

[Psalms] cont 14 12-1-18

Psa 51 David asks for forgiveness from the LORD after his sin with Bathsheba.

→ Psa 51:10 Create in me a clean heart, O GOD, and renew a right SPIRIT within me.

→ Psa 51:11 Cast me not away from thy presence and take not thy HOLY SPIRIT from me!

See St. John 14:16 Comforter

Psa 52 The enemies of the truth and the church are described by David.

Psa 53:1 The fool hath said in his heart, There is no GOD...

? Psa 53:2 GOD looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, that did seek GOD.

⊖ Psa 53:3 Every one of them has gone back; they are altogether become filthy; there is none that doeth good, no, not one.

→ Psa 54:1 Save me, O GOD, by thy name, and judge me by thy strength.

→ Psa 54:2 Hear my prayer, O GOD; give ear to the words of my mouth.

→ Psa 54:3 For strangers are risen up against me, and oppressors seek after my soul; they have not set GOD before them. Seh!

→ Psa 54:4 Behold, GOD is mine helper; the LORD is with them that uphold my soul.

[Psalms] cont 15

Psa 55 David prays to the LORD for the relief from the treachery of his enemies.

Psa 55:4 My heart is sore pained within me: and the terrors of death are fallen upon me.

✖ Psa 55:22 Cast thy burden upon the LORD, and HE shall sustain thee: HE shall never suffer the righteous to be moved.

Psa 56:1 Be merciful unto me, O GOD: for man would swallow me up; he sighting daily, to oppress me.

→ Psa 56:11 In GOD have I put my trust: I will not be afraid what man can do unto me.

Psa 56:13 For THOU hast delivered my soul from death: wilt not thou deliver my feet from falling, that I may walk before GOD in the light of the living?

Psa 57: David's Prayer when he fled from Saul into the cave.

✚ Psa 57:1 Be merciful unto me, O GOD, be merciful unto me: for my soul trusteth in THEE: yea in the shadow of thy wings will I make my refuge, until these calamities be overpast.

Psa 58 David tells of the wicked.

→ Psa 58:6-11 A prayer that the wicked might be disabled and their ruin be predicted.

[Psalms] cont 16

Psa 59:1 Deliver me from my enemies, O my GOD: defend me from them that rise up against me.

Psa 60:12 Through GOD we shall do valiantly: for HE it is that shall tread down our enemies.

✖ Psa 61:3 For THOU hast been a shelter for me, and a strong tower from the enemy.

→ Psa 61:8 So will I sing praise unto THY Name for ever, that I may daily perform my vows.

Psa 62:1 Truly my soul waiteth upon GOD: from HIM cometh my salvation.

Psa 62:2 HE only is my rock and my salvation; HE is my defence; I shall not be greatly moved.

✚ Psa 62:8 Trust in HIM at all times; ye people, pour out your heart before HIM: GOD is a refuge for us.

→ Psa 62:12 Also unto THEE, O LORD belongeth mercy: for THOU renderest to every man according to his work.

Psa 63 David's dependence upon GOD and assurance of safety.

→ Psa 63:7 Because THOU hast been my help, therefore in the shadow of thy wings will I rejoice.

[Psalms] cont. 17

✖ Psa 64:1 Hear my voice, O GOD, in my prayer: preserve my life from fear of the enemy.

→ Psa 64:10 The righteous shall be glad in the LORD, and shall trust in HIM; and all the upright in heart shall glory.

Psa 65:2 O THOU that hearest prayer, unto THEE shall all flesh come.

→ Psa 66:1 Make a joyful noise unto GOD, all ye lands:

Psa 66:2 Sing for the Honor of HIS Name: make HIS praise glorious.

* Psa 66:19 But Verily GOD hath heard me: HE hath attended to the voice of my prayer.

Psa 67:7 GOD shall bless us; and all the ends of the earth shall fear HIM.

→ Psa 68 The many wonders of GOD.

✖ Psa 68:4 Sing unto GOD, sing praises to HIS name: extol HIM that rideth upon the heavens by HIS name JATH, and rejoice before HIM.

✚ Psa 68:17 The chariots of GOD are twenty thousand even thousands of angels: the LORD is among them, as in Sinai, in the Holy Place.

→ Psa 68:35 ... the GOD of Israel is HE that giveth strength and power unto HIS people. Blessed be GOD.

