Mk 1:1 The beginning of the gospel of JESUS CHRIST, the SON of GOD.

→ Mark - A Gospel of Deeds, Works of CHRIST

Mk 1:1-8 The Ministry of John the Baptist.

Mk 1:9-11 The Baptism of JESUS.

Mk 1:12-13 The temptation of JESUS.

Mk 1:14-15 The First Ministry in Galilee.

⇒ Mk 1:16-20 The Call of Peter and Andrew and James and John.

Mk 1:21-28 JESUS casts out demons in Capernaum.

Mk 1:29-31 JESUS heals Peter's wife's Mother.

Mk 1:32-45 JESUS heals many and casts out devons.

Mk 2:1-12 The palsied man is healed.

⇒ Mk 2:13-17 The call of Matthew.

Mk 2:18-22 Why CHRIST's disciples did not fast.

Mk 2:23-28 JESUS justifies HIS disciples for plucking corn on the sabbath.

Mk 2:10 But that ye may know that the SON of Man hath power on earth to forgive sins;

Mk 2:11 I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy bed, and go thy way unto thine house.

Mk 4:13-20 The Parable of the Sower is explained to the Disciples.

Mk 4:21-25 Parable of the Candle.

⇒ Mk 4:30-34 Parable of the Mustard Seed.

Mk 4:31 It is like a grain of Mustard Seed, which, when it is sown in the earth, is less than all the seeds that be in the earth:

Mk 4:32 But when it is sown, it groweth up, and becometh greater than all herbs and shooteth out great branches; so that the fowls of the air may lodge under the shadow of it.

Mk 4:35-41 JESUS stills the Storm.

⇒ Mk 5:1-20 JESUS casts out Legion of devons into the swine which perish into the sea.

Mk 5:8 For HE said unto him, Come out of the man, thou unclean spirit.

⇒ Mk 5:9 And HE asked him, What is thy name? And he answered, saying, My name is Legion; for we are many.

Mk 5:25-34 JESUS heals the woman with an issue of blood.

Mk 5:30 And JESUS immediately knowing within himself that virtue had gone out of HIM, tare him about in the press, and said, Who tou who MY clothes?

Mk 5:34 And HE said unto her, Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole, go in peace, and be whole of thy plague.

Mark cont.

Mk 2:17... They that are whole have no need of the physician, but they that are sick: I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.

Mk 2:21-22 Parable of the cloth and bottles.

Mk 2:21 And HE said unto them, The Sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath:

⇒ Mk 2:28 Therefore the SON of Man is LORD also of the Sabbath.

Mk 3:1-5 JESUS heals the withered hand on the Sabbath.

⇒ Mk 3:6-12 The multitudes healed.

⇒ Mk 3:13-21 The Twelve Apostles Chosen.

Mk 3:22-30 The unforgiveable sin.

Mk 3:29 But he that shall blaspheme against the HOLY GHOST hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of total damnation.

Mk 3:35 For whosoever shall do the will of GOD, the same is MY Brother, and MY Sister, and Mother.

Mk 4:1-12 Parable of the Sower.

Mk 4:9 And HE said unto them, HE that have ears to hear, let him hear.

⇒ Mk 4:11 Unto you it is given to know the Mystery of the kingdom of GOD; but unto them that are without, all these things are done in parables.

* Mk 5:35-43 JESUS raises the daughter of Jairus from the dead.

Mk 5:39 And when HE was come in, HE saith unto them, Why make ye this ado, and weep? the damsel is not dead, but sleepeth.

Mk 5:40 And they laughed him to scorn.

Mk 5:41 And HE took the damsel by the hand, and said unto her, Talitha cumi, which is, being interpreted, Damsel, I say unto thee, arise.

Mk 5:42 And straightway, the damsel arose, and walked, for she was of the age of twelve years. And they were astonished with a great astonishment.

Mk 6:1-6 JESUS despised in HIS own country.

⇒ Mk 6:4 But JESUS said unto them, A Prophet is not without honour, but in HIS own country, and among HIS own kin, and in HIS own house.

Mk 6:7-13 The Twelve sent out to preach and to heal.

Mk 6:14-29 John the Baptist is killed by Herod.

Mk 6:32-44 The Five Thousand fed.

Mk 6:45-52 JESUS walks on the Sea.

⇒ Mk 6:50 Be of good cheer: it is I; be not afraid.

Mk 6:53-56 JESUS heals the sick.

⇒ Mk 7:1-13 JESUS rebukes the Pharisees for following rules of men and not obeying GOD's commandments.
