# Deuteronomy cont.

Deu 5:6-22 The Ten Commandments repeated for the current generation of Israel

Deu 5:23-33 The people request the law be delivered through Moses, rather than directly from GOD, for they feared HIM.

Deu 6 Moses reminds the people that obedience to the commandments is necessary

Deu 6:4 Hear O' Israel: The LORD our GOD is one LORD: "Great Commandment"

Deu 6:5 And thou shalt Love the LORD thy GOD with all thine heart and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.

Deu 6:6 And those words which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart:

Deu 6:7 And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children...

Deu 7 Warnings against involvement with inhabitants of the promised land.

Deu 7:34 Marriages for bidden... for they will cause you to worship idols.

Deu 7:6 For thou art an holy people unto the LORD thy GOD: the LORD thy GOD hath chosen thee to be a special people unto HIMSELF above all people that are upon the face of the earth.

Deu 1 Moses spoke to the people as the LORD commanded him, reviewing the wilderness travels, and their disobedience

Deu 2:1-7 The Edomites to be spared

Deu 2:8-37 The Moabites, Ammonites, and Amorites to be destroyed.

Deu 3:1-20 Og King of Bashan, and all their people destroyed.

Deu 3:12-20 The land given to Reuben, Gad, and 1/2 Manasseh - east of Jordan.

Deu 3:21-29 Moses prevented from seeing the Promised Land but Joshua to be strengthened and encouraged.

Deu 4 Summary of Israel's travels

Deu 4:33 Did ever people hear the Voice of GOD speaking out of the midst of the fire, as thou hast heard and live?

Deu 4:36 Out of heaven HE made thee to hear HIS voice, that HE might instruct thee: and upon earth HE showed thee HIS great signs, and thou heardest HIS words out of the midst of the fire.

Deu 4:41-49 Moses chooses three cities of refuge on the east side of Jordan.

# Deuteronomy cont. 2

Deu 8:3... that HE might make thee know that man doth not live by bread only, but by every word that proceedeth out of the Mouth of the LORD doth men live.

Deu 8:5 Thou shalt also consider in thine heart that, as a man chasteneth his son, so the LORD thy GOD chasteneth thee.

Deu 8:6 Therefore thou shalt keep the commandments of the LORD thy GOD, to walk in HIS ways, and to fear HIM.

Deu 8:10-20 Do not forget that it is GOD that make thee prosperous, NOT your own actions.

Deu 9 Moses reminds the people of their poor behavior, and that they receive the fruits of the promised land by the GRACE of GOD, NOT by their own worthiness, for they have been greatly rebellious.

Deu 10:1-11 Moses reminds the people of GOD's mercies after their rebellion and how HE gave the second time, two tables of stone on which HE wrote the 10 Commandments.

Deu 10:12-12 Obedience Required

# Deuteronomy cont. 3

Deu 10:17 For the LORD your GOD is GOD of gods, and LORD of Lords; a great GOD...

Deu 10:22 Thy fathers went down into Egypt with threescore and ten persons; and now the LORD thy GOD hath made thee as the stars of heaven for multitude.

Deu 11:1 Therefore thou shalt love the LORD thy GOD, and keep HIS charge, and HIS statutes, and HIS judgements, and HIS commandments, always.

Deu 11 Careful study of GOD's word is required

Deu 11:18 Therefore shall ye lay up these My Words in your heart and in your soul...

Deu 11:19 And ye shall teach them your children.

Deu 11:26 Behold I set before you this day a blessing and a curse.

Deu 11:27 A Blessing if you obey the commandments of the LORD your GOD...

Deu 11:28 And a curse if ye will not...

Deu 12:1-4 Conditions of Blessings in the Land.

Deu 12:5-32 The place of GOD's service to be kept.

Deu 13 Beware of false prophets, who might lead you to follow other gods.

## Deuteronomy cont. 4

Deu 13:6-11 Beware of others, even relatives who might lead you astray!

