

Hosea

Hos 1 Hosea was a prophet during the times of 4 kings in Judah, including Hezekiah.

Hos 1:1-7 Hosea's marriage is a prediction of the unfaithfulness of Israel.

Hos 1:10-11 The Future Restoration of Israel

Hos 2 The idolatry of Israel, portrayed as an Adulterous Wife, to be restored.

Hos 3:5 Afterward shall the children of Israel return, and seek the LORD their GOD, and David their King; and shall fear the LORD and HIS goodness in the latter days.

Hos 4:1 Hear the word of the LORD, ye children of Israel: for the LORD hath a controversy with the inhabitants of the land, because there is no truth, nor mercy, nor knowledge of GOD in the land.

Hos 5 The Priests are chastised for their role in the downfall of Israel.

Hos 6 The Resurrection is foretold.

Hos 6:2 After two days will HE rouse: in the Third Day HE will raise us up, and we shall live in HIS sight.

Hos 7 A Lamentation for Israel, as portrayed through the actions of Ephraim and Samaria.

Hos 8 Israel claims to know the LORD, but they do not follow HIM or HIS commandments.

Hos 9 Israel's ingratitude

Hos 10 The sins of Israel, Ephraim, & Samaria.

Hos 11:10 They shall walk after the LORD: HE shall roar like a lion: when HE shall roar, then the children will tremble from the west.

Hosea cont.

Hos 12 The LORD further rebukes Ephraim and Judah for their sins.

Hos 12:9 And I that AM the LORD thy GOD from the Land of Egypt will yet make thee to dwell in tabernacles, as in the days of the solemn feast.

Hos 13:4 Yet I AM the LORD thy GOD from the land of Egypt, and thou shalt know no god but ME: for there is no SAVIOUR beside ME.

Hos 14:1 O Israel, return unto the LORD thy GOD; for thou hast fallen by thine iniquity.

Hos 14:2 Take with you words, and turn to the LORD: say unto HIM, Take away all iniquity, and receive us graciously: so will we render the calves of our lips.

Hos 14:4 I will heal their backsliding, I will love them freely: for mine anger is turned away from him.
