

## II Samuel

- II Sam 1 David learns of the death of Saul and Jonathan and by the Amalekites bringing the news.
- II Sam 1:17-27 David mourns the loss of Saul & Jonathan.
- II Sam 2 David is made king by the tribe of Judah.
- II Sam 3 Abner rebels from Saul's family to David. Joab plots and kills Abner in revenge for the death of his brother Asahel, by Abner.
- II Sam 4 Saul's son Ishbosheth is murdered and the guilty men are slain at David's command.
- II Sam 5 David is made king over all Israel and (Zion) Jerusalem is made capital over the united kingdom.
- II Sam 6:1-5 The ark removed from Kirjath-jearim.
- II Sam 6:6-11 Uzzah is smitten for touching the ark.
- II Sam 6:12-19 David brings the ark to Zion.
- II Sam 6:20-22 David celebrates the arrival of the ark.
- II Sam 6:16 And as the ark of the LORD came into the city of David, Michal Saul's daughter looked through a window and saw king David leaping and dancing before the LORD; and she despised him in her heart.
- II Sam 6:23 Therefore Michal the daughter of Saul had no child unto the day of her death.
- \* II Sam 7 GOD forms a covenant with David.
- II Sam 7:10 And when thy days be fulfilled, and thou shalt sleep with thy fathers, I will set up thy seed after thee, which shall proceed out of thy bowels; and I will establish his kingdom.
- II Sam 7:13 He shall build a house for MY name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom for ever!!

## II Samuel cont.

- II Sam 8 David subdues the Philistines, the Moabites, and the Syrians.
- II Sam 8:14 And he put garrisons in Edom; throughout all Edom just he garrisons, and all they of Edom became David's servants. And the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.
- II Sam 8:15 And David reigned over all Israel; and David executed judgment and justice unto all his people.
- II Sam 9 David shows kindness to Jonathan's son Mephibosheth and returns to him, his family land.
- II Sam 10 David attempts to show kindness to the people of Ammon, but instead they treat his messenger as a mercenar. David defeats the Ammonites and the Syrians, who helped them.
- II Sam 11 David takes Bathsheba, another man's wife. He has her husband Uriah the Hittite killed in battle.
- II Sam 11:27 And when the mourning was past, David sat and fetched her to his house, and she became his wife, and bare him a son.
- ... 11:27 But the thing that David had done displeased the LORD.
- II Sam 12 The LORD sends Nathan the prophet to David to tell him of his sin. He gives him a parable.
- II Sam 12:7 And Nathan said to David, Thou art the man.
- II Sam 12:10 Now therefore the sword shall never depart from thine house; because thou hast despised me, and hast taken the wife of Uriah the Hittite to be thy wife.

## II Samuel cont. 2

- II Sam 12:13 And David said unto Nathan, I have sinned against the LORD, and Nathan said unto David, The LORD also hath put away thy sin; thou shalt not die.
- II Sam 12:24 And David comforted Beth-Abba his wife, and went in unto her, and lay with her; and she bare a son, and he called his name Solomon; and the LORD loved him.
- II Sam 12:25 And he sent by the hand of Nathan the prophet; and he called his name Jedidiah, because of the LORD.
- II Sam 13:1-20 Amnon, David's son, violates his sister Tamar.
- II Sam 13:21-29 Absalom murders his brother Amnon for his sister Tamar's sake.
- II Sam 14-15 Absalom returns to Jerusalem and then rises up against his father, David. David leaves the city to avoid Absalom.
- II Sam 15:30 And David went up by the ascent of Mount Olivet, and went as he went up, and had his head covered, and he went beforefoot; and all the people that were with him covered every man his head, and they went up, weeping as they went up.
- II Sam 16:5-14 David is cursed by Shimei.
- II Sam 16:12 It may be that the LORD will look on mine affliction, and that the LORD will requite me good for his cursing this day.
- II Sam 17 Absalom and the army of Israel follow David to Gilead.

## II Samuel cont. 3

- II Sam 18 Absalom dies in battle and David mourns for him.
- II Sam 19 The division between Judah & Israel.
- II Sam 20 Sheba and Israel revolt from King David.
- II Sam 21 The Gibonites are avenged for the actions of Saul. A three year famine ends.
- II Sam 21:15-12 The sons of Goliath the Philistine are slain by David's servants and relatives.
- II Sam 22 David's Song of Deliverance unto the LORD.
- II Sam 22:2 And he said, the LORD is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer.
- II Sam 23:1-7 The last words of David.
- II Sam 23:3 The GOD of Israel said the ROCK of Israel spoke to me. He that ruleth over men must be just, ruling in the fear of GOD.
- II Sam 23:8-39 David's Mighty Men.
- II Sam 24 David numbers the people: 800,000 fighting men of Israel, 500,000 of Judah who were set in array for battle.
- II Sam 24:10 And David's heart smote him after that he had numbered the people. And David said unto the LORD, I have sinned greatly in that I have done: and now I beseech thee, O LORD, take away the iniquity of thy servant; for I have done very foolishly: the people are perished by pestilence.