⇒ Deu 14:22-29 Tithing - giving to the LORD

Deu 15:1 At the end of every seven years, thou shalt make a release. Forgive Debts

Deu 15:11 For the poor shall never cease out of the land: therefore I command thee, saying, Thou shalt open thine hand wide unto thy brother, to thy poor, and to thy needy in thy land.

⇒ Deu 16 The Laws of the yearly Feasts are repeated: the Passover, the Pentecost, the Tabernacles.

Deu 17 All sacrifices to be perfect, Idolaters to be stoned: The choice of a king, and his duties.

Deu 18:1-8 The provisions made for Levites.

Deu 18:9-14 The abominations of the Canaanites to be avoided.

Deu 18:15 The LORD thy GOD will raise up unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto ME; unto HIM ye shall hearken.

+++ Deu 18:15-22 CHRIST the GREAT PROPHET

Deu 18:21-22 How to tell a True Prophet, if it comes to pass, it is from the LORD, if not, then merely words of a man.

## Deuteronomy cont. 5

Deu 19:1-13 The cities of refuge.

Deu 19:15-21 The punishment of False witnesses

Deu 20 The laws of war.

Deu 21 Laws concerning captive wives, stubborn sons, etc.

Deu 22:5 The woman shall not wear that which pertaineth unto a man, neither shall a man put on a woman's garment; for all that do so are an abomination unto the LORD thy GOD.

Deu 23 Many regulations or rules

⇒ Deu 23:17-18 Prostitution forbidden. And Sodomity

Deu 23:19 Law of Usury.

Deu 23:21 When thou shalt vow a vow unto the LORD thy GOD, thou shalt not slack to pay it: for the LORD thy GOD will surely require it of thee; and it would be sin in thee.

Deu 24:1-4 Law of divorce.

⇒ Deu 24:16 The fathers shall not be put to death for the children, neither shall the children be put to death for the fathers: every man shall be put to death for his own sin.

⇒ Deu 24:17-22 Thou shalt help take care of the widow, the fatherless, and the stranger.

Deu 25 More regulations and rules

⇒ Deu 26:5 Jacob, a Syrian, went down to Egypt and became a mighty nation.

## Deuteronomy cont. 6

Deu 27:1-10 The Law to be written on great stones and placed on Mount Ebal.

⇒ Deu 27:9 And Moses and the priests, the Levites, spake unto all Israel, saying, Take heed and hearken,

⇒ O' Israel, this day thou art become the people of the LORD thy GOD.

Deu 27:11-26 Curses for disobedience to be announced from Mount Ebal; Blessings for obedience to be announced from Mount Gerizim.

⇒ Deu 28:1-14 MANY BLESSINGS for obedience to the LORD.

Deu 28:15-44 Curses for disobedience.

Deu 28:45-68 Their Ruin for continued disobedience.

Deu 29 The Palestinian Covenant

Deu 29:29 The secret things belong unto the LORD our GOD; but those things that are revealed belong unto us and to our children for ever, that we may do all the words of this law.

Deu 30 Further information on the Palestinian Covenant.

⇒ Deu 31:1-8 Moses encourages the people and Joshua

## Deuteronomy cont. 7

Deu 31:6 Be strong and of a good courage, sear not, nor be afraid of them: for the LORD thy GOD, HE it is that doth go with thee; HE will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.

Deu 31:9-13 The law to be read every seventh year.

⇒ Deu 31:14-22 The LORD tells Moses of the future transgressions of Israel.

Deu 31:22-30 The law delivered unto the Levites.

Deu 32 The Song of Moses

Deu 32:4 HE is the Rock, HIS work is perfect for all HIS ways are judgment a GOD of truth and without iniquity, just and right is HE.

⇒ Deu 32:48-52 Moses to go up mount Nebo to die.

Deu 33 Moses blesses each tribe of Israel.

Deu 33 Simon is omitted from the blessing.

Deu 34 The LORD shows Moses the Promised Land

Deu 34:7 Moses was 120 years old when he died: his eye was not dim, nor his force abated.

Deu 34: ... Moses who, whom the LORD know face to face!!
