Lk 12:16-34 Parable of the Rich Fool

Lk 12:30 Fear not for the needs of this world, but seek ye the Treasures of Heaven.

Lk 12:31 But rather seek ye the kingdom of God, and all these things shall be added to you.

Lk 12:34 For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.

Lk 12:35-40 Warnings concerning the Second Coming of CHRIST.

Lk 12:40 Be ye therefore ready also: for the SON of Man cometh at an hour when ye think not.

Lk 12:42-48 Parable of the Steward and his servants

Lk 12:48 ... For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required ...

Lk 12:49-59 CHRIST a divider of men in Spiritual Matters

Lk 12:51 Suppose ye that I AM come to give peace on earth? I tell you, Nay; but rather division:

Lk 12:52 For from henceforth there shall be five in one house divided, three against two, and two against three.

Lk 12:54-59 Men cannot see the Obvious about their Fate

Luke cont. 14

Lk 14:25-35 JESUS gives examples of Difficulty in Discipleship

Lk 14:27 And whosoever doth not bear his cross and comes after me, cannot be MY disciple

1. Building the Tower
2. The King contemplating War.
3. The Salt without Seavour.

Lk 15 Lost and Found - Three Parables of something Lost and the Joy when it is Found

Lk 15:3-7 The Lost Sheep

Lk 15:8-10 The Lost Coin

Lk 15:11-32 The Lost Son - Prodigal Son

Lk 15:31 And he said unto him, Son, thou art ever with me, and all that I have is thine.

Lk 15:32 It was meet that we should make merry, and be glad: for this thy brother was dead, and is alive again; and was lost, and is found.

Lk 16:1-13 Parable of Unjust Servant - Two Masters

Lk 16:10 He that is faithful in that which is least is faithful also in much: and he that is unjust in the least is unjust also in much.

Lk 16:13 No servant can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve GOD and mammon.

Luke cont. 13

Lk 13:1-5 Men must not judge, but repent.

Lk 13:5 I tell you Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish.

→ Lk 13:6-9 Parable of Sycamore: judgment delayed

Lk 13:10-17 A woman is healed on the Sabbath

CHRIST lists Bonds
Lk 13:16 And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan hath bound 10, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day?

Lk 13:18-21 Unto what is the Kingdom of GOD like? and whereunto shall I compare it?

→ Lk 13:19 It is like a Grain of Mustard Seed, which a man took, and cast into his garden; and it grew, and waxed a great tree; and the fowls of the air lodged in the branches.

Lk 13:22-33 Teachings on the way to Jerusalem.

Lk 13:34-35 JESUS laments over Jerusalem.

Lk 14:1-6 CHRIST heals a man on the Sabbath

Lk 14:7-14 JESUS teaches humility

→ Lk 14:11 For whosoever exalteth himself shall be abased: and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.

Lk 14:15-24 Parable of the Great Supper

We make Many Excuses for Not Accepting the LORD'S INVITATION

Luke cont. 15

Lk 16:16 The law and the prophets were until John: since that time the Kingdom of GOD is preached, and every man presseth into it.

Lk 16:18 Who soever putteth away his wife, and marrieth another, committeth adultery: and whosoever marrieth her that is putt away from her husband committeth adultery.

Lk 16:19-31 The Rich Man and Lazarus

→ Lk 16:23 Scoville note: description of hades

Lk 16:23-31 The Rich Man, from Hell pleads with Father Abraham and is rejected, while Lazarus is in Heaven.

→ Lk 16:31 And HE said unto him, If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though ONE rose from the dead.

Lk 17:11-19 10 Lepers healed - only One thanked GOD

→ When we are healed by the Grace of the LORD, we should bow down in thanks to HIM

Lk 17:17 And JESUS answering said, Were there not ten cleansed? But where are the nine?

→ Lk 17:22-37 SECOND Coming of CHRIST
