

## [Psalms] cont 27

1-21-19

Psa 102:1 Hear my prayer, O LORD, and let my cry come unto THEE.

Psa 102:2 Hide not THY face from me in the day when I am in trouble; incline thine ear unto me: in the day when I call answer me speedily.

Psa 102:12 But THOU, O LORD, shalt endure for ever; and THY remembrance unto all generations.

Psa 102:17 HE will regard the prayer of the destitute, and not despise their prayer.

Psa 102:25 Of old hast THOU laid the foundation of the earth: and the heavens are the work of THY hands.

Psa 102:28 The children of THY servants shall continue, and their seed shall be established before thee.

Psa 103 David's Psalm of the Great Mercies of the LORD.

Psa 103:1 Bless the LORD O my soul: and all that is within me, bless HIS HOLY Name.

Psa 103:2 As far as the East is from the West, so far hath HE removed our transgressions from us.

Psa 103:13 Like as a father piteth his children, so the LORD piteth them that fear HIM. (respect HIM)

Psa 103:14 For HE knoweth our frame; HE remembereth that we are dust.

## [Psalms] cont 29

Psa 109:1-5 David tells of the wrongdoings of his enemies.

Psa 109:6-20 David asks for the LORD's help in dealing with his enemies.

\* Psa 109:21-31 Prayers and Praises for the LORD's help.

Psa 109:26 Help me, O LORD my GOD; O save me according to THY mercy:

Psa 109:27 That they may know that this is THY Hand; that THOU, LORD hast done it.

+ Psa 110 This Psalm announces the eternal priesthood of Messiah.

++ Psa 110:1 The LORD said unto my LORD, Sit THOU at MY Right Head until I make thine enemies THY footstool.

+ Psa 110:4 The LORD hath sworn, and will not repeat THOU art a Priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek.

++ Psa 111:10 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do HIS commandments: HIS praise endureth for ever.

\* Psa 112 Rewards to those who respect the LORD and trust HIM.

++ Psa 112:1 Praise ye the LORD. Blessed is the man that feareth the LORD, that delighteth greatly in HIS commandments.

Psa 104 The LORD's Majesty is everywhere.

→ Psa 105 A review of the LORD's Covenants with HIS people, Israel. History up to David.

Psa 105:4 Seek the LORD and HIS strength: seek HIS face evermore.

X Psa 105:5 Remember HIS marvellous works that HE hath done; HIS wonders and the judgements of HIS mouth;

→ Psa 105:6 O ye seed of Abraham HIS servant ye children of Jacob HIS chosen.

Psa 106 Summary of the LORD's works with Israel and their failure to remember HIM.

Psa 107:2 Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, whom HE hath redeemed from the hand of the enemy

→ Psa 107:43 Whoso is wise, and will observe these things, even they shall understand the loving kindness of the LORD.

Psa 107 The LORD's kindness and mercy toward man are soon forgotten until times of trouble.

→ Only then does man remember the LORD.

+ Psa 108:13 Through GOD we shall do valiantly: for HE it is that shall tread down our enemies

→ Psa 109 David's prayer for justice from his enemies.

## [Psalms] cont 30

Psa 112:7 He shall not be afraid of evil tidings: his heart is fixed, trusting in the LORD.

Psa 113:7 HE raiseth up the poor, out of the dust, and lift the needy out of the dung hill;

Psa 113:8 That HE may set him with princes...

Psa 113:9 HE maketh the barren woman to keep house and to be a joyful mother of children. Praise ye the LORD.

Psa 114 The Strength of the LORD; over Seas, Mountains and the whole earth!

Psa 115:11 Yet that fear the LORD, trust in the LORD: HE is their help and their shield

Psa 115:13 HE will bless them that fear the LORD, both small and great.

Psa 115:15 Ye are blessed of the LORD which make heaven and earth.

Psa 115:16 The heaven, even the heavens, are the LORD's: but the earth hath HE given to the children of men.

Psa 116:6 The LORD preserveth the simple: I was brought low, and HE helped me.

Psa 116:13 I will take the cup of salvation, and call upon the name of the LORD.

X Psa 116:17 I will offer to THEE the sacrifice of Thanksgiving, and will call upon the name of the LORD.

Psa 117:1 O praise the LORD, all ye nations: praise HIM, all ye people.

→ Psa 118 HIS mercy endureth for ever.

\* Psa 118:5 I called upon the LORD in distress: the LORD answered me and set me in a large place.

Boxed Psa 118:6 The LORD is on my side; I will not fear: what can man do unto me?

Boxed Psa 118:8 It is better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in man.

→ Psa 118:18 The LORD hath chastened me sore: but HE hath not given me over unto death.

+ Psa 118:22 The Stone which the builders refused is become the head stone of the corner.

\* Psa 118:24 This is the day which the LORD hath made; we will rejoice and be glad in it.

+ Psa 118:28 THOU art my GOD, and I will praise THEE: THOU art my GOD, I will exalt THEE.

+ Psa 118 note The Messianic Psalms.

+ Psa 119 22 Prayers in one Psalm.

Psa 119:2 Blessed are they that keep HIS testimonies, and that seek HIM with the whole heart.

Psa 119:81 My soul fainteth for THY salvation: but I hope in THY Word.

## [Psalms] cont 33

Psa 122 Concern for the City of Jerusalem, where the people come to worship the LORD.

Psa 122:6 Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: they shall prosper that love thee.

Psa 123:1 Unto THEE lift I up mine eyes, O Thou that dwellest in the heavens.

→ Psa 124:2 If it had not been the LORD who was on our side, when men rose up against us:

→ Psa 124:3 Then they had swallowed us up quick, when their wrath was kindled against us.

