

Luke cont. 16

Lk 17:26-27 JESUS reminds us of the Days of Noe (Noah) and how most perished

Lk 17:28-29 HE also reminded us of Lot in Sodom and Lot's wife.

Lk 17:30 Even thus shall it be in the Day when the SON of Man is revealed

Lk 17:21 ... for, Behold, the Kingdom of GOD is within you!

Lk 18:1-8 Power of Persistent Prayer

Lk 18:9-44 Parable of Self-Righteous

Lk 18:25 For it is easier for a camel to go through a needle's eye, than for a rich man to enter into the Kingdom of GOD.

Lk 18:27 And HE said, The things which are impossible with men are possible with GOD.

Lk 18:17 Verily I say unto you, Whosoever shall not receive the Kingdom of GOD as a little child shall in nowise enter therein.

Lk 18:31-34 JESUS' prediction of death & resurrection

Lk 18:35-43 A Blind Man healed near Jericho

Lk 19:1-10 Conversion of Zaccheus

Lk 19:9 A JESUS said unto him, This day is salvation come to this house, forasmuch as he also is a son of Abraham.

Lk 19:10 For the SON of Man is come to seek and to save that which was lost

Luke cont. 18

Lk 20:3 And HE answered and said unto them, I will also ask you one thing; and answer ME:

Lk 20:4 The Baptism of John, was it from heaven, or of men?

Lk 20:8 And JESUS said unto them, Neither tell I by what authority I do these things.

Lk 20:9-18 Parable of evil husbandman and the Vineyard → killed his son.

Lk 20:25 Render therefore unto Caesar the things which are his, and unto GOD the things which be GOD's.

Lk 20:27-38 JESUS tells of the RESURRECTION

Lk 20:38 For HE is not a GOD of the dead, but of the living: for all live unto HIM.

Lk 20:39-47 JESUS questions and denounces the scribes

→ Lk 21:1-4 Widow's Mite

Lk 21:3 And HE said of a truth I say unto you, that this poor widow hath cast in more than they all:

Lk 21:4 For all these have of their abundance cast in unto the offerings of GOD: but she of her penury hath cast in all the living that she had.

Luke cont. 17

Lk 19:11-27 Parable of 10 pounds - wicked servant

Lk 19:26 For I say unto you, That unto every one which hath shall be given; and from him that hath not even that he has shall be taken away from him.

Lk 19:27 But those mine enemies, which would not that I should reign over them, bring hither, and slay them before ME.

Lk 19:28-40 JESUS enters Jerusalem

Lk 19:38... Blessed be the KING that cometh in the name of the LORD: peace in Heaven, and Glory in the Highest.

Lk 19:40 And HE answered and said unto them, I tell you that, if these should hold their peace, the stones would immediately cry out.

Lk 19:41-44 CHRIST weeps over Jerusalem

Lk 19:44 ... and they shall not leave in thee one stone upon another...

Lk 19:45 And HE went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold therein, and them that bought;

Lk 19:46 saying unto them, It is written, MY House is the House of Prayer: but ye have made it a den of thieves.

Lk 20:1-8 The priests and scribes question JESUS' authority

Luke cont. 19

→ Lk 21:5-38 The Olivet Discourse - JESUS speaks of many things at the Mount of Olives

Lk 21:6 As for these things which ye behold, the days will come, in the which there shall not be left one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down.

Lk 21:8-19 JESUS tells the Signs of the End Times

Lk 21:11 And great earthquakes shall be in diverse places and famines, and pestilences; and fearful sights and great signs shall there be from heaven.

Lk 21:12-19 Suffering of Apostles and Believers

Lk 21:17 And ye shall be hated of all men for MY Name sake.

Lk 21:18 But there shall not an hair of your head perish.

Lk 21:19 In your patience possess ye your souls

Lk 21:20-24 Destruction of Jerusalem foretold

Lk 21:25-28 Return of the LORD, 2nd Advent

Lk 21:27 And then shall they see the SON of Man coming in a cloud with power and Great Glory.

Lk 21:28 And when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh.

Lk 21:29-33 Parable of the Fig Tree
