

Judges cont. 4

Jud 13:19 So Manoah took a kid with a milk offering, and offered it upon a rock into the LORD: and the angel did wondrously; and Manoah and his wife looked on.

Jud 13:20 For it came to pass, when the flames went up toward heaven from off the altar, that the angel of the LORD ascended in the flame of the altar, and Manoah and his wife looked on it, and fell on their faces, to the ground.

Jud 13:24 And the woman bore a son, and called his name Samson; and the child grew, and the LORD blessed him.

Jud 13:25 And the Spirit of the LORD began to move him at times in the camp of Dan, between Zorah and Eshtaoel.

Judges 14-16 Samson is the thirteenth judge.

Jud 14:1-4 Samson desires a wife of the Philistines.

Jud 14:5-9 Samson kills a lion

Jud 14:10-20 Samson's riddle

Jud 14:19 And the SPRIT of the LORD came upon him, and he went down to Ashkelon, and slew thirty men of them, and took their skirts, and gave change of garments into them which expounded the riddle.

Jud 15:1-3 Samson is denied his wife

Jud 15:4 And Samson went and caught three hundred foxes, and took firebrands, and turned tail to tail, and put a firebrand in the midst between two tails.

Judges cont. 5

Jud 15:5 And when he had set the brands on fire, he let them go into the standing corn of the Philistines, and burnt eye both the shoulder, and also the standing corn, with the vineyards and olives.

Jud 15:6 Samson's wife is burned with Simeon

Jud 15:9:17 Samson kills a thousand Philistines with a jawbone of an ass.

Jud 15:20 And he judged Israel in the days of the Philistines twenty years.

Jud 16 Samson and Delilah

Jud 16:16 And it came to pass, when she pressed him daily with her words, and urged him, so that his soul was vexed unto death;

Jud 16:17 But he told her all his heart, and said unto her, There hath not come a razor upon my head; for I have been a Nazarite unto GOD from my mother's womb: if I be shaven, then my strength shall go from me, and I shall become weak, and be like any other man.

Jud 16:18-21 The Philistines take Samson and put out his eyes.

Jud 16:22-31 Samson's strength is renewed and he destroys many of the Philistines.

Jud 16:30 And Samson said, let me die with the Philistines... and the house fell upon the lord and all the people (3,000+)... so the dead which he slew at his death were more than they which he slew in his life.

Judges cont. 6

Jud 17:1-6 The beginning of idolatry in Israel, Micah and his mother.

Jud 17:6 In those days there was no king in Israel, but every man did that which was right in his own eyes.

Jud 17:7-13 Micah hires a Levite to be his priest.

Jud 18:1-7 Five men of Dan are sent as spies to the land of Zidon and find the Levite in Micah's house, near mount Ephraim.

Jud 18:8 The six hundred men of Dan kill the Zidonians and take the Levite from mount Ephraim.

Jud 18:28... And they built a city, and dwelt therein.

Jud 18:29 And they called the name of the city Dan, after the name of Dan their father, who was born into Israel: howbeit the name of the city was Laiish at the first.

Jud 19:1 And it came to pass in those days, when there was no king in Israel, that there were certain Levites sojourning on the side of mount Ephraim who took to him a concubine out of Bethlehem-Judah.

Jud 19:14 And they went on their way; and the sun was down upon them when they were by Gibeah, which belongeth to Benjamin.

Jud 19:15-28 The men of Gibeah abuse his concubine and she dies.

Jud 19:29-30 The Levite cuts her into twelve pieces and sends her to 12 tribes.

Judges cont. 7

Jud 20:1-20 All of Israel rise up against Gibeah and the tribe of Benjamin in a civil war.

Jud 20:21-23 Benjamin defeats Israel the first day and kills twenty and two thousand men.

Jud 20:24-26 In the second battle, Benjamin kills eighteen thousand.

Jud 20:27 And the children of Israel enquired of the LORD, (for the ark of the covenant of GOD was there in those days.)

Jud 20:28-45 Israel defeats Benjamin in the third battle.

Jud 20:46 So that all that fell that day of Benjamin were twenty and five thousand men that drew the sword; all these were men of valour.

Jud 20:47 But six hundred men turned and fled to the wilderness into the route of Kimmon, and abode in the route Kimmon four months.

Jud 20:48 And the men of Israel turned again upon the children of Benjamin, and smote them with the edge of the sword, as well the men of every city, as the best beast, and all that came to herd; also they set on fire all the cities that they came too.
