

Ezekiel

Eze 1: Ezekiel's vision of the LORD and HIS GLORY!

Eze 1:3 The WORD of the LORD came expressly unto Ezekiel the priest, the son of Buzai, in the land of the Chaldeans by the river Chebar; and the HAND of the LORD was there upon him.

Eze 1:10 The four faces in which GOD would reveal HIMSELF when HE incarnated HIMSELF in human flesh as MESSIAH.

Eze 1:24-25 The voice of the ALMIGHTY.

Eze 2:1 And HE said unto me, Son of Man, stand upon thy feet, and I will speak unto thee.

Eze 2:2 And the SPIRIT entered into me, and set me upon my feet, that I heard HIM that spake unto me.

Eze 2:3-10 Ezekiel's commission from the LORD

Eze 2:6-8 The LORD tells Ezekiel not to fear those who would oppose him.

Eze 2:9-10 The BOOK of lamentations, mourning, and woe is presented.

Eze 3 Ezekiel is prepared for his work as a prophet. The LORD appears & talks to him.

Eze 3:14 So the SPIRIT lifted me up, and took me away, and I went in bitterness, in the heat of my spirit; but the hand of the LORD was strong upon me.

Eze 3:17 Son of man, I have made thee a watchman unto the House of Israel: therefore hear the word at my mouth, and give them warning from ME.

Ezekiel cont. 2

Eze 7 The LORD tells Ezekiel of the desolation of Israel that is to come.

Eze 7:22 MY FACE will I turn also from them, and they shall pollute MY Secret Place: for the robbers shall enter into it, and defile it.

Eze 8:1-4 Ezekiel has a vision of a Sirey figure, who was the HOLY SPIRIT, who lifted him up and took him to Jerusalem.

Eze 8:4 And, behold, the GLORY of the God of Israel was there, according to the vision that I saw in the plain.

Eze 8:5-17 The temple is defiled, including the HOLY of HOLIES. Men worship the sun, and women worship Adonis, a great god.

Eze 9 The Vision of the slaying in Jerusalem.

Eze 9:3-7 The GLORY of GOD leaves from above the Mercy Seat of the Ark of the Covenant to the threshold of the Temple.

The LORD tells the messenger to place a mark on the foreheads of those to be saved from the slaying.

Eze 9:8-11 The slaying begins.

Eze 10 The vision of Altar Fire scattered over Jerusalem.

Eze 10:8-22 The Divine Glory departing from the Temple.

Ezekiel cont.

Eze 3:22-27 The LORD speaks to Ezekiel and tells him of the time he will be mute.

Eze 3:26 And I will make thy tongue cleave to the roof of thy mouth, that thou shalt be dumb...

Eze 3:27 But when I speak with thee, I will open thy mouth, and thou shalt say unto them, Thus saith the LORD GOD; He that heareth, let him hear; and he that forbeareth, let him forbear: for they are a rebellious house.

Eze 4 Ezekiel provides signs to predict the siege of Jerusalem.

Eze 5:1-4 Ezekiel must shave his beard to signify the LORD's utter rejection of Israel and Judah.

Eze 5:5-17 The LORD to send famine and beasts to destroy the land.

Eze 5:17 So will I send upon you famine and evil beasts, and they shall bereave thee; and pestilence and blood shall pass through thee; and I will bring the sword upon thee. I the LORD have spoken it.

Eze 6 The idolatry of Israel & Judah to be punished.

Eze 6:14 So will I stretch out MY hand upon them, and make the land desolate, yea, more desolate than the wilderness toward Diblath, in all their habitations: and they shall know that I AM the LORD.

Ezekiel cont. 3

Eze 10:18 Then the GLORY of the LORD departed from off the threshold of the house, and stood over the cherubims.

Eze 10:20 This is the living creature that I saw under the GOD of Israel by the river of Chebar; and I knew that they were the cherubims.

Eze 11 The Wicked Leaders of Jerusalem to be judged.

Eze 11:14-21 A remnant of Israel to be restored to Jerusalem.

Eze 11:22-25 The vision of the GLORY of the LORD departing from the mount of Olives.

Eze 12 The LORD tells Ezekiel to act as a sign to the people, by preparing to move and by digging through a well.

Eze 12:17-28 The LORD tells Ezekiel that the people will be removed from Israel in the near future.

