

⇒ Job 1-2 Why bad things happen to good people.

Job 1 Satan declares that Job is good because the LORD has helped him to be prosperous.

Job 1:20 Then Job arose and rent his mantle, and shaved his head, and fell down upon the ground, and worshipped.

Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD.

Job 1:22 In all this Job sinned not, nor charged GOD foolishly.

⇒ Job 1:13-19 Satan had taken away all of Job's children and all that he had!

⇒ Job 2 Satan further afflicts Job by taking away his health.

⇒ Job 2:6 And the LORD said to Satan, Behold, he is in thine hand; but, save his life.

Job 3 Job tells of his misery and despair.

Job 4 Eliphaz answers Job.

Job 5 The teachings of Eliphaz:

Job 5:17 Behold, happy is the man who GOD correcteth: therefore despise not thou Heb 12:5 the chastening of the ALMIGHTY: Rev 3:19 Psalms 94:12, Pro 3:11 Jas 1:12

Job 6 and 7 Job's answer to Eliphaz.

Job 8 Bildad thinks Job is a hypocrite.

Job 9 & 10 Job answers Bildad.

Job 15 Second accusation of Eliphaz

Job 16-17 Job's 4th Answer

Job 18 Bildad's response of oriental proverbs

Job 19 Job's 5th answer: his strong faith

Job 19:25 For I know that my redeemer liveth, and that HE shall stand at the latter day upon the earth:

Job 19:26 And though after my skin worms destroy this body, yet in my flesh shall I see GOD:

Job 19:27 Whom I shall see for myself, and mine eyes shall behold, and not another; though my reins be consumed within me.

Job 20-22 Zophar and Eliphaz again maintain that Job has sinned.

Job 23-24 Job gives proof that their arguments are false.

Job 25 Bildad's discouraging comments

Job 26-31 Job answers the accusations (8th Answer)

Job 27:7 Let mine enemy be as the wicked, and he that riseth up against me as the unrighteous.

⇒ Job 27:8 For what is the hope of the hypocrite, though he hath gained, when GOD take eth away his soul.

Job 28 The Value of Wisdom.

## [JOB] cont.

Job 10: 4-5 Job wonders if the LORD has seen the world through the eyes of a man? (HE does when JESUS is in the world)

Job 10:4 Hast thou eyes of flesh? or seest thou as man seeth?

Job 10:5 Are thy days as the days of man? are thy years as man's days?

Job 11 Zophar proclaims Job to be a hypocrite and liar.

Job 12-14 Job answers the three.

⇒ Job 14:1 Man that is born of a woman is of few days, and full of trouble

⇒ Job 14:5 Seeing his days are determined, the number of his months are, with THESE THOU hast appointed his bounds that he cannot pass.

Job 14:7 For there is hope of a tree that if it be cut down, that it will sprout again, and that the tender BRANCH thereof will not cease

Job 14:8 Though the root thereof wax old in the earth, and the stalk thereof die in the ground;

Job 14:9 Yet through the scent of water it will bud, and bring forth boughs like a plant.

Job 14:10 But man dieth and wasteth away: yea, man giveth up the ghost, and where is he?

Job 14:14 If a man die, shall he live again? all the days of my appointed time shall I wait, till my charge come.

Job waits for the RESURRECTION

## [JOB] cont. 3

⇒ Job 28:18 No mention shall be made of coral or of pearls: for the price of wisdom is above rubies.

Job 28:28 And unto man HE said, Behold, the fear of the LORD, that is wisdom; and to depart from evil is understanding.

Job 29 Job remembers the Blessings from the LORD.

Job 30-31 Job continues to answer the accusations of the three men who visit him.

Job 32 Elihu accuses Job. A young 4th man.

⇒ Job 33:4 The SPIRIT of GOD hath made me, and the breath of the ALMIGHTY hath given me life.

Job 33:27 HE looketh upon men, and is any say, I have sinned, and perverted that which was right, and it profiteth me not;

Job 33:28 HE will deliver his soul from going into the pit, and his life shall see the light.

Job 33:29 LO, all these things worketh GOD ostentimes with man,

Job 33:30 To bring back his soul from the pit, to be enlightened with the light of the living.

⇒ Job 34-37 Elihu continues his remarks including some excellent comments about GOD

Job 36:5 Behold GOD is Mighty, and despiseth not any: HE is Mighty in Strength & Wisdom

## JOB cont. 4

Job 37 GOD sets Nature in order.

Job 37:5 GOD thundereth marvellously with HIS voice; great things doeth HE, which we cannot comprehend.

Job 37:14 Hearken unto this, O Job: stand still, and consider the wonderous works of GOD.

Job 38:41 JEHOVAH and Job.

Job 38:1 Then the LORD answered Job out of the Whirlwind, and said,

Job 38:2 Who is this that darkeneth counsel by words without knowledge?

Job 38:4-39 The many wonders of the LORD are reviewed.

Job 40 Job and the LORD talk.

Job 40:15-24 Behemoth is described - Land Beast

Job 41 Leviathan is described. Sea Beast.

Job 41:11 ... Whatsoever is under the whole Heaven is MINE.

Job 42 Job is vindicated and honored

"The godly are afflicted that they may be brought to self-knowledge and self-judgment."

## JOB cont 5

Job 42:1-6 Job's Self-Judgment

"Such Self-knowledge and self-judgment is the prelude to greater fruitfulness. Such afflictions are not penal for their sins, but remedial and purifying." [Scafield Note: Job 42:6]

Job 42:7 And it was so, that after the LORD had spoken these words to Job, the LORD said to Eliphaz, the Temanite, MY wrath is kindled against thee, and against thy two friends; for ye have not spoken of ME the thing that is right, as MY servant Job hath.

Job 42:10 And the LORD turned the captivity of Job when he prayed for his friends; also the LORD gave Job twice as much as he had before.

Job 42:12- So the LORD blessed the latter end of Job more than his beginning; with many animals and 7 sons; 3 daughters

\* Job 42:15 Job gave his daughters an inheritance

Job 42:16 After this lived Job an hundred and forty years, and saw his sons, and his sons' sons, even 4 generations.

Job lived about the time of Moses
