

II Corinthians

B-4-17

2 COR 1:3 Blessed be GOD, even the FATHER of our LORD JESUS CHRIST, the FATHER of Mercies, and the GOD of all comfort;

2 COR 1:4 Who comforteth us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort them which are in any trouble, by the comfort wherewith we ourselves are consoled of GOD.

2 COR 2 Paul cautions believers to receive back those who have repented.

2 COR 2:7 So that contrariwise ye ought rather to forgive him, and comfort him, lest perchance such a one should be swallowed up with overmuch sorrow.

2 COR 2:11 Lest Satan should get an advantage of us; for we are not ignorant of his devices.

2 COR 2:14 Now thanks be unto GOD, which always causeth us to triumph in CHRIST.

2 COR 3 New covenant in CHRIST is superior to Old Covenant of Moses.

2 COR 3:3 For as much as ye are manifestly declared to be the Epistle of CHRIST ministered by us, written not with ink, but with the SPIRIT of the Living GOD; not in tables of stone, but in fleshly tables of the heart.

II Corinthians cont. 2

2 COR 5:21 For HE hath made HIM to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made righteousness of GOD in HIM.

⇒ 2 COR 5:18-19 Reconciliation with the LORD

2 COR 5:18 And all things are of GOD, who hath reconciled us to HIMSELF by JESUS CHRIST, and hath given us the ministry of reconciliation.

⇒ 2 COR 6:1 We then, as workers together with HIM beseech ye also that ye receive not the GRACE of GOD in vain.

2 COR 6:17 Separation (see note) come out from them and I will receive you.

And will be a FATHER unto you, and ye shall be MY sons and daughters, saith the LORD ALMIGHTY.

2 COR 7:6 Nevertheless GOD, that comforteth those that are cast down, comforted us.

2 COR 8 Christian Giving

2 COR 9:6... He which soweth sparingly, shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully.

II Corinthians cont.

2 COR 3:17 Now the LORD is that SPIRIT: and where the SPIRIT of the LORD is, there is Liberty.

2 COR 4:5 For we preach not ourselves, but CHRIST JESUS our LORD - and ourselves your servants for JESUS' sake.

2 COR 4:6 For GOD, who commanded the LIGHT to shine out of darkness hath shined in our hearts to give the LIGHT of the knowledge of the Glory of GOD in the face of JESUS CHRIST.

2 COR 4:14 Knowing that HE which raised up the LORD JESUS shall raise up us also by JESUS, and shall present us with you.

⇒ 2 COR 4:18 ...but things that are not seen are eternal.

2 COR 5:10 For we must all appear before the Judgement Seat of CHRIST... (for works not sins)

2 COR 5:17 Therefore if any man be in CHRIST, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

2 COR 5:20 Now then we are Ambassadors for CHRIST...

II Corinthians cont. 3

2 COR 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for GOD loveth a cheerful giver.

⇒ 2 COR 9:15 Thanks be unto GOD for HIS unspeakable gift!

⇒ 2 COR 10:17 But he that glorieth, let him glory in the LORD.

2 COR 11 Beware of False Teachers from Satan

2 COR 11:13 For such are False Apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of CHRIST

2 COR 11:14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.

2 COR 12:1-6 Paul's Visions and Revelations

⇒ 2 COR 12:7-10 Paul recognizes his need for Humility

2 COR 12:7 And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a THORN in the FLESH, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure.

2 COR 12:7 note "thorn in the flesh"
