I Corinth. (cont.)

↓ Body of CHRIST

I COR 1:10 The greatest, smartest, strongest and fittest believer has precisely the same relationship in GRACE as the most ordinary saint.

I COR 12:13 Spiritual Gifts

I COR 12:12 For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is CHRIST.

I COR 2:9-14 Know ye how a TRUTH comes from the mind of GOD, to the mind of HIS people (see note) GOD talks to us

I COR 13 Ministry Gifts must be governed by LOVE.

I COR 3:11 For the foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is JESUS CHRIST

I COR 13:11 When I was a child, I spoke as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things.

I COR 3:16 Know ye not that ye are the temple of GOD, and that the SPIRIT of GOD dwelleth in you?

I COR 13:13 And now abideth faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is Charity. LOVE

I COR 3:19 For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with GOD

I COR 14 Prophecy is the greatest of the gifts, next unknown tongues

I COR 3:23 And ye are CHRIST'S, and CHRIST is GOD'S

I COR 15 The RESURRECTION

I COR 4:4 For I know nothing by myself; yet am I not hereby justified: but HE that judgeth me is the LORD

I COR 15:22 For as in Adam all die, even so in CHRIST shall all be made alive.

I COR 4:10 We are fools for CHRIST'S sake...

I COR 15:45 The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a quickening spirit

I COR 5:3-6 Presence of Satan's evil... Know ye not that a little leaven leaveneth the whole lump?

I COR 15:52 In a moment, in a twinkling of an eye, the dead shall be raised. (see note)

I COR 5:13 Therefore put away from among yourselves that wicked person.

I COR 6:19 Know ye not that your body is the temple of the HOLY GHOST, which is in you, which ye have of GOD, and ye are not your own?

I COR 6:20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify GOD in your body, and in your spirit, which are GOD'S.

I COR 7:2 Nevertheless, to avoid fornication, let every one of you have his own wife, as the church loveth her own body, as herself.

I COR 10:13 GOD is faithful, who will not suffer for you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.

I COR 10:16-17 Communion blood & CHRIST, body of CHRIST

I COR 10:21 Ye cannot drink the cup of the LORD, and the cup of devils (demons); ye cannot be partakers of the LORD'S table, and of the table of devils

I COR 10:31 Whether therefore ye eat or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the Glory of GOD.

I COR 11:24 Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you; this do, in remembrance of me.

11:25 This cup is the New Testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as you drink it, in remembrance of me.