- ◇ Psalms 69 The Psalm of the humiliation of CHRIST
- Psalm 69:1 Save me O GOD for the waters are come in unto my soul.
- Psalm 69:21 ... view of the CROSS to come.
- Psalm 69:21 They gave me also gall for my meat; and in my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink.
- Psalm 70:1 Make haste, O GOD, to deliver me; make haste to help me, O LORD.
- Psalm 70:5 ... O GOD: thou art my help and my deliverer; ...
- * Psalm 71:1-13 David prays that he might never be ashamed of dependence upon GOD.
- Psalm 71:4 Deliver me, O my GOD, out of the hand of the wicked, out of the hand of the unrighteous and cruel man.
- Psalm 71:5 For THOU art my hope, O LORD GOD: THOU art my trust from my youth.
- Psalm 71:17 O GOD, thou hast taught me from my youth; and hitherto have I declared thy wonderous works.
- Psalm 71:18 Now also when I am old and grayheaded, O GOD, do not forsake me; until I have shewed THY strength unto this generation, and THY power to every one that is to come.

[Psalms] cont. 20

- Psalm 74 the Enemy in GOD's sanctuary... an appeal for HIS help.
- Psalm 75:7 But GOD is the judge: HE putteth down one, and setteth up another.
- Psalm 75:9 But I will declare for ever; I will sing praises to the GOD of Jacob.
- Psalm 76:11 Vow, and pay unto the LORD your GOD: let all that be round about HIM bring presents unto HIM that ought to be feared. (loved) (respected).
- Psalm 77:1 I cried unto GOD with my voice, even unto GOD with my voice; and HE gave ear unto me.
- ◇ Psalm 77:20 THOU leddest thy people like a flock by the hand of Moses and Aaron.
- *** Psalm 78 History of Israel up to David.
- Psalm 78:40-55 Their settlement in Canaan.
- ◇ Psalm 78:56-72 The Mercies of GOD to Israel contrasted with their ingratitude.
- ◇ Psalm 79 A prayer to ask the LORD for help against those who have oppressed HIS people.
- Psalm 80 A prayer describing GOD as the Shepherd of Israel, asking for HIS Mercy.
- Psalm 80:1 Give ear, O Shepherd of Israel, THOU that leddest Joseph like a flock, THOU that dwellest between the cherubims, shine forth!

see Psalms 86

- Psalm 72 The last psalm of David, about Solomon and the Messiah. It is the prayer of a father for his child; a dying blessing.
- Psalm 72:2-17 This is a prophecy of the Kingdom of CHRIST.
- Psalm 72:11 Yea, all kings shall fall down before HIM: all nations shall serve HIM.
- Psalm 72:17 HIS name shall endure for ever: HIS name shall be continued as long as the sun: and men shall be blessed in HIM: all nations shall call HIM blessed.
- Psalm 72:18 Blessed be the LORD GOD, the GOD of Israel, who only do wonderous things.
- Psalm 72:19 And blessed be HIS Glorious Name for ever: and let the whole earth be filled with HIS GLORY; AMEN, and AMEN.
- Psalm 72:20 The prayers of David the son of Jesse are ended.
- Psalm 73:2-16 The prosperity of the wicked is short lived.
- Psalm 73:17 Until I went unto the Sanctuary of GOD, then understood I their end.
- Psalm 73:26 My flesh and my heart faileth: but GOD is the strength of my heart, and my portion forever.
- Psalm 73:28 But it is good for me to draw near to GOD: I have put my trust in the LORD GOD, that I may declare all thy works.

[Psalms] cont. 21

- Psalm 80:19 Turn us again, O LORD GOD of hosts, cause thy face to shine; and we shall be saved.
- Psalm 81:1 Sing aloud to GOD our strength: make a joyful noise unto the GOD of Jacob.
- Psalm 82:3 Defend the poor and fatherless: do justice to the afflicted and needy.
- Psalm 82:8 Arise, O GOD, judge the earth: for THOU shalt inherit all nations.
- Psalm 83 A prayer against the enemies of GOD's people.
- Psalm 83:1 Keep not thy silence, O GOD: hold not THY peace, and be not still, O GOD.
- Psalm 83:18 That men may know that THOU, whose Name alone is JEHOVAH, art the Most High over all the earth.
- Psalm 84:4 Blessed are they that dwell in THY houses: they will be still praising THEE. Selah
- Psalm 84:5 Blessed is the man whose strength is in THEE; in whose heart are the ways of them.
- Psalm 84:8 O LORD GOD of hosts, hear my prayer: give ear O GOD of Jacob. Selah.
- Psalm 84:9 Behold, O GOD, our shield, and look upon the face of thine anointed.
- Psalm 84:10 For a day in THY courts is better than a thousand. I had rather be a doorkeeper in the House of my GOD, than to dwell in the temples of wickedness.

[Psalms] cont. 22

Psa 84:11 For the LORD GOD is a sun and shield: the LORD will give Grace and Glory: no good thing will HE withhold from them that walk uprightly.

→ Psa 84:12 O LORD of hosts, blessed is the man that trusteth in THEE.

Psa 85 A prayer asking the LORD to turn away HIS anger when we have sinned.

→ Psa 86 David's prayer for the LORD's tender mercy

Psa 86:3 Be merciful unto me, O LORD: for I cry unto THEE daily.

