

Isaiah

Isa 1:1-24 The vision of Isaiah in which GOD tells of sins of Judah and Jerusalem.

* Isa 1:26-27 The LORD renews the promise of the Palestinian Covenant.

Isa 2 The vision of the coming kingdom.

Isa 2:2 And it shall come to pass in the last days that the mountain of the LORD's house shall be established in the top of the mountains and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow unto it.

> Isa 2:6-22 Necessity of humility in the day of the LORD.

Isa 2:12 For the day of the LORD of hosts shall be upon everyone that is proud and lofty, and upon every one that is lifted up; and he shall be brought low.

> Isa 3 GOD forewarns the people about the calamities they were about to endure!

Isa 3:5 And the people shall be oppressed, every one by another, and every one by his neighbor: the child shall behave himself proudly against the ancient, and the base against the honourable.

Isa 3:8 For Jerusalem is ruined and Judah is fallen: because their tongue and their doings are against the LORD, to provoke the eyes of his glory.

Isa 4 The vision of the future kingdom.

Isa 4:2 In that day shall the BRANCH of the LORD be beautiful and glorious, and the fruit of the earth shall be excellent and comely for them that are escaped of Israel.

Isaiah cont. 2

Isa 6:9-13 Isaiah's new commission

Isa 6:9 And HE said, Go, and tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not; and see ye indeed, but perceive not.

→ Isa 7:10-16 Immanuel Prediction

Isa 7:14 Therefore the LORD HIMSELF shall give you a sign; Behold a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call HIS name IMMANUEL.

Isa 7:17-25 Prediction of the invasion of Judah.

Isa 8 Prediction of the Assyrian invasion

Isa 8:8 Coming of Immanuel

Isa 8:8 And HE shall pass through Judah, HE shall overflow and go over, HE shall reach even to the neck; and the stretching out of HIS wings shall fill the breadth of thy land, O IMMANUEL.

→ Isa 9 Birth of JESUS foretold.

Isa 9:6 For unto us a CHILD is born, unto us a SON is given; and the government shall be upon HIS shoulder: and HIS name shall be called WONDERFUL, COUNSELLOR, THE MIGHTY GOD, THE EVER-LASTING FATHER, THE PRINCE OF PEACE!

Isa 10:5-19 Assyria is GOD's instrument against HIS people, Assyria to be destroyed later.

Isa 10:20-27 A Jewish remnant shall return to GOD.

→ Isa 11 The LORD JESUS shall come from the BRANCH of Jesse.

Isaiah cont.

Isa 5 Parable of Jehovah's Vineyard

Isa 5:1-7 Israel, the LORD's Vineyard, is to receive judgement from the LORD.

Isa 5:8-23 The judgements and woes to come.

Isa 5:24-30 The exhortations of these judgements.

Isa 5:21 Woe unto them that are wise in their own eyes and prudent in their own sight.

Isa 5:25 Therefore is the anger of the LORD kindled against HIS people, and HE hath stretched forth HIS hand against them, and hath smitten them... For all this HIS anger is not turned away, but HIS hand is stretched out still.

Isa 6:1-4 Isaiah's vision which leads to his transformation.

Isa 6:5 Then said I, Woe is me! for I am undone, because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: for mine eyes have seen the KING, the LORD of HOSTS.

Isa 6:6-8 The cleansing fire.

Isa 6:6 Then flew one of the seraphims unto me, having a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with the tongs from off the altar:

Isa 6:7 And he laid it upon my mouth, and said, Lo, this hath touched thy lips; and thine iniquity is taken away, and thy sin purged.

Isa 6:8 Also I heard the voice of the LORD, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for us? Then said I, Here am I; send me.

Isaiah cont. 3

Isa 11:1 And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse and a BRANCH shall grow out of his roots:

Isa 11:2 And the SPIRIT of the LORD shall rest upon HIM, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD.

Isa 12:2 Behold, GOD is my salvation; I will trust and not be afraid: for the LORD JEHOVAH is my strength and my song; HE also is become my salvation.

Isa 13 The prediction of the Fall of Babylon.

→ Isa 14:12-14 Prediction of Satan's Fall

Isa 14:12 How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! how art thou cut down to the ground, which did weaken the nation!

→ Isa 14:15 Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit.

Isa 15 The judgement of Moab.

Isa 16 The pride of Moab, refusing Israel's fugitives.

Isa 17 The prediction of the fall of Syria.

Isa 18 The fall of Ethiopia is foretold.

Isa 19 The destruction of Egypt.

Isa 20 Prophecy that Assyria will destroy Egypt, Ethiopia.

