

# Galatians

GAL 2:15-21 Justification is by FAITH, not works or law.

GAL 2:16 Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the FAITH of JESUS CHRIST, even we have believed in JESUS CHRIST, that we might be justified by the faith of CHRIST, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law, shall no flesh be justified.

GAL 2:21 To mingle law-works with GRACE is justification ~~frustrates GRACE~~

GAL 3:6-9 Abrahamic Covenant is by FAITH

GAL 3:24 The Law & more are our schoolmaster to bring us into CHRIST, that we may be justified by Faith

GAL 3 (note) Discussion of Law vs. FAITH

GAL 3:25 But after that FAITH is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster.

GAL 3:26-29 By faith we are the children of GOD, not servants of the Law.

GAL 4:4-5 GOD sent forth HIS SON, made of a woman, made under the law, to redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons.

GAL 4:6 And because ye are sons, GOD hath sent forth the SPIRIT of HIS SON into your hearts, crying Abba, Father.

GAL 4:7 Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and of a son, thou art heir of GOD through CHRIST!

GAL 4:14-31 The 2 systems, law and GRACE cannot co-exist. Just as 2 sons of Abraham could not co-exist.

GAL 5:14 For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself. Lev 19:18

GAL 5:16 This I say then, Walk in the SPIRIT, and ye shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

5:18 But if ye be led of the SPIRIT, ye are not under the law.

GAL 5:19-21 Works of the Flesh

GAL 5:22-24 Fruit of the Spirit.

GAL 5:25 If we live in the SPIRIT, let us also walk in the SPIRIT

Gal 5:22 note: 9 Graces, fruit of the SPIRIT

GAL 6:7 Be not deceived; GOD is not mocked. For whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.
