Prov 14 A wise woman and a Faithful Witness Ignore the counsel of Fools and be Slow to Anger.

Prov 15:3 The eyes of the LORD are in every place, beholding the evil and the good.

[Proverbs] (cont.)

Pro 15:29 The LORD is far from the wicked but HE heareth the prayer of the Righteous.

Pro 16 A man's heart leads him to Faith and Trust in the LORD.

Pro 17 Be kind to the poor, the glory of grandchildren, avoid foolish people

Pro 18 The blessings of finding a wise and a close friend.

Pro 19 The LORD's gift of a prudent wife, being kind to the poor, the discipline of children, and keeping the LORD in your heart.

Pro 20 Strong drink reduces wisdom, an honorable man ceases from strife, the children of a just man are blessed, the talent-bearer who revealeth secrets, honor thy father and thy mother, the spirit of a man is the candle of the LORD.

Pro 21 Justice and Judgement severed by the LORD, avoid life with an angry woman, seek righteousness and mercy, one who keepeth his mouth and his tongue, keepeth his soul from troubles.

Pro 22 A good name is better than riches, Trust in the LORD for riches, honor, life. Teach your children when they are young, so they won't forget when they are old.

Pro 23 Labour not to be rich; avoid fools; correct your children to save them; wise children are a blessing; Seek truth, wisdom, instruction, and understanding.

Prov 24 A house is established by wisdom and understanding; the LORD knows our heart; be not a witness without cause.

Prov 25-29 Proverbs of Solomon chosen by the men of King Hezekiah.

Prov 26:1-12 A Fool and his Folly; avoid Foolish people; be not gaily.

Prov 27 Boast not upon thyself, but, let another man praise thee; disregard praise from thine enemy; A prudent man foreseeth evil.

Be diligent to know the state of thy flock's

Prov 28 Evil men don't understand judgement, but they that seek the LORD understand all; whoso cause the righteous to go astray, shall fall himself into the pit; whoso confesseth sin shall have mercy.

Whoso robbeth his Father or Mother is a companion of a destroyer;

He that hath a proud heart stirreth up strife; but he that trusteth in the LORD shall be made large in life.

He that giveth unto the poor shall not lack.

Prov 29: The righteous consider the cause of the poor

A fool uttereth all his mind; but a wise man keep it in until afterwards

The rod and reproof give wisdom; but a child left to himself, bringeth his mother to shame.

Prov 29:17 Correct thy son and he shall give thee rest; yea, he shall give light unto thy soul

[Proverbs] cont. 3

Prov 29: (cont) A man that is hasty in his words is less than a fool;

An angry man stirreth up strife;

A man's pride shall bring him low; but honor shall uphold the humble in spirit

Prov 29:25 The fear of man bringeth a snare; but whoso putteth his Trust in the LORD shall be safe.

Prov 30:5 Every word of GOD is pure: HE is a shield unto them that put their trust in HIM.