Isa 21 Sennacherib of Assyria's invasion of Babylon, Arabia.

Isa 22 Arabia war Desha, son of Ishmael, a.k.a. Edom.

Isa 22 Woe to Jerusalem.

Isa 23 Downfall of Tyre.

→ Isa 24:16-21 Prediction of Tribulation & Armageddon.

Isaiah cont. 4

Isa 25 Triumphs of the Kingdom Age

Isa 25:1 O LORD THOU art my GOD; I will exalt THEE, I will praise THY NAME;

For thou hast done wonderful things; THY counsels of old are Faithfulness and truth.

Isa 26:4 Trust ye in the LORD for ever:

For in the LORD JEHOVAH is everlasting strength.

Isa 27:1 In that day the LORD with HIS sore and great and strong sword shall punish Leviathan the piercing serpent, even Leviathan that crooked serpent; and HE shall slay the dragon that is in the sea.

Isa 27:6-13 A promise of HIS people to be recalled to DIVINE Favor.

Isa 28 Prediction of the Assyrian capture of Ephraim.

Isa 29 Jerusalem (Ariel) and Judah warned of impending discipline.

Isa 30 Judah warned not to make an Alliance with Egypt.

Isa 30:1 Woe to the rebellious children, saith the LORD that take counsel, but not of ME; and that cover with a covering, but not of MY SPIRIT, that they may add sin to sin. Isa 30:8 BOOK of the LORD

Isa 31:1 Woe to them that go down to Egypt for help; and stay on horses and trust in chariots, because they are many; and in horsemen, because they are very strong; but they look not unto the HOLY ONE of Israel neither seek the LORD.

Isa 31:5 As the birds flying, so will the LORD of Hosts defend Jerusalem; defending HE will also deliver it, and passing over HE will preserve it.

Isaiah cont. 5

Isa 32 Prophecy of the Coming of CHRIST

Isa 32:1 Behold, a KING shall reign in righteousness, and princes shall rule in judgement.

Isa 32:9-20 A time of tribulation but then peace and blessings.

Isa 33:1-14 God's judgements against the enemies of HIS church.

Isa 33:17 Thine eyes shall see the KING in HIS beauty; they shall behold the land that is very far off.

Isa 33:22 For the LORD is our judge, the LORD is our lawgiver, the LORD is our KING; HE will save us.

Isa 34 The day of the LORD: Armageddon

Isa 34:2 For the indignation of the LORD is upon all nations...

Isa 34:1-8 A prophecy of the wars of the LORD

Isa 34:8 For it is the DAY of the LORD's vengeance

Isa 34:16 Seek ye out of the books of the LORD and read:

Isa 35:4 Say to them that are of a fearful heart, BE strong, fear not: behold, your GOD will come with vengeance, even GOD with a revengence; HE will come and save you.

Isa 36 Sennacherib, king of Assyria's invasion of Judah.

Isa 37 The LORD destroys the Assyrian army.

Isa 37:20 Now therefore O LORD our GOD, save us from his hand that all the kingdoms of the earth may know that THOU art the LORD, even THOU only.

Isa 37:35 For I will defend this city to save it for mine own sake, and for my servant David's sake.

Isaiah cont. 6

Isa 37:36 Then the angel of the LORD went forth and smote in the camp of the Assyrians a hundred and fourscore and five thousand; and when they arose in the morning, they were all dead corpses.

Isa 38 Hezekiah's sickness & recovery. The "Miracle of the Sundial."

Isa 38:2 Then Hezekiah turned his face toward the wall, and prayed unto the Lord,

Isa 38:3 And said, remember now O LORD I beseech thee, how I have walked before thee in truth and with a perfect heart, and have done that which is good in thy sight. And Hezekiah wept sore.

Isa 38:4 Then came the word of the LORD to Isaiah saying,

Isa 38:5 Go, and say unto Hezekiah, Thus saith the LORD the GOD of David thy father, I have heard thy prayer, I have seen thy tears: behold, I will add unto thy days fifteen years.

Isa 38:6 And I will deliver thee and this city out of the hand of the King of Assyria; and I will defend this city.

Isa 38:7 And this shall be a sign unto thee from the LORD, that the LORD will do this thing that HE hath spoken;

Isa 38:8 Behold, I will bring again the shadow of degrees, which is gone down in the sun dial of Ahaz, ten degrees backward.

So the sun returned ten degrees, by which degrees, it was gone down.

see 2 kings 20: 8-11

Isaiah cont. 7

Isa 39 Hezekiah shows all his treasures to the men from Babylon.

