Josh 7 Achan, of the tribe of Judah takes a part of the accursed thing. Israel is punished in warfare.

Josh 7:16-26 Achan is detected and destroyed by Israel

Josh 8 GOD encourages Joshua and instructs him in the ambush and taking of the city of Ai and its king.

Josh 8:1 And the LORD said unto Joshua, Fear not, neither be thou dismayed: take all the people of war with thee, and arise, go up to Ai: see, I have given into thy hand the king of Ai, and his people, and his city, and his land.

Josh 9 The Gibeonites deceive Joshua's men and are spared to become servants of Israel.

Josh 10 The five kings of the Amorites war against Gibeon and Israel... and are defeated by Joshua

Josh 10:12 Then spake Joshua to the LORD in the day when the LORD delivered up the Amorites before the children of Israel, and he said in the sight of Israel, Sun, stand thou still upon Gibeon; and thou Moon, in the valley of Ajalon.

Josh 10:13 And the sun stood still, and the moon stayed, until the people had avenged themselves upon their enemies... So the sun stood still in the midst of heaven, and hastened not to go down about a whole day.

Josh 10:14 And there was no day like that before it or after it, that the LORD heard into the voice of a man: for the LORD fought for Israel.

Josh 11 The LORD defeats the rest of the kings in the promised land through Joshua & Israel.

Josh 11:23... And the land rested from war.

Josh 12 31 Kings conquered by Moses & Joshua

Josh 13:1-6 Bounds of the land not yet conquered

Josh 13:7-33 Inheritance of Reuben

Josh 14 Nine and one half tribes given land west of Jordan River

Josh 14:4 For the children of Joseph were two tribes, Manasseh and Ephraim: therefore they gave no part unto the Levites in the land, save cities to dwell in, with their suburbs for their cattle and for their substance.

Josh 14:6-15 Caleb obtains Hebron as he was promised

Josh 18 Seven tribes remain to receive land

Josh 18:11-28 Benjamin - boundaries

Josh 19:49-50 Land of Joshua, son of Nun

Josh 19:51... So they made an end of dividing the country.

Josh 20 The six cities of refuge.

Josh 21 48 cities given to the Levites out of the tribes of Israel

Josh 21:45 There failed not ought of any good thing which the LORD had spoken into the house of Israel; all came to pass!

Josh 22 Reuben, Gad, 1/2 tribe of Manasseh build an altar of testimony. Israel is offended in fear of wrath of GOD. They explain to Israel that it is testimony to GOD, not an altar.

Josh 23 Joshua's Saremeel warning to Israel.

Josh 24:15-28 Joshua renews the covenant between the people and GOD

Josh 24:29 And it came to pass after these things, that Joshua the son of Nun, the servant of the LORD, died, being an hundred and ten years old.

Josh 24:31 And Israel served the LORD all the days of Joshua, and all the days of the elders that overlived Joshua, and which had known all the works of the LORD, that he had done for Israel.

Josh 24:32 And the bones of Joseph, which the children of Israel brought up out of Egypt, buried they in Shechem... (Joseph also lived to be 110 years of age.)

Josh 24:33 And Eleazar, the son of Aaron, died: and they buried him in a hill that pertained to Phineas his son, which was given him in mount Ephraim.
