

The Acts cont. 8

Acts 10: 44-48 HOLY SPIRIT given to Gentile Believers.

Acts 10: 44 While Peter yet spake these words, the HOLY GHOST fell on all them which heard the WORD.

*** Acts 10: 47-48 Gentiles Baptized.

++ Acts 11 Peter vindicates his Ministry to Gentiles

Acts 11: 1-18 Peter defends his actions with the Gentiles in Caesarea.

Acts 11: 15 And as I began to speak, the HOLY GHOST fell on them, as on us at the beginning.

Acts 11: 16 Then remembered I the WORD of the LORD, how that HE said, John indeed baptized with water, but ye shall be baptized with the HOLY GHOST.

Acts 11: 17 Forasmuch then as GOD gave them the like gift as HE did unto us, who believed on the LORD JESUS CHRIST; what was I, that I could withstand GOD?

Acts 11: 18 When they heard these things, they held their peace...

Acts 13: 3-5 Saul's First Missionary Journey - to Cyprus

Saul (who is also Paul) filled with the HOLY GHOST set his eyes on him... and rebuked Paul. (he rebuked the devil).

Acts 13: 14-43 Paul's sermon at Antioch

Acts 13: 44-45 Paul's teaching rejected by the Jews.

Acts 13: 46-49 Paul and Barnabas turn to the Gentiles.

Acts 13: 47 For so hath the LORD commanded us, saying, I have set thee to be a light of the Gentiles, that thou shouldest be for salvation unto the ends of the earth.

⇒ Acts 13: 38-39 Justification by FAITH

Acts 14: 1-7 Paul and Barnabas at Iconium

Acts 14: 8-10 Paul heals crippled man.

Acts 14: 9 The same heard Paul speak: who steadfastly beholding him, and perceiving that he had faith to be healed.

Acts 14: 10 Said with a loud voice, Stand upright on thy feet. And he leaped and walked.

The Acts cont. 9

Acts 11: 18 ... they held their peace, and glorified GOD, saying, Then hath GOD also to the Gentiles granted Repentance unto Life.

⇒ Acts 11: 19-26 Stephen and Barnabas go to Antioch. Barabbas brings Saul from Tarsus unto Antioch.

Acts 11: 26 ... And the Disciples were called CHRISTIANS first in Antioch.

Acts 11: 27-29 Prophets from Jerusalem, including Agabus, go to Antioch. Barabbas and Saul return to Jerusalem.

Acts 12: 2 Herod ... And he killed James, the brother of John with the sword.

Acts 12: 3-4 Peter is imprisoned.

Acts 12: 3-11 Peter released from prison, by the Angel of the LORD.

Acts 12: 12-19 Peter goes to the house of Mary, mother of John Mark. Rhoda let him in.

⇒ Acts 12: 20-23 Herod killed by the Angel of the LORD.

++ Acts 13: 1-2 Saul and Barnabas called by the HOLY SPIRIT

The Acts cont. 11

Acts 14: 11-18 People attempt to worship Paul and Barnabas

Acts 14: 19 Paul stoned at Lystra

And there came thither certain Jews from Antioch and Iconium, who persuaded the people, and having stoned Paul, drew him out of the city, supposing he had been dead.

Acts 14: 20-28 The churches visited again.

++ Acts 15 Gentiles saved by FAITH, not the LAW. MAJOR

Acts 15: 7-11 ... Peter rose up, and said unto them ... why tempt ye GOD, to put a yoke upon the necks of the disciples, which neither our fathers nor we were able to bear?

Acts 15: 11 But we believe that through the GRACE of the LORD JESUS CHRIST we shall be saved, even as they.

Acts 15: 13-18 Divine Purpose: the taking out from among the Gentiles of a people for HIS name (see note)

Acts 15: 19-27 The Gentiles not under the Law, but under GRACE.

Acts 15: 28-25 Gentiles not give offence to Godly JEWS
