

[Psalms] cont. 12

Psa 62:5 My soul, wait thou only upon GOD; for my expectation is from HIM.

✠ Psa 62:6 HE only is my rock and my salvation: HE is my defence; I shall not be moved

→ Psa 62:7 In GOD is my salvation and my glory: the rock of my strength, and my refuge, is in GOD.

✠ Psa 62:8 Trust in HIM at all times; ye people, pour out your heart before HIM: GOD is a refuge for us.

→ Psa 62:12 Also unto THEE, O LORD, belongeth mercy: for THOU renderest to every man according to his work.

Psa 63 David's dependence upon GOD, and assurance of safety.

→ Psa 63:7 Because thou hast been my help, therefore in the shadow of thy wings will I rejoice.

✠ Psa 64:1 Hear my voice, O GOD, in my prayer: preserve my life from fear of the enemy.

→ Psa 64:10 The righteous shall be glad in the LORD, and shall trust in HIM; and all the upright in heart shall glory.

Psa 65:2 O THOU that hearest prayer, unto thee shall all flesh come.

Psa 66:1 Make a joyful noise unto GOD, all ye lands: Psa 66:2 Sing forth the honor of HIS name: make HIS praise glorious.

Psa 66:19 But verily GOD hath heard voice: HE hath attended to the voice of my prayer.

[Psalms] cont. 14

→ Psa 72 The last psalm of David, about Solomon and the Messiah. It is the prayer of a father for his child; a dying blessing.

→ Psa 72:2-17 This is a prophecy of the kingdom of CHRIST.

→ Psa 72:11 Yea, all kings shall fall down before HIM: all nations shall serve HIM.

→ Psa 72:17 HIS name shall endure for ever: HIS name shall be continued as long as the sun: and men shall be blessed in HIM: all nations shall call HIM blessed.

→ Psa 72:18 Blessed be the LORD GOD, the GOD of ISRAEL, who only doeth wondrous things.

→ Psa 72:19 And blessed be HIS glorious name for ever: and let the whole earth be filled with HIS GLORY; AMEN, and AMEN.

→ Psa 72:20 The prayers of David the son of Jesse are ended.

Psa 73:26 My flesh and my heart faileth: but GOD is the strength of my heart, and my portion forever.

Psa 73:28 But it is good for me to draw near to GOD: I have put my trust in the LORD GOD, that I may declare all thy works.

Psa 74 the enemy in GOD'S sanctuary ... deprives.

Psa 75:7 But GOD is the judge: HE putteth down one, and setteth up another.

→ Psa 76:11 Vow, and pay, unto the LORD your GOD: let all that be round about HIM bring presents unto HIM that ought to be feared. (loved),

Psa 77:1 I cried unto GOD with my voice, even unto GOD with my voice; and HE gave ear unto me.

[Psalms] cont. 13

Psa 67:1 GOD shall bless us; and all the ends of the earth shall fear HIM.

✠ Psa 68:4 Sing unto GOD, sing praise to HIS name: let HIM that rideth upon the heavens by HIS name JAH, and rejoice before HIM.

→ Psa 68 The many wonders of GOD

✠ Psa 68:17 The chariots of GOD are twenty thousand, even thousands of angels: the LORD is among them, as in Sinai, in the holy place.

✠ Psa 69 The Psalm of the humiliation of CHRIST.

Psa 69:1 Save me, O GOD; for the waters are come in unto my soul.

→ Psa 69:21 ... view of the CROSS to come.

→ Psa 69:21 They gave me also gall for my meat; and in my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink. Psa 70:1 Make haste, O GOD, to deliver me; make haste to help me, O LORD.

Psa 70:5 ... O GOD: thou art my help, and my deliverer; ...

Psa 71:1-13 David prays that he might never be ashamed of depending upon GOD.

Psa 71:4 Deliver me, O my GOD, out of the hand of the wicked, out of the hand of the unrighteous and cruel men.

→ Psa 71:5 For thou art my hope, O LORD GOD: THOU art my trust from my youth.

✠ Psa 71:17 O GOD, thou hast taught me from my youth: and hitherto have I declared thy wondrous works.

Psa 71:18 Now also when I am old and gray-headed, O GOD, forsake me not; until I have showed THY strength unto this generation, and THY power to every one that is to come.

[Psalms] cont. 15

✠ Psa 77:20 THOU leddest thy people like a flock, by the hand of Moses and Aaron.

Psa 78:9-39 The history of Israel.

Psa 78:40-55 Their settlement in Canaan.

→ Psa 78:56-72 The mercies of GOD to Israel contrasted with their ingratitude.

✠ Psa 79 A prayer to ask the LORD for help against those who have oppressed HIS people.

Psa 80 A prayer describing GOD as the Shepherd of Israel, asking for HIS mercy.

→ Psa 80:1 Give ear, O Shepherd of Israel, thou shalt leadst Joseph like a flock; thou shalt dwellst between the cherubims, shine forth

Psa 81:1 Sing aloud to GOD our strength: make a joyful noise unto the GOD of Jacob.

✠ Psa 82:8 Arise, O GOD, judge the earth: for THOU shalt inherit all nations.

→ Psa 83:1 Keep not thy silence, O GOD: hold not THY peace, and be not still, O GOD.

✠ Psa 83:2 For, lo, thine enemies make a tumult: and they that hate THEE have lifted up the head.

Psa 83:15 So persecute them with THY tempest, and make them afraid with THY storm.

Psa 83:16 Fill their faces with shame; that they may seek THY name, O LORD.

Psa 83:17 Let them be confounded and troubled for ever; yea, let them be put to shame and perish:

→ Psa 83:18 That men may know that THOU, whose name alone is JEHOVAH, art the most high over all the earth.
