

[Luke] cont. 8

Lk 10:17-24 The Seventy return

Lk 10:21 In that hour JESUS rejoiced in SPIRIT, and said, I thank THEE O FATHER, LORD of Heaven and Earth, that thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto Rabes: even so FATHER; for so it seemed good in thy sight.

Lk 10:22 All things are delivered to ME of MY FATHER: and no man knoweth who the SON is, but the FATHER; and who the FATHER is, but the SON, and HE to whom the SON will reveal HIM.

Lk 10:23-24 JESUS tells HIS disciples of the importance of the things they have seen.

Lk 10:25-28 The TWO Great COMMANDMENTS

Lk 10:27... Thou shalt love the LORD thy GOD with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; And Thy Neighbor as thy self.

Lk 10:30-37 The Good Samaritan

Lk 10:38-42 Martha and Mary: Pay Attention to The IMPORTANT Things

[Luke] cont. 10

Lk 11:20 But if I with the finger of GOD cast out devils, no doubt the Kingdom of GOD is come upon you.

Lk 11:23 He that is Not with ME is against ME; and he that gathereth not with ME scattereth.

Lk 11:28 But HE said, Yea rather, Blessed are they that hear the word of GOD, and keep it.

Lk 11:29-32 The sign of Jonas (Jonah)

Lk 11:30 For as Jonas was a sign unto the Ninevites, so shall the SON of man be to this generation.

Lk 11:33-36 The Light and Darkness of Man

Lk 11:35 Take heed therefore that the light which is in thee be not Darkness!

Lk 11:39-44 JESUS denounces hypocrisy.

Lk 11:44 Woe unto you, scribes & Pharisees, hypocrites! ...

Lk 11:45-54 JESUS denounces lawyers, but means legalists, rather than by GRACE

Lk 11:46 And HE said Woe unto you also, ye lawyers! for ye lade men with burdens grievous to be borne, and ye yourselves do not.

[Luke] cont. 9

Lk 10:41 And JESUS answered and said unto her, Martha, Martha, thou art careful and troubled about many things:

Lk 10:42 But one thing is needful: and Mary hath chosen that good part, which shall not be taken away from her.

Prayer is a Relationship with GOD.

Lk 11:2-4 The LORD's Prayer.

Lk 11:9 And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you.

Lk 11:10 For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

Lk 11:13 Note: Mary of Bethany - HOLY SPIRIT

Lk 11:13 Is ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly FATHER give the HOLY SPIRIT to them that ask HIM?

Lk 11:14-23 JESUS declares Satan the Enemy

Lk 11:17... Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation - and a house divided against a house shall fall.

[Luke] cont. 11

Lk 11:52 Woe unto you lawyers! for you have taken away the key of knowledge: ye entered not in yourselves, and them that were entering in ye hindered.

Lk 12:1-12 JESUS warns of the doctrine (leaven) of the Pharisees

Lk 12:1... Beware ye of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy

Lk 12:2 For there is nothing covered that shall not be revealed; neither hid that shall not be known.

Lk 12:4-12 Fear not the attacks of men or the devil, but choose the LORD thy GOD.

Lk 12:7 But even the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Fear not therefore: ye are of more value than many sparrows

Lk 12:8 Also I say unto you, Whosoever shall confess ME before men, him shall the SON of Man also confess before the Angels of GOD:

Lk 12:9 But he that denieth ME before men shall be denied before the Angels of GOD

Lk 12:10-12 When men shall be against thee, do not worry about what to say:

Lk 12:12 For the HOLY GHOST shall teach you in the same hour what to say
