

II Samuel

3-19-18

II Sam 1 David learns of the death of Saul and Jonathan and has the Amalekite who brought the news and slew the injured Saul to be slain.

II Sam 1:17-27 David mourns the loss of Saul and Jonathan.

II Sam 1:25 How are the mighty fallen in the midst of the battle!...

II Sam 1:27 How are the mighty fallen, and the weapons of war perished.

II Sam 2 David is made King by the tribe of Judah and Asahel dies.

II Sam 3 Abner revolts from Saul's family to David. Joab plots and kills Abner in revenge for the death of his brother Asahel, killed by Abner.

II Sam 4 Saul's son Ishbosheth is murdered and the guilty men are slain at David's command.

II Sam 5 David is made King over all Israel and (Zion) Jerusalem is made capital over the united kingdom.

II Sam 5:4 David was 30 years old when he began to reign, and he reigned 40 years. JESUS WAS 30

II Sam 5:5 In Hebron he reigned over Judah seven years and six months; and in Jerusalem, he reigned thirty and three years over all Israel, and Judah. (CHRIST WAS 33 years old at HIS death.)

II Sam 6:1-11 The Ark is removed from Kirjath-jearim and Uzzah is smitten for touching it.

II Sam 6:12-19 David brings the Ark to Zion.

II Samuel cont. 2

II Sam 10 David attempts to show kindness to the people of Ammon, but instead they treat his messengers as enemies. David defeats the Ammonites and the Syrians who helped them.

II Sam 11 David takes Bathsheba, another man's wife. He has her husband Uriah, the Hittite, killed in battle.

II Sam 11:27 ... But the thing that David had done displeased the LORD.

II Sam 12 The LORD sends Nathan, the prophet to David to tell him of his sin. He gives him a parable.

II Sam 12:7 And Nathan said to David, Thou art the man.

II Sam 12:10-12 Nathan foretells the strife that shall be in David's family, as a result of his sin due to Uriah, the Hittite's murder.

II Sam 12:13 Nathan said unto David, the LORD also hath put away thy sin; thou shalt not die.

II Sam 12:24-25 The birth of Solomon; and the LORD loved him.

II Sam 13:1-20 Amnon, David's son, violates his sister Tamar.

II Sam 13:21-29 Absalom murders his brother Amnon for his sister Tamar's sake.

II Sam 14-15 Absalom returns to Jerusalem and then rises up against his father, David. David leaves the city to avoid Absalom.

II Sam 15:30 And David went up by the ascent of Mount Olivet, and wept as he went...

II Samuel (cont.)

II Sam 6:20-22 David celebrates the arrival of the Ark.

II Sam 6:16 And as the Ark of the LORD came into the city of David Michal, Saul's daughter, looked through a window and saw King David leaping and dancing before the LORD; and she despised him in her heart.

II Sam 6:23 Therefore Michal, the daughter of Saul, had no child unto the day of her death.

II Sam 7 GOD forms a covenant with David.

II Sam 7:12 And when thy days be fulfilled, and thou shalt sleep with thy fathers, I will set up thy seed after thee, which shall proceed out of thy bowels, and I will establish his kingdom.

II Sam 7:13 He shall build an house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom for ever!!

II Sam 8 David subdues the Philistines, the Moabites, and the Syrians.

II Sam 8:14 And he put garrisons in Edom ... and all they of Edom became David's servants.

II Sam 8:15 And David reigned over all Israel; and David executed judgement and justice unto all his people.

II Sam 9 David shows kindness to Jonathan's son Mephibosheth and returns to him, his family land.

II Sam 9:8 Mephibosheth is humble before his Master after being shown Grace.

II Samuel cont. 3

II Sam 16 David accepts the cursing by Shimei.

II Sam 16:12 It may be that the LORD will look on mine affliction and that the LORD will requite me good for his cursing this day.

II Sam 17 Absalom and the army of Israel follow David to Gilead.

II Sam 18 Absalom dies in battle and David mourns for him.

II Sam 19 The division between Judah & Israel

II Sam 20 Sheba and Israel revolt from King David.

II Sam 21 The Gibeonites are avenged for the actions of Saul. A three year famine ends.

II Sam 21:15-22 The sons of Goliath, the Philistine are slain by David's servants and relatives.

II Sam 22 David's Song of Deliverance unto the LORD.

II Sam 22:2 And he said, the LORD is my Rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer.

II Sam 23:1-7 the last words of David

II Sam 23:3 The GOD of Israel said, the Rock of Israel spoke to me, He that ruleth over men must be just, ruling in the fear of GOD.

II Sam 23:8-39 David's Mighty Men.

II Sam 24 David numbers the people: 800,000 fighting men of Israel, 500,000 of Judah who were set in array for battle.

II Sam 24:10 David's heart smote him for number the people, He asks forgiveness from the LORD; He accepts the punishment of Pestilence.
