

## [Galatians]

## "Salvation by GRACE"

GAL 1 Paul chosen by JESUS and GOD to spread the Gospel.

GAL 1:6-9 Paul reminds the churches of Galatia that the True Gospel requires FAITH Only, not Works as imposed by men.

→ GAL 1:15-24 Paul had preached Grace years before he saw any of the other Apostles

GAL 2:15-21 Justification is by FAITH not Works or Law. Rom 3:28 note

GAL 2:16 knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the Law, but by the FAITH of JESUS CHRIST even we have believed in JESUS CHRIST that we might be justified by the FAITH of CHRIST, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

GAL 2:21 Mixing Law and Works with GRACE frustrates the GRACE of GOD!

\* GAL 3:1-5 The gift of the SPIRIT is by FAITH

→ GAL 3:6-9 The Abrahamic Covenant is a covenant of FAITH

→ GAL 3:24 wherefore the Law of Moses was our Schoolmaster to bring us unto CHRIST, that we might be Justified by FAITH.

+ GAL 3 notes Law vs. FAITH

## [Galatians] cont. 2

GAL 5:16 This I say then, Walk in the SPIRIT, and ye shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

GAL 5:18 But if ye be led of the SPIRIT, ye are not under the Law.

GAL 5:19-21 Works of the Flesh

+ GAL 5:22-24 Fruits of the SPIRIT.

+ GAL 5:25 If we live in the SPIRIT, let us also walk in the SPIRIT.

+ GAL 5:22 Note: 9 Graces, Fruits of the SPIRIT

→ GAL 6:7 Be not deceived: GOD is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

## cont.

GAL 3:25 But after that FAITH is come, we are no longer under a Schoolmaster.

GAL 3:26 By FAITH we are children of GOD, Not Servants of the Law

GAL 4:4-5 GOD sent forth HIS SON made of a woman, made under the Law, To redeem them under the Law, that we might receive the Adoption of sons.

GAL 4:6 And because ye are sons, GOD hath sent forth the SPIRIT of HIS SON into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father:

GAL 4:7 Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son, and if a son, then an heir of GOD through CHRIST.

→ GAL 4:8-18 Relying on "Legalism", or the Law of Moses, for Salvation, causes one to lose the Blessing of the LORD.

GAL 4:19-31 The 2 systems, Law and GRACE, cannot co-exist. Just as the 2 sons of Abraham, Isaac and Ishmael could not co-exist.

GAL 5:14 For all the Law is fulfilled in one Word: "Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself."