Isa 39:5 Then said Isaiah to Hezekiah, Hear the word of the LORD of Hosts:

Isa 39:6 Behold, the days come, that all that is in thine house, and that which thy fathers have laid up in store until this day, shall be carried to Babylon: nothing shall be left, saith the LORD.

Isa 40 John the Baptist

Isa 40:3 The voice of him that crieth in the wilderness, Prepare ye the WAY of the LORD, make straight in the desert a highway for our GOD.

Isa 41 The LORD raised up a man from the East to act as HIS servant.

Isa 41:4 WHO hath wrought and done it, calling the generations from the beginning? I the LORD, the FIRST, and with the LAST; I AM HE.

Isa 41:13 For I the LORD thy GOD will hold thy right hand, saying unto thee, Fear not; I will help thee.

Isa 41:17 When the poor and needy seek water, and there is none, and their tongue faileth for thirst, I the LORD will hear them, I the GOD of Israel will not forsake them.

Isa 42 CHRIST the servant of JEHOVAH.

Isa 42:1 Behold, my servant, whom I uphold; mine elect, in whom my soul delighteth; I have put my SPIRIT upon HIM; HE shall bring forth judgement unto the Gentiles.

[Isaiah] cont. 8

→ Isa 42:6 The salvation of the Gentiles

Isa 42:6 I the LORD have called thee in righteousness, and will hold thine hand, and will keep thee, and give thee for a covenant of the people, for a light of the Gentiles.

Isa 43 Israel to be redeemed and restored

Isa 43:1 But now thus saith the LORD that created thee, O Jacob, and HE that formed thee
→ O Israel, Fear not: for I have redeemed thee, I have called thee by thy name; thou art mine.

→ Isa 43:3 For I AM the LORD thy GOD, the HOLY ONE of Israel, thy SAVIOUR:

Isa 43:5 Fear not: for I AM with thee: I will bring thy seed from the east, and gather thee from the west;

Isa 43:10 Ye are MY witnesses, saith the LORD, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe ME, and understand that I AM HE: before ME there was no God formed, neither shall there be after ME.

Isa 43:11 I, even I, AM the LORD; and beside ME there is no SAVIOUR.

Isa 43:25 I, even I, AM HE that blottereth out thy transgressions for mine own sake, and will not remember thy sins.

Isa 44 The LORD the only GOD !!

Isa 44:6 Thus saith the LORD the KING of Israel and HIS REDEEMER the LORD of HOSTS, I AM the FIRST, and I AM the LAST; and beside ME there is no GOD

[Isaiah] cont. 9

Isa 44:21 Remember these, O Jacob and Israel: for thou art my servant: I have formed thee, thou art my servant: O Israel, thou shalt not be forgotten of me.

Isa 44:22 I have blotted out, as a thick cloud, thy transgressions, and as a cloud, thy sins: return unto me; for I have redeemed thee.

Isa 44:24 Thus saith the LORD thy redeemer, and HE that formed thee from the womb, I AM the LORD that maketh all things; that stretcheth forth the heavens alone; that spreadeth abroad the earth by myself;

* Isa 44:28 The prophecy concerning Cyrus; the restoration under Ezra and Nehemiah;

→ Isa 45:1-4 Cyrus is called the LORD's "anointed" the only time it is ever applied to a Gentile.

Isa 45:1-4 The deliverance of the Jews by Cyrus.

→ Isa 45:4 For Jacob thy servant's sake, and Israel mine elect, I have even called thee by thy name: I have surnamed thee, though thou hast not known thee,

Isa 45:5 I AM the LORD, and there is none else, there is no GOD beside ME: I girded thee, though thou hast not known ME.

Isa 45:22 Look unto ME, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I AM GOD, and there is none else!

[Isaiah] cont. 10

Isa 46:9 Remember the former things of old: for I AM GOD, and there is none else; I AM GOD, and there is none like ME.

Isa 47 Judgement upon Babylon

Isa 48:12 Hearken unto ME, O Jacob, and Israel, MY called; I AM HE, I AM the FIRST, I also AM the LAST.

Isa 48:17 Thus saith the LORD thy REDEEMER, the HOLY ONE of Israel; I AM the LORD thy GOD which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go.

Isa 48:22 There is no peace, saith the LORD, unto the wicked.

Isa 49:6 ... I will also give thee for a light to the Gentiles, that thou mayest be my salvation unto the end of the earth.

Isa 49:22 Thus saith the LORD GOD, Behold, I will lift up mine hand to the Gentiles, and set up my standard unto the people...