→ Psa 125:1 They that trust in the LORD shall be as Mount Zion, which cannot be removed, but abideth forever.

Psa 125:4 Do good, O LORD, unto those that be good, and to them that are upright in their hearts.

Psa 126 A song "of ascent". Perhaps chanted by the people as they went up to Jerusalem to the feasts.

Psa 127:1 Except the LORD build the house, they labour in vain that build it: except the LORD keep the city, the watchmen wake not but in vain.

Psa 128:1 Blessed is every one that feareth the LORD - that walketh in his ways.

→ Psa 128:2-6 Those who are respectful and loyal to the LORD shall be greatly blessed.

→ Psa 128:6 Yea, thou shalt see thy children's children.

Psa 129 The LORD hath protected us from our enemies.

## [Psalms] cont 32

Boxed Psa 119:98 THOU through THY Commandments hast made me wiser than mine enemies: for they are ever with me.

Psa 119:107 I am afflicted very much: quicken me, O LORD, according to THY Word.

→ Psa 119:114 THOU art my hiding place and my shield: I hope in THY Word.

Psa 119:125 I am THY servant; give me understanding that I may know THY Testimonies.

Psa 119:135 Make THY Face to shine upon thy servant; and teach me THY Statutes.

Psa 119:149 Hear my voice unto THY lovingkindness, O LORD, quicken me unto THY judgement.

Psa 119:154 Plead my cause, and deliver me: quicken me according to THY Word.

Boxed Psa 119:176 I have gone astray like a lost sheep; seek THY servant; for I do not forget THY Commandments.

→ Psa 120 In my distress I cried unto the LORD, and HE heard me.

Psa 121:2 My help cometh from the LORD, which made heaven and earth.

Boxed Psa 121:7 The LORD shall preserve thee from all evil: HE shall preserve thy soul.

Psa 130:5 I wait for the LORD, my soul doth wait, and in HIS WORD do I hope.

Psa 131:3 Let Israel hope in the LORD from henceforth and forever.

→ Psa 132:12 If thy children will keep MY covenant and MY testimony, that I shall teach them, their children shall also sit upon thy throne, for everyone

Psa 132:13 For the LORD hath chosen Zion; HE hath desired it for HIS habitation.

→ Psa 132:17 There will I make the horn of David to bud: I have ordained a lamp for MY Anointed.

Psa 133:1 Behold how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity.

Psa 134:2 Lift up your hands in the sanctuary and bless the LORD.

→ Psa 135:1 Praise ye the LORD. Praise ye the Name of the LORD; praise HIM, O ye servants of the LORD.

Boxed Psa 135:5 For I know that the LORD is great, and that our LORD is above all gods.

Psa 136:1 O give thanks unto the LORD; for HE is good: for HIS Mercy endureth for ever.

Psa 137:1 By the rivers of Babylon, there we sat down, yea, we wept, when we remembered Zion.

Psa 138:3 In the day when I cried THOU answered me and strengthened me with strength in my soul.

Psa 138:7 Though I walk in the midst of trouble,  
 Thou wilt revive me: Thou shalt stretch forth THINE hand against the wrath of mine enemies, and THY right hand shall save me.

Psa 139:1 O LORD, THOU hast searched me, and known me.

Psa 139:17 How precious also are THY thoughts unto me, O GOD! how great is the sum of them!

Psa 139:23 Search me, O GOD, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts:

Psa 139:24 And see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way ever lasting.

Psa 140:1 Deliver me, O LORD, from the evil man: preserve me from the violent man;

Psa 140:4 Keep me, O LORD, from the hands of the wicked; preserve me from the violent man; who have purposed to overthrow my goings.

Psa 140:6 I said unto the LORD, THOU art my GOD: hear the Voice of my sapplication, O LORD.

Psa 140:7 O GOD the LORD, the strength of my salvation, THOU hast covered my head in the day of battle.

++ Psa 145:8 The LORD is high unto all them that call upon HIM, to all that call upon HIM in Truth.

++ Psa 146:5 Happy is he that hath the GOD of Jacob for his help, whose hope is in the LORD his GOD.

++ Psa 146:10 The LORD shall reign for ever, even, thy GOD, O Zion, unto all generations. Praise ye the LORD.

++ Psa 147:19 HE sheweth HIS WORD unto Jacob, HIS statutes and HIS judgements unto Israel.

++ Psa 147:20 HE hath not dealt so with any nation: and as for HIS judgements, they have not known them. Praise ye the LORD.

Psa 148:13 Let them praise the name of the LORD: for HIS name alone is excellent; HIS Glory is above the earth and Heaven.

Psa 141:1 LORD, I cry unto thee: make haste unto me; give ear unto my voice, when I cry unto THEE.

D Psa 141:8 But mine eyes are unto THEE, O GOD the LORD: in THEE is my Trust; leave not my soul destitute.

Psa 142:5 I cried unto THEE, O LORD: I said, THOU art my refuge and my portion in the land of the living.

+ Psa 143 A prayer of David when in despair.

+ Psa 143:7 Hear me speedily, O LORD: my spirit faileth: hide not THY Face from me, lest I be like unto them that go down into the pit.

++ Psa 144:4 Man is like to vanity: his days are as a shadow that passeth away.

D Psa 144:5 ... yea, Happy is that people, whose GOD is the LORD.

Psa 145:8 The LORD is gracious, and full of compassion; slow to anger, and of great mercy.

D Psa 145:10 All THY works shall praise THEE, O LORD; and THY saints shall bless THEE.