Eze 12:27 Son of man, behold, they of the house of Israel say, The vision that he seeth is for many days to come, and he prophesieth of the times that are far off.

Eze 12:28 Therefore say unto them, Thus saith the LORD GOD; There shall none of my words be prolonged any more, but the word which I have spoken shall be done, saith the LORD GOD.

Eze 13 False Prophets to be punished

Eze 13:3 Thus saith the LORD GOD; Woe unto the foolish prophets, that follow their own spirit and have seen nothing.

Ezekiel cont. 4

Eze 14 Setting up Idols in your heart.

Eze 14:6 Therefore say unto the house of Israel, Thus saith the LORD GOD; REPENT, and turn yourselves from your idols; and turn away your faces from all your abominations.

Eze 14:14 Though these three men, Noah, Daniel, and Job were in it, they should deliver but their own souls by their righteousness, saith the LORD GOD.

Eze 14:12-22 Jerusalem not to be spared even if Noah, Daniel, and Job were there. They would be able only to save themselves, not even their sons and daughters.

Eze 15 The vision of the burning vine, as Jerusalem is to be.

Eze 15:8 And I will make the land desolate, because they have committed a trespass, saith the LORD GOD.

Eze 16:3 Abraham an Amorite, and Sarah a Hittite and the land of Canaan.

Eze 16 A parable in which Israel is portrayed as an abandoned infant who is saved and treated royally. Only to forget the kindness and become an herlot.

Eze 17 The parable of the Great Eagle

Eze 17:11-21 The rebellion of Zedekiah is like the parable of the Eagle.

Eze 17:22-24 A direct promise of the Messiah

Ezekiel cont. 5

Eze 22:22 As silver is melted in the midst of the furnace, so shall ye be melted in the midst thereof; and ye shall know that I the LORD have poured out my fury upon you.

Eze 23 The Parable of Aholah and Aholibah, in which the sins of Israel and Judah are told.

Eze 24 The Parable of the boiling pot, which represented Jerusalem besieged by the Chaldeans.

Eze 24:15-18 The death of Ezekiel's wife, a sign to the people.

Eze 25 Judgments upon the Gentile nations: Ammon, Moab, Edom, Philistia.

Eze 26 The coming judgement upon Tyre.

Eze 26:7 For thus saith the LORD GOD: Behold, I will bring upon Tyrus, Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, a king of kings, from the north, with horses, and with chariots, and with horsemen, and companies, and much people.

Eze 27 The Glory, Fall, and Ruin of Tyre.

Eze 28:1-19 The sentence of the king of Tyre

Eze 28:20-23 The fall of Sidon.

Eze 29 The Prophecy against Egypt.

Eze 30 Those countries helping Egypt also to be destroyed: Ethiopia, Libya, Lydia, etc.

Eze 31 Parable of the Cedar of Lebanon: the Fall of Pharaoh.

Eze 32 17-32 Description of those gone to hell.

Eze 33 Ezekiel - a Watchman to warn Israel

Ezekiel cont. 5

Eze 18 Each person is judged by the LORD for his/her own actions, not someone else.

Eze 18:4 Behold, all souls are MINE; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the soul that sinneth, it shall die.

Eze 18:5-9 He that followeth the LORD's statutes, shall surely live.

Eze 18:30 Therefore I will judge you, O house of Israel, every one according to his ways, saith the LORD GOD. Repent, and turn yourselves from all your transgressions; so iniquity shall not be your ruin.

Eze 18:31-32 Those who repent shall receive a new heart and a new spirit.

Eze 19 Lamentations for the Princes of Israel. A parable of Lions describing the cruelty and oppressiveness of Jehoa-haz and Jehoiadim.

Eze 20 The Rebellious nature of Israel.

Eze 20:33-44 GOD will establish Israel in her land, when HE regathers HIS people in the end times.

Eze 20:45-49 The parable of the South Field.

Eze 21 The sword of the LORD to be against Israel.

Eze 21:18-24 Ezekiel foresees the coming of Nebuchadnezzar to overthrow Israel and the Ammonites.

Eze 21:26-27 No Davidic King in Israel until Messiah comes.

Eze 22 The sins of Israel are listed.

Ezekiel cont. 6

Eze 22:22 As silver is melted in the midst of the furnace, so shall ye be melted in the midst thereof; and ye shall know that I the LORD have poured out my fury upon you.

