

The Acts cont. 12

Acts 15: 36-41 Paul chooses Silas, not Mark. Barrabas and John Mark go to Cyprus.

Acts 16: 1-5 Paul finds Timothy

Acts 16: 6... they... were forbidden of the HOLY GHOST to preach the Word in Asia.

Acts 16: 9 And a vision appeared unto Paul in the night, a vision of a man of Macedonia, saying, Come over into Macedonia and help us.

Acts 16: 12-13 Paul and Silas go to Philippi

Acts 16: 14-15 Lydia becomes First Christian in Europe.

Acts 16: 16-18 Paul casts out demon.

Acts 16: 19-24 Paul and Silas beaten and cast into prison.

Acts 16: 25-29 Earthquake from the LORD saves them.

Acts 16: 30-34 Only condition of SALVATION

Acts 16: 31 And they said, Believe on the LORD JESUS CHRIST and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.

The Acts cont. 14

Acts 18: 18 Paul takes a Jewish vow shaving his head at Cenchrea, having with him Priscilla and Aquila.

Acts 18: 19-21 Paul sails to Ephesus

Acts 18: 22-23 Paul travels to Caesarea, Antioch, Galatia, and Phrygia.

Acts 18: 24-28 Apollos at Ephesus, instructed by Aquila and Priscilla.

Acts 19 Paul at Ephesus: disciples of John the Baptist become CHRISTIANS and receive the HOLY SPIRIT.

Acts 19: 8-22 Paul teaches in Ephesus for nearly three years.

Acts 19: 23-41 Demetrius a silver smith who created idols in the name of Diana, causes an uproar among the people against Paul.

Acts 20: 6-12 Paul visits Troas (Troy)

Acts 20: 10-12 Paul brings Eutychus back to life.

Acts 20: 13-16 Paul goes to the ancient city of Miletas, (since 3,500 B.C.)

Acts 16: 35-40 Paul announces he is a ROMAN citizen.

Acts 17: 1-4 Founding of the Church at Thessalonica.

Acts 17: 5-14 Jewish opposition at Berea and Thessalonica.

Acts 17: 15-21 Paul at Athens

Acts 17: 22-34 Paul's Sermon at Mars' Hill

Acts 17: 23 For as I passed by, and beheld your devotions, I found an altar with this inscription, TO THE UNKNOWN GOD. Whom therefore ye ignorantly worship, HIM declare I unto you.

Acts 17: 34 Dionysius and Damaris become Believers

Acts 18 Founding of Church at Corinth

Acts 18: 9 Then spake the LORD to Paul in the night by a vision "Be not afraid, but speak, and hold not thy peace:"

Acts 18: 10 For I AM with thee, and no man shall set on thee to hurt thee: for I have much people in this city

Acts 20: 17-35 Paul bids Saremeil to the Elders of Ephesus

Acts 20: 35 ... the words of the LORD JESUS how HE said: "It is more blessed to give than to receive."

Acts 21 Paul goes to Jerusalem

Acts 21: 1-3 Paul travels to Tyre, on the way to Jerusalem.

Acts 21: 4-9 The HOLY SPIRIT forbids Paul to go to Jerusalem.

Acts 21: 10-11 Agabus - HOLY SPIRIT again warns Paul

Acts 21: 14-26 Paul at Jerusalem: He takes a Jewish vow involving a Jewish sacrifice

Acts 21: 27-32 Paul is seized in the Temple by the Jews.

Acts 21: 33-40 Paul bound with chains.

Acts 22 Paul tells of his conversion to the Jews at Jerusalem

Acts 22: 8 ... I AM JESUS of Nazareth, whom thou persecutest.

Acts 22: 21 And HE said unto me Depart: for I will send thee far hence unto the Gentiles.
