

## [John] cont. 16

Jon 17: 2 Note: CHRIST'S Gifts  
 to those whom the FATHER gave HIM:  
 \* Eternal Life, the FATHER'S Name,  
 \* the FATHER'S Words, HIS own joy,  
 \* HIS Own Glory.

† Jon 18 JESUS in the Garden of Gethsemane  
HE is betrayed and appears before  
 the High Priest and Pilate.

⇒ Jon 18: 1-11 The BETRAYAL

† Jon 18: 10 Then Simon Peter, having  
 a sword drew it and smote the high  
 priest's servant, and cut off his right ear.  
 The servant's name was Malchus.

† Jon 18: 11 Then said JESUS unto Peter, Put  
 up thy sword unto the sheath: the cup  
 which MY FATHER hath given ME, shall  
 I not drink it?

† Jon 18: 15 And Simon Peter followed JESUS,  
 and so did another Disciple: that Disciple  
 was known unto the High Priest, and  
 went in with JESUS into the palace  
 of the High Priest, ⊕ JOHN

⇒ Jon 18: 15-27 Peter's Three Denials

## [John] cont. 18

† Jon 19: 26 When JESUS therefore  
 saw HIS Mother, and the Disciple  
 standing by, whom HE loved, ⊕ JOHN  
HE saith unto HIS Mother,  
 "Woman, behold thy son!"

⇒ Jon 19: 27 Then saith HE unto  
 the Disciple, "Behold thy mother!"

† Jon 19: 31-37 Not a bone of HIM broken  
⊕ Psalms 34: 20

† Jon 19: 37 ... They shall look on HIM  
 whom they pierced. → Zechariah 12: 10

† Jon 19: 38-42 JESUS is Entombed - Buried

†† Jon 20 The Resurrection of JESUS CHRIST

† Jon 20: 1 The First Day of the week  
 cometh Mary Magdalene early, when it was  
 yet dark, unto the sepulchre, and seeth  
 the stone taken away from the sepulchre.

† Jon 20: 2 Mary Magdalene tells Peter and  
John that JESUS is missing.

† Jon 20: 3-10 Peter and John go to the tomb.

† Jon 20: 4 So they ran both together:  
⊕ John and the other Disciple did outrun Peter,  
 and came first to the sepulchre.

## [John] cont. 17

Jon 18: 26 3rd Person to ask Peter  
 was related to servant whose ear was cut.

⇒ Jon 18: 27 Peter then denied again:  
 and immediately the cock crew.

Jon 18: 28-40 JESUS before Pilate.

† Jon 18: 36-37 ... MY Kingdom is not of  
 this world ... Thou sayest that I AM  
 a king. To this end was I born, and  
 for this cause came I into the world,  
 that I should bear witness unto the TRUTH.  
 Every one that is of the TRUTH  
 heareth MY VOICE.

†† Jon 18: 38 ... I find in HIM  
 no fault at all.

\*\*\* Jon 19 CHRIST is Condemned & Crucified

Jon 19: 1-3 JESUS is crowned with thorns

Jon 19: 4-13 Pilate brings JESUS  
 before the multitude.

Jon 19: 16-30 The crucifixion of  
JESUS CHRIST.

## [John] cont. 19

Jon 20: 11-13 Mary Magdalene sees  
2 Angels inside the tomb.

Jon 20: 14-16 JESUS appears to Mary Magdalene

Jon 20: 15 ... Woman, why weepest thou?  
 whom seekest thou?

† Jon 20: 16 JESUS saith unto her, Mary.  
 she turned herself, and saith unto HIM,  
Rabboni; which is to say Master.

† Jon 20: 17 ... Touch ME not, for I AM  
 not yet ascended to MY FATHER ...

⇒ Jon 20: 19-23 JESUS appears to the  
Disciples, Thomas being absent.

†† Jon 20: 21 ... Peace be unto you,  
 as MY FATHER hath sent ME, even so  
 send I you.

† Jon 20: 22 ... HE breathed on them,  
Receive ye the HOLY GHOST:

† Jon 20: 23 Whosoever sins ye remit,  
 they are remitted unto them, and  
 whosoever sins ye retain,  
 they are retained.

⇒ Jon 20: 24-29 JESUS appears with Thomas present
