

## I Samuel

I Sam - the history of Samuel, the last of the judges.

I Sam 1:3-8 Hannah and her husband Elkanah go to Shiloh to worship the LORD.

I Sam 1:9 So Hannah rose up after they had eaten in Shiloh, and after they had drunk. Now Eli, the priest, sat upon a seat by a post of the temple of the LORD.

I Sam 1:10 And she was in bitterness of soul, and prayed unto the LORD, and wept sore.

I Sam 1:11 And she vowed a vow, and said, O LORD of hosts, if thou wilt, look indeed on the affliction of thine handmaid, and remember me, and not forget thine handmaid, but will give unto thine handmaid a man child, then I will give him unto the LORD all the days of his life, and there shall no razor come upon his head.

I Sam 1:13 Now Hannah, she spoke in her heart; only her lips moved, but her voice was not heard: therefore Eli thought she had been drunken.

I Sam 1:14 And Eli said unto her, How long wilt thou be drunken? put away thy wine from thee.

I Sam 1:15 And Hannah answered and said, No, my lord, I am a woman of a sorrowful spirit; I have drunk neither wine nor strong drink, but have poured out my soul before the LORD.

## I Samuel cont.

I Sam 1:17 Then Eli answered and said, Go in peace: and the God of Israel grant thee thy petition that thou hast asked of him.

I Sam 1:20 Wherefore it came to pass, when the time was come about after Hannah had conceived, that she bare a son, and named his name Samuel, saying, Because I have asked him of the LORD.

I Sam 1:24 And when she had weaned him, she took him up with her, with... and brought him into the house of the LORD in Shiloh: and the child was young.

I Sam 1:25 And they slew a bullock, and brought the child to Eli.

I Sam 1:26 And she said, O my lord, I am the woman that stood by thee here, praying unto the LORD.

I Sam 1:27 For this child I prayed; and the LORD hath given me my petition which I asked of HIM.

I Sam 1:28 Therefore do I leave lent him to the LORD; so long as he liveth, he shall be lent to the LORD. And he worshipped the LORD there.

I Sam 2:1-10 Hannah's song of thanksgiving.

I Sam 2:11-26 The wickedness of Eli's sons.

I Sam 2:27-36 The prophecy against Eli's family

I Sam 3:1-10 The word of the LORD first revealed to Samuel.

I Sam 3:4 That the LORD called Samuel: and he answered, Here am I.

I Sam 3:7 Now Samuel did not yet know the LORD, neither was the word of the LORD yet revealed unto him.

I Sam 3:8 And the LORD called Samuel again at the third time. And he arose and went to Eli, and said, Here am I; for thou hast called me. And Eli perceived that the LORD had called the child.

I Sam 3:9 Therefore Eli said unto Samuel, Go lie down: and it shall be, if he call thee, that thou shalt say, Speak, LORD; for thy servant heareth. So Samuel went and lay down in his place.

I Sam 3:10 And the LORD came, and stood, and called as at other times, Samuel, Samuel. Then Samuel answered, Speak; for thy servant heareth.

I Sam 3:11 And the LORD said to Samuel, Behold, I will do a thing in Israel, at which both the ears of every one that heareth it shall tingle.

## I Samuel cont. 3

I Sam 3:11-18 GOD tells Samuel the destruction of Eli's house.

I Sam 3:16 Then Eli called Samuel, and said, Samuel, my son. And he answered here am I.

I Sam 3:17 And he said, What is the thing that the LORD hath said unto thee? I pray thee hide it not from me:...

I Sam 3:18 And Samuel told him every whit, and hid nothing from him. And he said, It is the LORD: let him do what seemeth him good.

I Sam 3:19 And Samuel grew, and the LORD was with him, and did let none of his words fall to the ground.

I Sam 3:20 And all Israel from Dan unto Beer-sheva knew that Samuel was established to be a prophet of the LORD.

I Sam 3:21 And the LORD appeared again in Shiloh: for the LORD revealed himself to Samuel in Shiloh by the word of the LORD.

I Sam 4:1-9 Israel is smitten before the Philistines.

I Sam 4:10 And the Philistines fought, and Israel was smitten, and they fled every man into his tent: and there was a very great slaughter; for three fell of Israel thirty thousand men.

I Sam 4:11 And the ark of GOD was taken; and the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, were slain.
