21:33 Heaven and Earth shall pass away:  
but MY WORDS shall not pass away.

Lk 21:34-38 Watchfulness in view of the LORD's return

Lk 21:35 For a snare shall it come on all them that dwell on the face of the whole Earth

Lk 21:36 Watch ye therefore, and pray always,  
that ye may be accounted worthy to escape  
all these things that shall come to pass,  
and to stand before the SON of MAN

Lk 22:3 Then entered Satan into Judas  
surnamed Iscairiot, being of the number of the Twelve

Lk 22:8 And HE sent Peter and John saying,  
Go and prepare us the Passover, that we may eat.

Lk 22:14-18 The Last Passover

Lk 22:19-20 The LORD's Supper

Lk 22:19... This is MY Body which  
is Given for You: This do in Remembrance of ME

Lk 22:20... This cup is the  
New Testament in MY Blood, which  
is Shed for You.

Lk 22:31-32... Simon, Simon, behold, Satan  
hath desired to hate you, that he may  
sift you as wheat:

Lk 22:32 But I have prayed for thee,  
that thy faith fail not: and when thou  
art converted, strengthen thy brethren

Lk 22:34... I tell thee, Peter, the cock  
shall not crow this day, before that thou  
shalt thrice deny that thou knowest ME

Lk 22:39-46 JESUS' Agony in the Garden

Lk 22:42... FATHER, if THOU be willing,  
remove this cup from ME: nevertheless  
not MY will, but THINE be done.

Lk 22:43-46 An angel from Heaven appeared  
unto HIM to strengthen HIM.

Lk 22:47-53 JESUS betrayed by Judas

Lk 22:54-62 Peter denies the LORD  
Three Times.

Lk 22:69 Hereafter shall the SON of Man  
sit on the Right Hand of the Power of GOD.

Lk 23:1-5 CHRIST before Pilate

Lk 23:4 Then said Pilate to the chief priests  
and to the people, I find No Fault in this MAN

## Luke cont. 22

Lk 23:6-12 JESUS before Herod

Lk 23:12 And the same day Pilate and Herod  
were made friends together: for before they  
were at enmity between them selves.

Lk 23:13-26 JESUS again before Pilate:  
Barabbas released, JESUS condemned.

Lk 23:14... behold, I, having examined HIM before  
you, have found no fault in this Man...

Lk 23:15 No, nor yet Herod: for I sent you  
to him: and, lo, nothing worthy of death is  
done unto him.

Lk 23:21 But they cried, saying, Crucify HIM,  
crucify Him.

Lk 23:25 And he released unto them him that  
for sedition and murder was cast into prison  
... but he delivered JESUS to their will.

Lk 23:26-32 Simon, a Cyrenian, on him they  
laid the cross, that he might bear it  
after JESUS.

Lk 23:32 And there were also two other  
malefactors, led with HIM to be put  
to death.

Lk 23:33 And when they were come to the place  
which is called Calvary, there they crucified HIM  
and the malefactors, one on the right hand,  
and the other on the left.

## Luke cont. 23

Lk 23:34 Then said JESUS, FATHER,  
Forgive them; for they know not what  
they do. And they parted his raiment  
and cast lots.

Lk 23:39-43 One of thieves Repents

Lk 23:42 And he said unto JESUS LORD,  
remember me when thou comest into  
THY Kingdom.

Lk 23:43 And JESUS said unto him  
Verily I say unto thee, To day shalt thou  
be with me in paradise.

Lk 23:44 And it was about the sixth hour;  
and there was a darkness over all the earth  
until the ninth hour.

Lk 23:45 And the sun was darkened, and  
the veil of the temple was rent in the midst.

Lk 23:46 And when JESUS had cried with  
a loud voice, HE said, FATHER; into  
THY Hands I commend MY SPIRIT:  
and having said thus, HE gave up  
the GHOST.

Lk 23:50-56 JESUS is Buried



Lk 24 The Resurrection and the Ascension

Lk 24:1 Now upon the first day of the week, very early in the morning, they came unto the sepulchre...

Lk 24:2 And they found the stone rolled away

Lk 24:3 And they entered in, and found not the body of the LORD JESUS.

Lk 24:4... behold, two men stood by them in shining garments:

Lk 24:5... they said unto them, Why seek ye the LIVING among the dead.

Lk 24:6 He is not here, but is Risen:

Lk 24:10 It was Mary Magdalene, and Joanna, and Mary the mother of James...

Lk 24:12 Peter goes to the Sepulchre to see for himself

Lk 24:13 JESUS appears to the Emmaus disciples and ministers to them.

Lk 24:34 The LORD is Risen indeed, and hath appeared unto Simon, see I Cor 15:5-8