Eze 23 The Parable of Aholah and Aholibah, in which the sins of Israel and Judah are told.

Ezekiel cont. 7

Eze 33:7 So thou, O Son of Man, I have set thee a watchman unto the house of Israel; therefore thou shalt hear the word at MY mouth, and warn them from ME.

Eze 33:21 Jan 5th Ezekiel is no more dumb, and can speak again, after the news of the fall of Jerusalem.

Eze 33:23-32 Hearers, but not doers of the Word.

Eze 33:32 And, lo, thou art unto them as a very lovely song of one that hath a pleasant voice, and can play well on an instrument: for they hear thy words, but they do them not.

Eze 34:1-10 The word of the LORD against the rulers or shepherds of Israel, and their failure to care for HIS people.

Eze 34:20-31 CHRIST to be the SHEPHERD of the LORD's people.

Eze 34:23 And I will set up one shepherd over them, and HE shall feed them, even my servant David, HE shall feed them, and HE shall be their shepherd.

Eze 34:24 And I the LORD will be their GOD, and my servant David a prince among them; I the LORD have spoken it.

Eze 34:25-31 The FINAL COVENANT with Israel.

Eze 34:31 And ye MY flock, the flock of MY pasture, are men, and I AM your God, saith the LORD GOD!

Eze 35 The prophecy against mount Seir-Edom

Eze 36 Prophecy of the future restoration of Israel and the New Covenant.

[Ezekiel] cont. 8

Eze 36:26 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you; and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you a heart of flesh.

Eze 36:27 And I will put my SPiRiT within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my ~~statutes~~ judgements, and do them.

Eze 36:28 And ye shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers; and ye shall be MY people, and I will be your GOD.

Eze 37 Vision of Valley of Dry Bones

Eze 37:1 The hand of the LORD was upon me, and carried me out in the SPiRiT of the LORD, and set me down in the midst of the valley which was full of bones,

Eze 37:2 And caused me to pass by them round about: and, behold, there were very many in the open valley; and, lo, they were very dry.

Eze 37:11-14 GOD restores dried bones to life.

Eze 37:15-23 Sign of the two sticks. Judah and Israel to be restored to one nation.

Eze 37:24-28 They all shall have ONE SHEPHERD, JESUS CHRIST.

Eze 38 Description of Gog, Magog, Russia against Israel

Eze 39 Prophecy against Gog, the Northern Invaders who GOD will destroy and their graves shall be east of the sea.

[Ezekiel] cont. 10 The River of CHRIST

Eze 47:9 And it shall come to pass, that every thing that liveth, which moveth, whither soever the rivers shall come shall live: and there shall be a very great multitude of fish, because these waters shall come thither: for they shall be healed; and every thing shall live whither the river cometh.

Eze 48 The land during the Millennial Age is divided among the tribes.

Eze 48:30-35 The Temple City

Eze 48:35 It was round about eighteen thousand measures: and the name of the city from that day shall be: The LORD is there!

[Ezekiel] cont. 9

Eze 40 Vision of the man with the measuring reed who measures the temple that is to be. (Millennial Temple)

Eze 40:3 And he brought me thither, and, behold, there was a man, whose appearance was like the appearance of brass, with a line of flax in his hand, and a measuring reed; and he stood in the gate.

Eze 40:5-49 The Temple is measured.

Eze 41 Description of the Temple

Eze 41:4 The Most HOLY Place - HOLY of HOLIES

Eze 42 The Temple is 500 Reeds x 500 Reeds, or approx. 1 mile x 1 mile!

Eze 43 GLORY of the LORD returns to the Temple

Eze 43:2 And, behold, the GLORY of the LORD GOD of Israel came from the way of the East and HIS voice was like a noise of many waters; and the earth shined with HIS GLORY.

Eze 43:3 The vision is the same as the earlier one, by the River Chebar.

Eze 44 Gate for the Prince to eat bread before the LORD.

Eze 45 The LORD's portion of the land, 25,000 reeds by 10,000 reeds.

Eze 46 The Prince to worship first, then HIS is to ~~be~~ lead the people in worship.

Eze 47 The vision of flowing waters out the East Gate of the LORD.

Eze 47:2-12 The River of Life flows through GOD's gate