→ Psa 86:11 Teach me THY way, O LORD: I will walk in THY truth: unite my heart to fear THY name.

→ Psa 86:12 I will praise THEE O LORD my GOD, with all my heart: and I will glorify THY Name for evermore.

→ Psa 86:13 For great is THY mercy toward me: and THOU hast delivered my soul from the lowest hell.

Psa 87 The glory of the church.

→ Psa 88 A psalm to remind us that though our prayers are not soon answered, we must continue praying, the greater our troubles, the more earnest and serious we should be in prayer.

→ Psa 89 Faithfulness and covenant with David; Prophecy of CHRIST.

→ Psa 89:3 I have made a covenant with my chosen I have sworn unto David my servant.

[Psalms] cont. 23

→ Psa 89:4 Thy seed will I establish for ever, and build up thy throne into all generations.

→ Psa 89:18 For the LORD is our defence; and the HOLY ONE of Israel is our King.

Psa 89:26 He shall cry unto me, THOU art my Father, my GOD, and the rock of my salvation.

→ Psa 89:27 Also I will make him MY firstborn, higher than the kings of the earth.

Psa 89:28 MY mercy will I keep for him for evermore, and MY covenant shall stand fast with him.

→ Psa 89:29 His seed also will I make to endure for ever, and his throne as the days of heaven.

→ Psa 89:52 Blessed be the LORD for evermore. Amen, and Amen.

Psa 90 A prayer of Moses concerning the brevity of life.

→ Psa 90:4 For a thousand years in THY sight are but as yesterday when it is past, and as a watch in the night.

→ Psa 90:12 So teach us to number our days, that we may apply our hearts unto wisdom.

→ Psa 91 Foreshadowing of temptation of JESUS by satan: Matt 4:6, Luke 4:10, 11

Psa 91:1 He that dwelleth in the secret place of the Most HIGH shall abide under the shadow of the ALMIGHTY.

[Psalms] cont. 24

→ Psa 91:2 ... HE is my refuge and my fortress: my GOD; in HIM will I trust.

→ Psa 91:11 For HE shall give HIS angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways.

Psa 91:12 They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest thou dash THY foot against a stone.

Psa 92 A psalm for the Sabbath day.

→ Psa 92: It is a good thing to give thanks unto the LORD, and to sing praises unto THY Name, O most High.

Psa 93 The strength of the LORD.

Psa 94:11 The LORD knoweth the thoughts of men, that they are vanity.

→ Psa 94:12 Blessed is the man whom THOU chastenest, O LORD, and teachest him out of THY law;

→ Psa 94:13 That THOU may give him rest from the days of adversity, until the pit be digged for the wicked.

→ Psa 94:17 Unless the LORD had been my help, my soul had almost dwelt in silence.

Psa 94:19 In the multitude of my thoughts within me thy comforts delight my soul.

→ Psa 94:22 But the LORD is my defence, and my GOD is the rock of my refuge.

[Psalms] cont. 25

→ Psa 95:1 O come, let us sing unto the LORD: let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation.

→ Psa 95:2 Let us come before HIS presence with thanksgiving, and make a joyful noise unto HIM with psalms.

→ Psa 95:3 For the LORD is a great GOD, and a great KING above all gods.

Psa 96 Praise for the LORD

→ Psa 96:11 Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad; let the sea roar, and the fullness thereof.

→ Psa 96:13 Before the LORD: for HE cometh, for HE cometh to judge the earth: HE shall judge the world with righteousness, and the people with HIS truth. Acts 1:9-11

→ Psa 97 The glory and joy of the Redeemer.

→ Psa 97:9 For THOU, LORD, art high above all the earth: THOU art exalted far above all gods.

→ Psa 98:4 Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all the earth: make a loud noise, and rejoice, and sing praise.

→ Psa 98:9 ... for HE cometh to judge the earth: with righteousness shall HE judge the world, and the people with equity.

→ Psa 99:9 Exalt the LORD our GOD, and worship at his holy hill; for the LORD our GOD is Holy.

→ Psa 100 #1 Psalm praising the LORD w/ Psa 23

* Psa 100:1 Make a joyful noise unto the LORD,
all ye lands.

◇ Psa 100:2 Serve the LORD with gladness: come
before HIS presence with singing.

→ Psa 100:3 Know ye that the LORD HE is GOD:
it is HE that hath made us, and not we ourselves;
we are HIS people and the sheep of HIS pasture.

◇ Psa 100:4 Enter unto HIS gates with thanksgiving,
and unto HIS courts with praise: be thankful
unto HIM and bless HIS name.

◇ Psa 100:5 For the LORD is good; HIS mercy
is everlasting; and HIS truth endureth
to all generations.

Psa 101 David's psalm declaring his praise
of the LORD.

→ Psa 101:2 I will behave myself wisely
in a perfect way. O when wilt THOU
come unto me? I will walk within
my house with a perfect heart.
