Micah 1 Micah was raised up to support Isaiah, and to confirm his predictions.

Micah 1: 6-16 The Assyrian invasion is predicted

Micah 2: 1-5 Woe to the people that devise evil during the night, and rise early to carry it into execution!

Micah 2: 12 I will surely assemble, O Jacob, all of thee; I will surely gather the remnant of Israel;...

Micah 3: 1-8 The cruelty of the princes, and the falsehood of the prophets.

Micah 4: 1-8 The future kingdom of Messiah.

Micah 4: 11-13 Prediction of the Battle of Armageddon. (Rev. 16:14, 19:17, note, Rev 16:16)

Micah 5 Prediction of the Birth and Rejection of the Messiah. "Prince of Bethlehem"

Micah 5: 2 But thou, Bethlehem Ephrathah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall HE come south unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; ~~whom~~ whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting.

Micah 5: 7-15 The triumphs of Israel.

Micah 5: 15 And I will execute vengeance in anger and fury upon the heathen, such as they have not heard.

Micah 6 GOD's controversy with Israel

Micah cont.

Micah 6: 2 Hear ye, O mountains, the LORD's controversy, and ye strong foundations of the earth: for the LORD hath a controversy with HIS people, and HE will plead with Israel.

Micah 6: 9-16 The wickedness of Israel.

Micah 7: 1-7 Micah bemoans himself for living among a people headed for destruction.

Micah 7: 1 Woe is me! ...

Micah 7: 6 ... a man's enemies are the men of his own house
