

Judg 1 Incomplete victories of Israel.

Judg 2 After Joshua, Israel began to worship other gods, and inter married with other peoples

X Judg 2:1-5 An Angel of the LORD visits the people of Israel to rebuke them for disobedience.

Judg 2:6-23 The wickedness of the new generation after Joshua.

=> Judg 2:16 Nevertheless the LORD raised up judges which delivered them out of the hand of those that spoiled them.

=> Judg 3 Several Nations remain unconquered that they may be used to test Israel for Faithfulness.

X Judg 3:7 And the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the LORD, and forgot the LORD their GOD, and served Baalim and the groves.

Judg 3:8-11 Othniel, Caleb's brother, the first judge, delivers Israel.

Judg 3:12-30 Ehud, the second judge, delivers Israel from Eglon.

X Judg 3:31 Shagar, the third judge, delivers Israel by killing Six Hundred Philistines.

Judg 4 Deborah and Barak, the fourth & fifth judges

Judg 4:1-3 Israel is evil again, and the LORD allows them to be ruled by Jabin king of Canaan, and Sisera his captain of the army

Judg 4:4-9 Deborah convinces Barak to lead an army against Sisera in the name of the LORD

=> Judg 4:10-24 Sisera is defeated and flees to the tent of Heber, whose wife Jael kills him with a tent stake through his forehead.

Judg 5 the Song of Deborah and Barak, a review of the LORD's victory

Judg 5:31 ... And the land had rest 40 years.

◇ Judg 6:1-24 An Angel of the LORD appears to Gideon.

Judg 6:25-32 Gideon destroys Baal's altar,

X Judg 6:33-40 GOD gives Gideon two signs: first - the fleece is wet on dry ground. second - the fleece is dry on wet ground.

Judg 7:9-15 the defeat of Midian by Gideon.

Judg 7:16-25 The LORD tells Gideon to use only 300 men to defeat Midian, 120,000

=> Judg 7:22 And the three hundred blew the trumpets, and the LORD set every man's sword against his fellow even throughout the host.. (they slew themselves)

=> Judg 8:23 And Gideon said unto them I will not rule over you, neither shall my son rule over you: the LORD shall rule over you!

=> Judg 8:28 ... And the country was in quietness forty years in the days of Gideon.

X Judg 9 Abimelech conspires to kill his 70 brethren He and conspirators in Shechem killed by the LORD

Judges cont.

Judg 10:2 Tola, the seventh judge for 23 years

Judg 10:3 Jair, the eighth judge for 22 years

Judg 11 Jephthah of Gilead, the ninth judge.

X Judg 11:34-40 Jephthah's daughter given in death

Judg 12 Ephraimites quarrel with Jephthah He and men of Gilead slay 42 Thousand men of Ephraim.

Judg 12:8-15 Ibzan, Elon, Abdon 10-12 Judges.

Judg 13:1 The children of Israel did evil again, and the LORD delivered them into the hands of the Philistines forty years

X Judg 13:2-20 An angel of the LORD appears to Manoah and his wife of the tribe of Dan, who would become the parents of Samson.

=> Judg 13:5 For, lo, thou shalt conceive and bear a son; and no razor shall come on his head: for the child shall be a Nazarite unto GOD from the womb; and he shall begin to deliver Israel out of the hands of the Philistines.

Judg 13:24 And the woman bare a son, and called his name Samson; and the child grew, and the LORD blessed him.

=> Judg 13:25 And the SPIRIT of the LORD began to move him at times in the camp of Dan, between Zorah and Eshtaol.

Judg 14-16 Samson is the thirteenth judge

Judges cont 3

Judg 14:1-4 Samson desires a wife of the Philistines.

Judg 14:5-9 Samson kills a lion.

Judg 14:10-20 Samson's riddle.

Judg 14:19 And the SPIRIT of the LORD came upon him, and he went down to Ashkelon, and slew thirty men of them, and took their spoil, and gave change of garments unto them which expounded the riddle.

Judg 15:1-3 Samson is denied his wife.

Judg 15:4-5 Samson catches three hundred foxes and uses them to burn the crops of the Philistines.

Judg 15:6 Samson's wife is burned with fire.

X Judg 15:9-17 Samson kills a thousand Philistines with a jawbone of an ass.

=> Judg 15:20 And he judged Israel in the days of the Philistines twenty years.

Judg 16 Samson and Delilah

=> Judg 16:16-17 Delilah is relentless in her efforts to discover Samson's secret to strength; that she might betray him.

Judg 16:18-21 The Philistines take Samson and put out his eyes.

Judg 16:22-31 Samson's strength is renewed and he destroys many of the Philistines (3,000+) at his death.

[Judges] cont 4

Judg 17:1-6 The beginning of Idolatry in Israel, Micah and his mother.

Judg 17:7-13 Micah hires a Levite to be his priest.

Judg 17:6 In those days there was no king in Israel but every man did that which was right in his own eyes.

Judg 18:1-7 Five men of Dan are sent as spies into the land of Zidon and find the Levite in Micah's house, near Mount Ephraim.

Judg 18:8-21 Six hundred men of Dan kill the Zidonians and take the Levite from mount Ephraim.

Judg 18:28-29 ... And they built a city and dwelt therein.

Judg 18:29 And they called the name of the city Dan, after the name of Dan, their father, who was born unto Israel: howbeit the name of the city was Laish at the first.

Judg 19:1 The Levite takes a wife or concubine from Bethlehem-Judah.

Judg 19:14 They travel to Gibeah, which belongeth to Benjamin.

Judg 19:15-28 The men of Gibeah abuse his concubine and she dies.

Judg 19:29-30 The Levite cuts her into twelve pieces and sends her to 12 tribes of Israel.

Judg 20:1-20 All of Israel rise up against Gibeah and the tribe of Benjamin in a Civil War.

[Judges] cont.5

Judg 20:21-26 Benjamin defeats Israel in the first battle and kills 22,000 and also the second battle and kills 18,000.

Judg 20:27-45 Israel enquires of the LORD (for the ark of the covenant of GOD was there in those days.)

Israel defeats Benjamin in the third battle and kills 25,000.

Judg 20:47 Six hundred men of Benjamin escape to Rimmon and abide there 4 months.

Judg 20:48 Israel burns the cities of Benjamin and kills remaining other than 600.

Judg 21:1-11 Twelve thousand men destroy the people of Jabesh-Gilead who did not fight with them against Benjamin.

Judg 21:12-14 400 virgins of Jabesh-Gilead are given to the 600 men of Benjamin at Rimmon to re-establish the tribe.

Judg 21:15-23 The remaining 200 men of Benjamin are allowed to capture wives at the feast of Shiloh, from those who danced.

Judg 21:25 In those days, there was no king in Israel; every man did that which was right in his own eyes.