Isa 49:26 ... and all flesh shall know that I the LORD AM thy SAVIOUR and thy REDEEMER, the mighty ONE of Jacob.

Isa 50 The humiliation of the HOLY One.

Isa 50:49 The sufferings and exaltation of the MESSIAH.

Isa 51 Israel to be redeemed, oppressors punished.

[Isaiah] cont. 11

→ Isa 48:16 [Isaiah] sent by the LORD GOD, and HIS SPIRIT.

Isa 52 Vision of Jerusalem in the Kingdom Age,

→ Isa 52:13-15 CHRIST JEHOVAH'S servant is manned and exalted. The prediction of the brutalities against HIM.

Isa 53 Suffering of CHRIST is foretold

Isa 53:5 But HE was wounded for our transgressions, HE was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon HIM, and with HIS stripes we are healed.

Isa 53:6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on HIM the iniquity of us all.

Isa 54:5 ... the LORD of HOSTS is HIS name, and thy REDEEMER the HOLY ONE of Israel; the GOD of the whole earth shall HE be called.

Isa 54:6-10 The LORD is not angry with HIS people forever. HIS MERCY is swift.

Isa 55:3 Incline your ear and come unto ME: hear and your soul shall live; and I will make an ever lasting covenant with you, even the sure mercies of David.

Isa 55:6-13 Gracious offers of pardon and peace.

→ Isa 56:7 ... for mine house shall be called a house of prayer for all people.

Isa 57:15 The LORD dwells with the humble and those who have remorse for their sins (for contrite or contrition.)

Isaiah cont. 12

Isa 58:1-7 Fasting - Right and Wrong

Isa 58:8-12 Blessings on the charitable

Isa 58:13-14 Proper Keeping of the Sabbath.

Isa 59:15 Yea, truth faileth; and he that departeth from evil maketh himself a prey: and the LORD saw it, and it displeased HIM that there was no judgement.

Isa 59:16 And HE saw that there was no man, and wondered that there was no INTERCESSOR: therefore HIS arm brought salvation unto him; and HIS righteousness, it sustained him.

Isa 59:17 For HE put on righteousness as a breastplate, and a helmet of salvation upon his head; and he put on the garments of vengeance for clothing, and was clad with zeal as a cloke.

Isa 59:18 According to their deeds, accordingly he will repay, fury to HIS adversaries, recompence to HIS enemies; to the islands HE will repay recompence.

Isa 59:19 so shall they see the name of the LORD from the west, and HIS glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the SPIRIT of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him.

Isa 59:20 And the REDEEMER shall come to Zion and unto them that turn from transgression in Jacob, saith the LORD!

Isaiah cont. 14

Isa 65:9 And I will bring forth a seed out of Jacob, and out of Judah an inheritor of my mountains; and mine elect shall inherit it, and my servants shall dwell there.

Isa 65:17 For, behold, I create new heavens and a new earth: for, behold, I create Jerusalem a rejoicing, and her people a joy.

Isa 66 The New Heaven and the New Earth

Isa 66:1 Thus saith the LORD, The heaven is MY throne, and the earth is MY footstool: where is the house that ye build unto ME? and where is the place of MY rest?

Isa 66:22 For as the new heavens and the new earth, which I will make, shall remain before ME, saith the LORD, so shall your seed and your name remain.

Isaiah cont. 13

Isa 59:21 As for ME, this is MY covenant with them, saith the LORD: MY SPIRIT that is upon thee, and MY words which I have put in thy mouth, shall not depart out of thy mouth, nor out of the mouth of thy seed, nor out of the mouth of thy seed's seed, saith the LORD, from henceforth and for ever.

Isa 60:1 Arise, shine: for THY LIGHT is come, and the GLORY of the LORD is risen upon thee.

Isa 60 The glories of the church of GOD, when both Israel and Gentiles become the Kingdom of our LORD, and of HIS CHRIST.

Isa 61:1-2 Prophecy of Jesus' First sermon in Nazareth i.e. Luke 4:16-21

Isa 61:2 2 Advents - Prophecy

Isa 62:1-5 The Son of GOD here assures HIS church of HIS unshaking love and HIS pleading for her under all trials and difficulties.

Isa 62:12 And they shall call them, The HOLY people, The redeemed of the LORD: and thou shalt be called, fought out, A city not forsaken.

Isa 63:1-6 CHRIST'S victory over HIS enemies.

Isa 63:7-14 HIS mercy toward HIS church.

Isa 64:8 But now, O LORD, thou art our FATHER, we are the clay, and THOU our potter, and we all are the work of THY Hand.
