

I Kings cont. 8

I Kings 19:1-3 Jezebel the queen threatens Elijah. He flees to the wilderness.

✂ I Kings 19:5 And as he lay and slept under a juniper tree, behold, there an angel touched him, and said unto him, Arise and eat.

I Kings 19:6 And he looked, and behold, there was a cake baked on the coals, and a cruse of water at his head. And he did eat and drink, and laid him down again.

✂ I Kings 19:7 And the angel of the LORD came again the second time, and touched him, and said, Arise and eat; because the journey is too great for thee.

✂ I Kings 19:8 And he arose, and did eat and drink, and went in the strength of that meat forty days and forty nights unto Horeb the mount of GOD.

✂ I Kings 19:9 And he came thither unto a cave and lodged there; and behold, the word of the LORD came to him, and he said unto him, What doest thou here Elijah?

✂ I Kings 19:9-12 Wind, earth quake, fire, and a still small voice are heard by Elijah.

✂ I Kings 19:25 And the LORD said unto him, Go, return on thy way to the wilderness of Damascus; and when thou comest, anoint Hazael to be king over Syria.

I Kings 19:19 So he departed thence, and found Elisha the son of Shaphat, who was plowing with twelve yoke of oxen before him, and he with his staff; and Elijah passed by him, and cast his mantle upon him.

I Kings 20 Benhadad, the king of Syria besieges Samaria, the city of Ahab.

I Kings 21:1-4 Ahab covets Naboth's vineyard.

✂ I Kings 21:5-16 Naboth is murdered by Jezebel.

I Kings 21:17-29 Elijah announces Ahab's doom.

I Kings 22:15-28 Micahiah predicts the death of Ahab.

I Kings 22:29-40 Death of Ahab in battle with the Syrians.

→ I Kings 22:41-50 Jehoshaphat's good reign over Judah.

△ I Kings 21:23 And of Jezebel also spoke the LORD, saying, The dogs shall eat Jezebel by the well of Sezeel.
