

Mark cont. 8

Mk 9:46-52 Blind Bartimaeus receives his sight.

Mk 10:52 And JESUS said unto him, Go thy way, thy Faith hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed JESUS in the way.

Mk 11:1-11 JESUS enters Jerusalem riding a donkey colt as King David did, signifying HIS presentation as KING.

Mk 11:12-14 The barren fig tree cursed

Mk 11:15-21 JESUS purifies the Temple

Mk 11:17 And HE taught saying unto them, Is it not written, MY House shall be called of all nations the House of Prayer? but ye have made it a den of thieves.

Mk 11:22-26 Prayer of FAITH.

Mk 11:24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

Mk 11:25 And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your FATHER also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.

Mk 11:26 But if ye do not forgive, neither will your FATHER which is in heaven forgive your trespasses!

Mark cont. 10

Mk 12:35-40 JESUS questions the Pharisees concerning CHRIST as the son of David.

Mk 12:41-44 The Widow's Mite

Mk 12:43 And HE called unto HIM his disciples, and said unto them, Verily I say unto you, that this poor widow hath cast more in, than all they which have cast into the treasury:

Mk 12:44 For all they did cast in of their abundance, but she of her want did cast in all that she had, even all her living.

Mk 13 Signs of the End of the World, the Second Coming of CHRIST, Second Advent

Mk 13:1-4 The Destruction of the Temple foretold

Mk 13:2 And JESUS said unto him, Seest thou these great buildings? there shall not be left one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down.

Mk 13:5-13 Many signs before the Return of CHRIST

Mk 13:10 And the Gospel must first be published among all nations.

Mk 13:14-23 The Great Tribulation

Mk 13:24 But in those days after that Tribulation, the sun shall be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light.

Mark cont. 9

Mk 11:27-33 JESUS silences those who question HIS authority.

Mk 11:33 ... Neither do I tell you by what authority I do these things.

Mk 12:1-12 Parable of the Vineyard & wicked husbandmen

Mk 12:13-17 Parable of Caesar's Tribute

Mk 12:17 And JESUS answering said unto them, Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to GOD the things that are GOD's. And they marvelled at HIM.

Mk 12:18-27 The Sadducees attempt to trick JESUS concerning the Resurrection

Mk 12:27 HE is not the GOD of the dead, but the GOD of the Living: ye therefore do greatly err.

Mk 12:28-34 THE GREAT COMMANDMENTS

Mk 12:29 And JESUS answered him, The First of all the commandments is: Hear, O Israel; The LORD our GOD is one LORD:

Mk 12:30 And thou shalt love the LORD thy GOD with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the First Commandment.

Mk 12:31 And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.

Mark cont. 11

Mk 13:25 And the stars of Heaven shall fall, and the powers that are in Heaven shall be shaken.

Mk 13:26 And then shall they see the Son of Man coming in the clouds with great power and glory.

Mk 13:27 And then shall HE send HIS angels, and shall gather together his elect from the four winds from the uttermost part of the earth to the uttermost part of Heaven.

Mk 13:28-33 Parable of the Fig Tree: As the Fig Tree predicts the coming of Summer, so both the passing of signs indicate the Coming of CHRIST.

Mk 13:29 So ye in like manner, when ye shall see these things come to pass, know that it is nigh, even at the doors.

Mk 13:32 But of that day and that hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels, which are in heaven, neither the SON, but the FATHER.

Mk 13:33 Take ye heed, watch and pray: for ye know not when the time is.

Mk 13:34-37 Watch Always lest HE find you sleeping
