I Chron 1 The genealogies from Adam to Noah, to Abraham and his sons.

I Chron 2 The sons of Jacob (Israel) and their genealogies.

→ I Chron 3 The sons of David and their genealogies.

I Chron 4 The sons of Judeh.

I Chron 4:4 And Penuel the father of Gedor, and Ezer the father of Hushah. These are the sons of Han, the firstborn of Ephratah, the father of Bethlehem. ↗

I Chron 5 The sons of Reuben, Gad, and Manasseh.

I Chron 6 The sons of Levi.

I Chron 6:54-81 The cities of the priests & Levites

I Chron 7 The sons of Issachar, Ephraim, Benjamin, Naphtali, Mannasseh, and Asher.

I Chron 8 The genealogy of Benjamin.

I Chron 8:33 And Ner begat Kish, and Kish begat Saul, and Saul begat Jonathan...

I Chron 9 The Priests and Levites and their temple responsibilities.

I Chron 10 The death of Saul and his sons, see I Sam 31

I Chron 10:13 So Saul died for his transgression which he committed against the LORD, even against the word of the LORD, which he kept not, and also for asking counsel of one that had a familiar spirit, to enquire of it;

I Chron 10:14 He enquired not of the LORD: therefore HE slew him, and turned the kingdom unto David, the son of Jesse.

I Chronicles cont. 2

I Chron 17:1-6 David's desire to build the LORD's house.

→ I Chron 17:7-15 The great Davidic Covenant, the promises made by the LORD to David.

I Chron 18 The full establishment of David's Kingdom including Syria, Moab, Edom, and to the Euphrates River

I Chron 19 War with Ammon and Syria.

I Chron 20 War with Philistines.

→ I Chron 21:1 And Satan stood up against Israel, and provoked David to number Israel.

I Chron 21:8-10 David asks the LORD for forgiveness.

I Chron 21:11-17 David chooses the mercy of the LORD by HIS Angel who brings pestilence unto Israel.

I Chron 21:16 And David lifted up his eyes, and saw the Angel of the LORD stand between the earth and the heaven having a drawn sword in his hand stretched out over Jerusalem. Then David and the elders of Israel who were clothed in sackcloth, fell upon their faces.

I Chron 21:18 David pleads for the people of Israel and the LORD commands the Angel to stop the pestilence after 70,000 men are killed. The Angel of the LORD stops at the threshing floor of Ornan the Tebusite.

I Chron 21:30 David purchases the threshing floor from Ornan to build an alter and sacrifices unto the LORD.

→ I Chron 22 David prepares materials for the temple.

I Chronicles cont.

I Chron 11 David becomes King over a united Israel

→ I Chron 11:4-9 Jerusalem is made the capital of all of Israel. (also called Tebus and Zion)

I Chron 11:10-47 The mighty men of David, and their deeds of greatness.

I Chron 12 Men who came to David at Ziklag, the fortress of David.

I Chron 12:22 For at that time day by day there came to David to help him, until it was a great host, like the host of GOD.

→ I Chron 12:23-40 Many thousands join David and make him King, at Hebron.

I Chron 13 David and the people desire to bring the Ark of the Covenant to Jerusalem.

I Chron 13:9-12 Uzza is smitten by the LORD for touching the Ark & the Covenant.

I Chron 13:13 So David brought not the Ark home to himself to the city of David but carried it aside into the house of Obed-edom the Gittite.

→ I Chron 13:14 And the Ark of GOD remained with the family of Obed-edom in his house three months. And the LORD blessed the house of Obed-edom, and all that he had.

I Chron 14 The prosperity of King David.

→ I Chron 15 David and the Levites bring the Ark to the City of David. II Samuel 6.

I Chron 16 David's Psalm of Thanksgiving 7-36.

I Chron 16:34 O give thanks unto the LORD; for HE is good; for HIS mercy endureth for ever.

I Chron 23 David makes Solomon King.

The Levites are numbered and assigned their lots.

I Chron 24 The divisions of the sons of Aaron.

I Chron 25 288 singers for songs of the LORD

I Chron 26 Listing of gatekeepers & keepers of treasures

I Chron 27 The twelve captains for each month

I Chron 28 David in a solemn assembly gives counsel to Israel and Solomon.

→ I Chron 28:3 But GOD said unto me, Thou shalt not build an house for MY name because thou hast been a man of ver, and hast shed blood.

I Chron 28:6 And HE said unto me, Solomon thy son, he shall build MY house and MY courts: for I have chosen him to be MY son, and I will be his father.

I Chron 29:10 Wherefore David blessed the LORD before all the congregation: and David said Blessed be thou, LORD GOD of Israel our FATHER for ever and ever.

I Chron 29:23 Then Solomon sat on the throne of the LORD as king instead of David his father, and prospered; and all Israel obeyed him.

→ I Chron 29 David reigned over Israel for 40 years.
