GOD: the LORD thy GOD hath chosen thee to be a special people unto Himself, above all people that are upon the face of the earth.

Deuteronomy cont. 2

Deu 8:5 Thou shalt also consider in thine heart that, as a man chasteneth his son, so the LORD thy GOD chasteneth thee.

Deu 8:6 Therefore thou shalt keep the commandments of the LORD thy GOD, to walk in his ways, and to fear HIM.

Deu 8:10-20 Do not forget that it is GOD that make thee prosperous, NOT your own actions.

Deu 9 Moses reminds the people that they receive the fruits of the promised land by the GRACE of GOD, NOT by their own merit, for they have been greatly rebellious.

Deu 10:14 Behold, the heaven and the heaven of heavens is the LORD's thy GOD the earth also, with all that therein is.

Deu 10:17 For the LORD your GOD is God, of gods, and LORD of lords, a great GOD, a mighty, and a terrible, which regardeth not persons, nor taketh reward...

Deu 10:18 He doth execute the judgment of the fatherless and widow, and loveth the stranger, in giving him food and raiment.

Deu 10:19 Love ye therefore the stranger: for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt.

Deu 10:20 Thou shalt fear the LORD thy GOD: him shalt thou serve...

Deuteronomy cont. 3

Deu 10:22 Thy fathers went down into Egypt with threescore and ten persons: and now the LORD thy GOD hath made thee as the stars of heaven for multitude.

Deu 11 Careful study of GOD's word is required

Deu 11:18 Therefore shall ye lay up these my words in your heart and in your soul, and bind them for a sign upon your hand, that they may be frontlets between your eyes.

Deu 11:19 And ye shall teach them your children...

Deu 11:26 Behold I set before you this day a blessing and a curse;

Deu 11:27 A blessing, if you obey the commandments of the LORD your GOD, which I command you this day.

Deu 11:28 And a curse, if ye will not obey the commandments of the LORD your GOD, but turn aside out of the way which I command you this day, to go after other gods, which ye have not known.

Deu 12:5-32 The place of GOD's service to be kept.

Deu 12:13 Take heed to thyself that thou offer not thy burnt offerings in every place that thou seest:

Deu 12:14 But in the place that the LORD shall choose of one of thy tribes, there thou shalt offer thy burnt offerings, and there thou shalt do all that I command thee.
