I Chron 1 The genealogies from Adam to Noah, to Abraham and his sons.

I Chron 2 The sons of Jacob (Israel) and their genealogies

I Chron 4:4 And Perez the father of Hezor, and Ezar the father of Hashor. These are the sons of Hur, the brother of Ephrathah, the father of Bethlehem.

I Chron 6:54-81 The cities of the priests and Levites

I Chron 21 David sins in numbering the people

I Chron 21:1 And Satan stood up against Israel, and provoked David to number Israel

I Chron 21:8 And David said unto GOD, I have sinned greatly, because I have done this thing: but now I beseech thee, to stay the judgment of thy servant; for I have done very foolishly.

I Chron 21:9 And the LORD spake unto God, David nevertheless saying,

I Chron 21:10 Go and tell David, saying, They say of the LORD, I offer thee three things: choose thee one of them, that I may do it unto thee.

I Chron 21:11-17 David chooses the mercy of the LORD by HIS angel who brings pestilence into Israel.

I Chron 21:16 And David lifted up his eyes, and saw the angel of the LORD stand between the earth and the heaven, having a drawn sword in his hand stretched out over Jerusalem. The David and the elders of Israel, who were clothed in sackcloth, fell upon their faces.

I Chron 21:17-18 The angel of the LORD stayed at the threshing floor of Ornan the Jebusite.

I Chron 21:19-30 David purchases land from Ornan to build an altar unto the LORD.

I Chron 21:27 And the LORD commanded the angel; and he put up his sword again into the sheath thereof.

I Chron 27 The twelve captains for each month.

I Chron 28 David in a solemn assembly gives counsel to Israel and Solomon.

I Chron 28:3 But GOD said unto me, Thou shalt not build an house for MY name, because thou hast been a man of war, and hast shed blood

I Chron 28:6 And HE said unto me, Solomon thy son he shall build MY house and MY courts: for I have chosen him to be my son, and I will be his father.

I Chron 29:10 Wherefore David blessed the LORD before all the congregation: and David said, Blessed be thou, LORD GOD of Israel our father, for ever and ever.

I Chron 29:23 Then Solomon sat on the throne of the LORD as king instead of David his father, and prospered; and all Israel obeyed him.

I Chron 29 David reigned over Israel for 40 years.
