✘ Psa 39:13 O spare me, that I may recover strength, before I go hence, and be no more.

Psa 40 Spoke of Messiah, Jehovah's servant, obedient unto death.

→ Psa 40:1 I waited patiently for the LORD; and HE inclined unto me, and heard my cry.

Psa 40:2 HE brought me up also out of an horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon a rock, and established my goings.

Psa 40:4 Blessed is the man that maketh the LORD his trust, and respecteth not the proud, nor such as turn aside to lies.

Psa 40:11 Withheld not thou thy tender mercies from me O LORD? let thy loving-kindness and thy truth continually preserve me.

✘ Psa 40:13 Repleasa, O LORD to deliver me: O LORD, make haste to help me.

✘ Psa 40:17 But I am poor and needy; yet the LORD thinketh upon me: thou art my help and my deliverer; make no tarrying, O my GOD.

Psa 41:1 Blessed is he that considereth the poor: for the LORD will deliver him in time of trouble.

* Psa 41:4 I said, LORD be merciful unto me: heal my soul; for I have sinned against thee.

✘ Psa 41:9 Yea, mine own familiar friend, in whom I trusted, which did eat of my bread, hath lifted up his heel against me.

✘ Psa 41:13 Blessed be the LORD GOD of Israel from now even everlasting, and to everlasting. Amen & Amen

Psa 51 David asks for forgiveness from the LORD after his sin with Bathsheba.

→ Psa 51:10 Create in me a clean heart, O GOD; and renew a right SPIRIT within me.

→ Psa 51:11 Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy HOLY SPIRIT from me!
See St. John 14:16

Psa 52 The enemies of the truth and the church are described by David.

Psa 53:1 The Fool hath said in his heart, There is no God...

Psa 53:2 GOD looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, that did seek GOD.

Psa 53:3 Every one of them has gone back: they are altogether become filthy; there is none that doeth good, no, not one.

Psa 54:1 Save me, O GOD, by thy name, and judge me by thy strength.

Psa 55 David prays to the LORD for the relief from the treachery of his enemies.

→ Psa 55:4 My heart is sore pained within me: and the terrors of death are fallen upon me.

✘ Psa 55:22 Cast thy burden upon the LORD and HE shall sustain thee: HE shall never suffer the righteous to be moved.

Psa 56:1 Be merciful unto me O GOD: for man would swallow me up; he fighting daily to oppress me.

→ Psa 56:4 In GOD I will praise HIS word; in GOD I have put my trust; I will not fear what flesh can do unto me,

Psa 42:2 My soul thirsted for GOD, for the living GOD: when shall I come and appear before GOD?

Psa 42:9 I will say unto GOD my rock, Why hast thou forgotten me?

Psa 43:5 ... hope in GOD: for I shall not praise HIM, who is the health of my countenance, and my GOD.

Psa 44:26 A rise for our help, and redeem us for thy mercies' sake.

* Psa 45 One of the Psalms concerning the Messiah.

→ Psa 46:1 GOD is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

✘ Psa 46:10 Be still and know that I AM GOD: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth.

Psa 46:11 The LORD of hosts is with us; the GOD of Jacob is our refuge.

Psa 47:7 For GOD is the KING of all the earth: sing ye praise with understanding.

Psa 48 Jerusalem is the city of our GOD.

Psa 49:15 But GOD will redeem my soul from the power of the grave: for HE shall receive me. Selah.

Psa 50:1-6 THE glory of GOD.

→ Psa 50:7-15 No more sacrifices but prayers to GOD.

✘ Psa 50:14 Offer unto GOD thanksgiving; and pay thy vows unto the most HIGH:

✘ Psa 50:15 And call upon ME in thy day of trouble: I will deliver thee, and thou shalt glorify ME.

Psa 56:10 In GOD will I praise HIS WORD: as the LORD will I praise HIS WORD.

→ Psa 56:11 In GOD have I put my trust: I will not be afraid what man can do unto me.

Psa 56:12 Thy vows are upon me, O GOD; I will render praises unto THEE;

Psa 56:13 For THOU hast delivered my soul from death: wilt not thou deliver my feet from falling, that I may walk before GOD in the light of the living?

Psa 57 David's prayer when he fled from Saul into the cave.

Psa 57:2 I will cry unto GOD most high; unto GOD that performeth all things for me.

Psa 57:5 Be thou exalted, O GOD, above the heavens; let thy glory be above all the earth.

Psa 57:10 For thy mercy is great unto the heavens, and thy truth unto the clouds.

✘ Psa 57:1... for my soul trusteth in THEE: ... until these calamities be overpast.

Psa 58 David talks of the wicked.

Psa 59:1 Deliver me from my enemies, O my GOD: defend me from them that rise up against me.

Psa 60:12 Through GOD we shall do valiantly: for HE it is that shall tread down our enemies.

✘ Psa 61:3 For thou hast been a shelter for me, and a strong tower from the enemy.

→ Psa 61:8 So will I sing praise unto THY name for ever, that I may daily perform my vows
